Rajeev Kapur unveils 'Mission Save Lives' - A 13-Point Plan at Morocco Summit

JAMMU: In a landmark move towards global road safety, Rajeev Kapur, Managing Director of Steelbird Helmets, presented the 'Mission Save Lives' 13-point roadmap at the Fourth Ministerial Conference in Morocco.

Invited as a helmet expert by the UN-WHO, Rajeev's initiative aligns with the UN's 'Decade of Action for Road Safety' (2021-2030), aiming to reduce global road accidents by 50% by 2030.

The plan advocates for a universal helmet safety standard for all developing nations, eliminating the need for manufacturers to comply with mul-

tipple regulations. UN/WHO-accredited helmet testing laboratories in every country are proposed to combat the sale of fake helmets, ensuring quality and safety.

Key recommendations include mandating two certified helmets with every new two-wheeler; enforcing a 'No Helmet, No Fuel' policy; and making lightweight bicycle helmets compulsory for children under four years old. A nationwide crackdown on counterfeit helmets and a traceability system for defective helmet components are also crucial aspects of the initiative.

To encourage helmet affordability, Kapur calls for the elimination of import duties and taxes on helmets in countries lacking manufacturing facilities. He also urges governments to allocate 25% of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) budgets to road safety initiatives, such as distributing subsidized helmets and launching awareness campaigns. In addition, the plan stresses the importance of mandatory ISO certification for helmet manufacturers, fully equipped in-house testing laboratories, and helmet sensors in two-wheelers to remind riders to wear helmets. Delivery and ride-sharing companies must also test their helmets at certified labs in Europe and the U.S.

With this ambitious strategy, Rajeev Kapur calls for global collaboration among policymakers, manufacturers, and governments to enhance road safety. By enforcing helmet regulations, eliminating fake products, and increasing public awareness, the 'Mission Save Lives' roadmap aims to make roads safer worldwide and significantly reduce traffic fatalities by 2030.

HC's toll order brings major relief to people, will reduce muscle power: PHDCCI, HRAK

JAMMU: PHD Chamber of Commerce & Industry (PHDCCI), Jammu Region Chapter and Hotel & Restaurant Association Katra (HRAK) jointly in a meeting held here on Wednesday besides hailing the decision of the Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court with regard to Toll Plaza from Lakhampur to Udhampur discussed in detail the positive impacts of that order which are going to be seen in future in details.

Rakesh Wazir, Chair PHDCCI & President HRAK, while welcoming the decision wherein the Court directed that toll fees at Lakhampur and Ban Toll Plazas be reduced to 20% of previous rates until the Lakhampur-Udhampur highway is fully operational and also instructed authorities to reassess the current toll charges, noting they are excessively high and prohibited the establishment of new toll plazas within 60 kilometers of existing ones on National Highway-44, said that this order will have far reaching impact in whole society and J&K people as well as Vaishnudevi ji pilgrims will get benefitted from it. He while referring the decision wherein respondents i.e.

NHAI as well as the contractors of the Toll Plazas are directed not to employee any person at the Toll Plazas having criminal background and the respondent as well as the contractors should deploy the persons at the Toll Plazas only after verification of such employees by the concerned police agency and in case of any deviation in this regard, the concerned SHO/Incharge shall be personally responsible for the same will change the equation not only in J&K but this decision's impact would be seen in whole India in coming days and rule of muscle power which we used to see on Toll Plazas will get reduced because people will refer that order and asked the authorities for its strict implementation.

Shyam Lal Kesar, Executive member PHDCCI and Chairman HRAK, said that residents in the vicinity of toll plazas have faced unfair overcharging as they commute through the points very frequently and used to

ensure genuine relief for commuters and residents.

Local passes which are given to people residing within 20 Kms as per NHAI guidelines particularly at Ban Toll Plaza just on basis of muscle power and even asked the authorities for having prove of all the irregularities which are routine matter over there. Sanjay Gupta Co-Chair PHDCCI and Virender Kesar Convenor (Head) Katra PHDCCI said that this historic decision delivered long-awaited justice to the public and emphasized that these type of decisions and interventions of Courts make the society a real place to live in otherwise some time common man loose hope from the system and asked for immediate and effective implementation of the court's directives to
