**15 PSIs transferred in Doda District**

**DODA:** The District Police Headquarters (DPIH) Doda has ordered the transfer and posting of 15 Police Sub-Inspectors (PSIs) in the interest of administration, with immediate effect.

According to Order No. 92 of 2026 dated February 12, 2026, issued by the Jammu and Kashmir Police, the reshuffle has been carried out to streamline functioning and strengthen policing across various police stations and posts in the district.

As per the order, PSI Rahul Singh has been posted to Police Station (PS) Doda as Investigating Officer (I.O), while PSI Mohd Ilyas has been assigned as Incharge (IC) Police Post (PP) Kahara. PSI Sahil Bhagat has been posted as IC PP Goha, and PSI Amit Singh has been transferred to PS Assar as I.O. PSI Bua Ditta Bhagat has been posted to PS Bhaderwah as I.O, while

PSI Raghav Chalotra has been assigned as IC PP Khellani. PSI Rajat Sahani will serve as IC PP DH Doda, and PSI Abhinav Kotwal has been posted to PS Thathri as I.O.

Similarly, PSI Sandeep Kumar Raju has been deputed as IC PP Bhagwah, and PSI Saddam Hussain has been posted to PS Doda as I.O. PSI Sonu Choudhary has been assigned as IC PP Kastigarh, while PSI Mahender Kumar has been transferred to PS

Gandoh as I.O. PSI Pankaj Katoch will serve as IC PP Pul Doda. Meanwhile, PSI Vinod Kumar has been shifted from PP Khellani to PP Bhalla as IC, and PSI Rajnish Pangotra has been posted as IC PP Prem Nagar.

**Dirty business will not be tolerated in Temple City: Shiv Sena**

JAMMU: The J&K unit of Shiv Sena has launched a campaign against alleged immoral activities operating under the guise of health services in Jammu, while also raising concerns about the growing menace of human trafficking in the region. J&K unit president Manish Sahni termed the recent administrative crackdown on spas and massage parlours as a "victory for the people." Sahni stated that on February 9, the party had submitted a memorandum to the District Magistrate and Senior Superintendent of Police demanding stricter regulations for spa centres, including installation of CCTV cameras, mandatory police verification of staff, and photo identification for customers. He appreciated the administration's prompt action, saying it had helped protect the social and cultural dignity of Jammu, often referred to as the temple city. "Dirty business will not be tolerated in the temple city," he said, calling for sustained vigilance by authorities. Raising the issue of human trafficking, Sahni alleged that organised networks were bringing women from other states and abroad under the pretext of tourism or employment and forcing them into illegal activities. Calling for a zero-tolerance approach, he urged police and the administration to intensify action against such rackets and dismantle the alleged trafficking networks. Party members including Vikas Bakshi, Sanjeev Kohli, and Aditya Mahajan were also present during the press conference.
