## Zero-tolerance for terrorism must be uncompromising universal norm: India

NEW DELHI: India on Saturday conveyed to Arab League member nations that "zero-tolerance" for terrorism must be an "uncompromising universal norm" as the two sides deliberated on the shared priority of advancing the Gaza peace plan and ways to navigate the current geopolitical environment.

The issues figured at the second India-Arab foreign ministers' meeting in New Delhi that saw participation of 19 member nations of the Arab League, considered as an influential grouping.

The participants including several foreign ministers



called on Prime Minister Narendra Modi before the start of the meeting.

"The Arab world is a part of India's extended neighbourhood, linked by deep civilisa-

tional bonds, vibrant people-to-people connections and enduring brotherly ties, as well as a shared commitment to peace, progress and stability," Modi said.

"Confident that enhanced cooperation in technology, energy, trade and innovation will unlock new opportunities and take the partnership to new heights," he said on social media.

In his inaugural address at the foreign ministerial meeting, Jaishankar said that taking forward the comprehensive peace plan to end the Gaza conflict, based on the UN Security Council Resolution 2803, is a widely shared priority.

"Various countries have made policy declarations on the peace plan, individually or collectively. This is

## Two revenue officials charge-sheeted over illegal land transfer

JAMMU: Two revenue officials were chargesheeted for allegedly transferring prime land worth Rs 22 crore to private persons in Nagrota, the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) said on Saturday.

A chargesheet produced by the anti-graft agency before the court of Jammu Anti-corruption Special Judge carried the names of the two officials and 31 private persons, alleged to be the beneficiaries of the corruption.

The legal action follows a case filed in 2020 against the illegal transfer of state land in Nagrota and adjoining areas of Jammu district, the ACB said.

## 67 terrorists, 10 SFs & 11 civilians killed in different ops across Balochistan

ISLAMABAD/KARACHI: At least 67 terrorists, some from the BLA, 11 civilians and 10 security personnel were killed in fierce clashes during multiple operations in Pakistan's restive Balochistan province, officials and ministers said Saturday.

Balochistan government spokesman Shahid Rind told Geo News in an interview that with these 67 terrorists killed since Friday night so far, the toll of rebels killed in the last two days has risen to 108.

Earlier in the day, Balochistan Chief Minister



Sarfraz Bugti, in a tweet, said 70 terrorists have been killed in the operations. A federal minister said terrorists from the Balochistan Liberation Army (BLA) killed civilians in Gwadar of Balochistan.

The ongoing operations as of Saturday 9 pm came after 41 terrorists were killed in two different counter-terror measures in Panjgur and Harnai of the province on Thursday and Friday.
