

CBI disposed of around 1,400 cases in 2024: Agency's director

GHAZIABAD: Highlighting a healthy disposal rate of cases in 2024, CBI Director Praveen Sood said on Thursday that the agency disposed of about 1,400 cases that were under investigation, as compared to 900 new ones registered, during the period and asked senior officers to maintain the momentum in 2025.

Addressing the valedictory ceremony of the newly-recruited law officers at the CBI Academy in Ghaziabad, Sood said the federal agency registered 900 cases in 2024.

After induction training, 50 newly-recruited law officers were formally solemnised into the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI).

Sood congratulated the officers for successfully completing the training and asked them to put in practice the knowledge and expertise gained from it.

The year 2024 witnessed high disposal of about 1,400 cases under investigation (UI) and under further investigation (UFI) against around 900 new cases registered, he said.

"The focus in 2025 would be on accelerating trial disposal of cases. He (Sood) stressed that the role of law officers in this regard would be crucial and called upon the officers to endeavour towards making their best contribution," a statement from the agency said. The director handed over the Cornelia Sorabji Trophy (for indoor studies) to Anubhav Shukla, while the Orator's Gavel Trophy (for best individual presentation) went to Sanjay Rana, the statement said.

II a. Diploma in General Nursing Midwifery from an Indian Nursing Council/State Nursing council recognized Institute / Board or Council
b. Registered as Nurses & Midwife in State / Indian Nursing Council.
c. Two Years' Experience in a minimum 50 bedded Hospital after acquiring the educational qualification mentioned above as applicable for all Participating AIIMS.

Remarks - The required two years of experience as in above is as an essential criterion and to be valid, the experience shall must be acquired after obtaining Essential Qualification, i.e. after completing residency period of the course, declaration of result & registration with State/Indian Nursing Council.

I, Yousf-ul-Umar Executive Officer Municipal Council Rajouri (Municipal Council Rajouri do hereby declare that:

a) Municipal Council Rajouri has notified sanitation service level benchmarks, at the least adhering to all conditions defined for SBM ODF+, in municipal bylaws (or equivalent, in absence of municipal administration) and published the same in at least two dailies with wide reach.

b) The city/town has sufficient mobile toilets/toilet facilities for use during occasions with large gatherings in a single area i.e. situations with high demand for toilets, where existing facilities may not be sufficient.

c) All functional public and community toilets should be appropriately provisioned and well maintained, thereby, adhering to all the conditions as per CT-PT Cleanliness Scoring Matrix.

d) For a city to be declared ODF+ all CT/PTs are to score the minimum qualifying marks.

e) City has carried out structural audit of all such community/public toilets which are more than 15 yrs old and are in dilapidated condition and has carried out necessary repairs/renovations /reconstruction on the basis of the findings of audit.

f) The city has issued and notified fines against open defecators, and people urinating in open and has defined penalty/fine against concessionaires/maintenance authorities in-charge of community/public toilets in service contract (with respect to poor maintenance of such toilets).

g) All Sanitary Inspector and Sanitary supervisor have submitted their self-declarations regarding SBM ODF+ status.

h) Preliminary resolution has been passed declaring the city/town as SBM ODF+

i) Above resolution has been publicly announced, in at least two newspapers of wide circulation and readership, inviting public feedback/objection within 15 days of announcement.

j) Since no objections have been received within the stipulated time period/since objections and feedback received from the public have been addressed, a final resolution has been adopted by this office regarding SBM ODF+ status.

k) This final resolution has been communicated to the state government for further verification (if decided to be carried out).

Accordingly, Municipal Council Rajouri is hereby declared SBM ODF+. MoHUA is now requested to carry out the "Swachh SBM ODF+ Certification" process for Municipal Council Rajouri.
