RAJOURI: The cluster-level PARAKH (PRS-2024) Dissemination and Intervention Initiative has successfully concluded across District Rajouri, marking a significant milestone in academic reform. The initiative followed a three-day U-T-level workshop held in Srinagar focusing on dissemination of PARAKH Rashtriya Sarvekshan (PRS)-2024

findings, identification of learning gaps, and preparation of intervention strategies aligned with NCF-2023 and the Holistic Progress Card framework.

Under the leadership of Principal DIET Rajouri, S. P. Khajuria, and Chief Education Officer Rajouri, Mohd Hafiz, cluster-level workshops were conducted across all 53 clusters in 15 educational zones from January 19 to February 14,

2026, culminating at HSS Kotranka. The drive covered 1,624 schools, ensuring participation of one Head of Institution and one teacher from each school.

The workshops were supervised by District Level Master Trainer (PRS-2024) Dr. Mohd Farooq, Senior Lecturer, DIET Rajouri, along with Associate District Level Master Trainer Mr. Mohd Shafi, Lecturer, DIET Rajouri. Key outcomes include development of standardized School-Level Micro Plans, cluster consolidation formats, and structured academic guidelines targeting PRS-2027 improvement.

With strong support from DIET faculty, Zonal Education Officers, Zonal Coordinators, and Cluster Heads, District Rajouri now aims to translate structured planning into measurable academic performance gains.

NAUP condemns sexual assault on minor in Bishnah, seeks swift justice

JAMMU: Senior leader of the National Awami United Party (NAUP), Shikha Bandral, has strongly condemned the alleged sexual assault of a three-year-old girl in Bishnah, terming the incident a "stain on humanity" and a grim reminder of the urgent need to strengthen child safety mechanisms.

Expressing deep shock and anguish, Bandral said that such barbaric acts against innocent children

cannot be tolerated in any civilized society and must be dealt with sternly under the law. She stood in solidarity with the victim's family and assured them of full support during this traumatic time.

The NAUP leader demanded that the government and law enforcement agencies ensure the strictest possible punishment for the accused. She called for the case to be fast-tracked to deliver timely justice and set a

strong deterrent example. "Justice delayed is justice denied. The accused must face exemplary punishment so that no one dares to commit such a heinous crime in the future," she said.

Bandral also urged the administration to provide comprehensive medical care and psychological counseling to the child and her family. She emphasized the need for a systemic shift in handling crimes against women and

children to ensure stronger preventive and protective measures.

Reaffirming the party's commitment, she said NAUP would closely monitor the case until justice is delivered. Prominent party leaders including Sushma Kumari, Balwan Chand, Parveen Verma, Bittu Ram, and Hansraj were also present and echoed the demand for stringent action and enhanced security measures across the region.
