31 colonies regularised...

"The process of regularisation of residential colonies in Jammu was initiated earlier and 31 colonies have already been regularised by the JDA. However, later on, the said process was stayed by the high court," he said. On plans to establish new residential colonies in Jammu, the chief minister said that new colonies would be developed after allotment of land either under self-financing mode or through the Public-Private Partnership model by agencies including the Jammu Development Authority, Srinagar Development Authority, and Jammu and Kashmir Housing Board after approval from their respective boards.

acts, thereby posing a threat to public order and safety. The order defines a Spa/Massage Centre as any premises, establishment, shop, clinic or commercial space, by whatever name called, which offers or claims to offer

massage, body therapy, spa therapy, wellness therapy, relaxation services, ayurvedic therapy, physiotherapy (other than those run by qualified registered medical practitioners) or similar services, whether for consideration or otherwise. The directions issued shall apply to all such establishments operating within the territorial jurisdiction of district Jammu.

As per the order, engaging in any form of immoral activity within the premises has been strictly prohibited. Cross-gender massage shall not be permitted and there shall be provision of male masseurs for massage of males and female masseurs for massage of females only. The order further stipulates that no internal locks, latches, bolts or locking mechanisms shall be installed in treatment rooms and that spa or massage services shall not be provided behind locked doors.

The order also directs that no centre shall operate before 8:00 AM and after 9:00 PM. No female employee shall use the premises as residence or for night stay. Supply or consumption of alcohol or any other intoxicant within the premises has been prohibited. Mandatory production of valid identity proof by all customers shall be ensured and a proper register containing their contact details shall be maintained. All employees shall wear identity cards issued by the employer during working hours and the employer shall maintain a register of all employees.

The order also mandates that display boards in both English and Hindi shall be installed at appropriate places at the reception containing the site plan of the premises, the category-wise number of beds for male and female sections and details of employees including their designation and qualifications. Owners and managers have been directed to submit an affidavit in the form of an undertaking to the nearest police station within ten days, confirming compliance with all the prescribed conditions.

It has been stipulated that any spa or massage centre found violating the order shall be liable for immediate closure and sealing, in addition to prosecution of the owners, managers and employees under relevant laws, including the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Jammu, has been directed to ensure effective enforcement of the order, while Sub-Divisional Magistrates and Tehsildars have been instructed to conduct periodic inspections of such establishments within their respective jurisdictions and submit compliance reports to the Office of the District Magistrate.

The order has come into force with immediate effect and shall remain operative for a period of eight weeks from the date of issuance, unless withdrawn, modified or rescinded earlier. The District Administration has reiterated its commitment to maintaining public order and ensuring that all commercial establishments operate strictly in accordance with the law.

Meanwhile, Jammu Police had on Tuesday detained two women, reportedly from Thailand, during a raid on Shine Spa Centre in the Narwal area and registered a First Information Report (FIR) in connection with alleged violations of immigration laws and suspected illegal activities.

An FIR (44/2026) was registered under Sections 21 and 24 of the Immigration and Foreigners Act, 2025. Further investigation is underway to ascertain the role of other persons and any wider network, a police officer said, adding both the arrested girls are on police remand.

During the operation, police had seized digital video recorders (DVRs) and other materials from the Spa for forensic examination. Several individuals present at the

premises were also detained for questioning as part of the probe.

On December 28 last year, police had conducted a similar operation at O2 Spa Centre in the Channi Himmat area, during which a Thai woman was detained and a man from Kurukshetra in Haryana booked. In that case, the spa owner, Jai Singh of Kurukshetra, was booked under FIR 237/2025 at Police Station Channi Himmat under Section 24 of the Immigration Act and Section 223 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) for keeping a foreign national without permission or prior intimation to authorities.

"As far as the matter is concerned, sometimes things are said in the heat of emotions. What I said hurt him, and I regret that. However, whatever I said was about them; I did not bring any of his family members into it. His field commanders, while leaving, dragged my parents and my late grandfather into it. But I will let that go as well", Abdullah told the House here.

Head of the CM's statement, BJP MLA Sham Lal Sharma said that he believed that nothing very serious had been said (by his party legislators) and maintained that there could have been a "slip of the tongue." CM Abdullah said that he shared cordial relations with legislators across party lines and had been interacting with all MLAs over the past one and a half years. "Had I been allowed to speak earlier, I would have clarified and withdrawn my remarks. But I was not given the opportunity to do so at the time", he said.

Reiterating his responsibility as the CM, Abdullah said that he represented voters from all regions and had responded to questions raised by the Opposition, despite some being difficult to answer.

He further cautioned that disruptions in the House could hamper the passage of grants related to key departments, including Education, Health and Social Welfare, adding that he did not want voters from any constituency to feel ignored.
