To encourage helmet affordability, Kapur calls for the elimination of import duties and taxes on helmets in countries lacking manufacturing facilities. He also urges governments to allocate 25% of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) budgets to road safety initiatives, such as distributing subsidized helmets and launching awareness campaigns. In addition, the plan stresses the importance of mandatory ISO certification for helmet manufacturers, fully equipped in-house testing laboratories, and helmet sensors in two-wheelers to remind riders to wear helmets. Delivery and ride-sharing companies must also test their helmets at certified labs in Europe and the U.S.

With this ambitious strategy, Rajeev Kapur calls for global collaboration among policymakers, manufacturers, and governments to enhance road safety. By enforcing helmet regulations, eliminating fake products, and increasing public awareness, the 'Mission Save Lives' roadmap aims to make roads safer worldwide and significantly reduce traffic fatalities by 2030.
