**Subject: Issuance of Admit Cards to the candidates for OMR Based Written Examination for the post of Laboratory Attendant.**

- The Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board (JKSSB) is conducting the OMR Based Written Examination for the post of **Laboratory Attendant**, Home Department, J&K, advertised under Notification No. 06 of 2025, Item No. 24 scheduled to be held on **01.03.2026**.
- Candidates can download their Admit Cards from the JKSSB's Official website ([www.jkssb.nic.in](http://www.jkssb.nic.in)) w.e.f. **24.02.2026** using their credentials. They must read the instructions contained therein, carefully.
- However, in case, a candidate is not able to download his/her admit card, he or she may represent before the board two days before the Examination Date with a valid proof of having filled in Online application form and online fee, failing which it shall be presumed that they are not interested in appearing in the said examination and no claim whatsoever shall be entertained.
- Candidates are advised to report to their respective examination centres at least two (02) hours before the scheduled examination time for Biometric/Facial Authentication.**
- Candidates are advised to take a printout of the Admit Card well in advance to avoid any last-minute rush. In case of any mismatch in the photograph on the Admit Card, the candidate must immediately report the matter to the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board (JKSSB) Central Office at Jammu or Srinagar, either in person or via email at [sakjksb@jk.gov.in](mailto:sakjksb@jk.gov.in). No such claim regarding photo mismatch shall be entertained by the Centre Superintendent or the staff on duty on the day of the examination.
- The candidature of candidates claiming eligibility by misrepresentation/concealment of any material facts, impersonation, fraud, etc. shall be liable for cancellation and disciplinary action, as deemed appropriate.
- The Board reserves the right to cancel the candidature of any candidate at any stage at which he/she is found ineligible.
- The candidates are also advised to be in touch with the JKSSB's Official Website ([www.jkssb.nic.in](http://www.jkssb.nic.in)) for the latest updates on the examinations and Admit cards will not be sent by post.

**Notification**

S.O. \_\_\_\_ In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Lieutenant Governor, Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir here by makes the following rules, namely:-

**1. Short title and Commencements.**-(1) These rules may be called Jammu and Kashmir Tourism (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2026.

(2) These rules shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Government Gazette.

**2. Definitions.**-(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-

- "Administrative Department" means the Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the Administrative charge of the service;
- "Cadre" means the cadre of the Service;
- "Commission" means the Jammu and Kashmir "Public Service Commission".
- "Government" means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir;
- "Member of the Service" means a person appointed to a post in the Service under the provisions of these rules or the rules superseded by these rules;
- "Post" means a permanent post carrying a definite time scale sanctioned by the competent authority;
- "Rules" means the Jammu and Kashmir Tourism (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2026;
- "Schedule" means the schedule(s) annexed to these rules;
- "Service" means the Jammu and Kashmir Tourism (Gazetted) Service; and
- "Union Territory" means Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

(2) Words and expressions used in these rules but not defined shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules/Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations, 1956.

**3. Constitution of Service.**-(1) From the date of commencement of these rules there shall be constituted the "Jammu and Kashmir Tourism (Gazetted) Service."

(2) The Government may, at the commencement of these rules, appoint to the service any person who at the commencement of these rules, is holding in substantive capacity any post included in the cadre of this Service:

Provided that for the purpose of the initial constitution of the Service, a person holding any post included in the cadre of the Service in its sanctioned scale of pay, in substantive capacity to which he was appointed by the competent authority under rules, either by direct recruitment or by promotion shall be deemed to have been appointed to the Service under these rules if he is fully qualified to hold the post under these rules.

**Explanation:-** The word 'holding' means a person holding a post included in the cadre of the Jammu and Kashmir Service in its sanctioned scale of pay on regular basis under orders of the competent authority and will not include the persons holding a post on ex-cadre/deputation basis or on adhoc basis or in a stop-gap arrangement.

**4. Strength and Composition of the Service.**-(1) The authorized permanent and temporary strength of the cadre and the nature of the post included therein shall be determined by the Government from time to time and shall, at the initial constitution of the Service under these rules, be as specified in the **Schedule-I** annexed to these rules:

Provided that the Government may create temporary posts in the cadre of the Service for specified period or purpose as may be considered necessary from time to time.

(2) The Government shall, after the interval of every five years or at such other intervals, as may be necessary, re-examine the strength and composition of cadre of the Service and make such alterations there in as it deems fit.

**5. Qualification and method of recruitment.**

(1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any post in any class, category, or grade in the Service unless he or she possesses the qualifications prescribed in **Schedule-II** and fulfils the requirements of recruitment as provided under the rules and orders for the time being in force.

(2) **Appointment to the Service shall be made.-**

- By direct recruitment; or
- By promotion; or
- Partly by (a), and partly by (b), in the ratio, and in the manner, as mentioned against each post in Schedule-II;

Provided that all the posts under direct recruitment shall be filled through the J&K Public Service Commission as per the rules/orders of the Government issued for the purpose.

Provided further, that all posts to be filled by promotion shall be filled up through Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC).

(3) The department shall refer vacancies in the direct/promotion quota to Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission and Departmental Promotion Committee, as the case may be, in terms of the existing rules.

**6. Probation.**-(1) Probation of the Members of the Service shall be governed by the provisions of J&K Civil Services (Classification Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

(2) The pay of person appointed to the Service under these rules shall be regulated as per the provisions of J&K Civil Services Regulations or general rules as issued from time to time.

**7. Reservation in appointments.**-While making appointments either by direct recruitment or by promotion, reservation shall be provided to the eligible categories in accordance with the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and the rules and orders, as in force and amended from time to time.

**8. Training and Departmental Examination** Persons appointed to the Service by Competitive Examination shall be required to undergo such training from time to time during the course of probation and to pass during the period of probation or trial such departmental examination(s) as the Government may prescribe.

**9. Eligibility of Government servants for direct recruitment.**-A person already in the Government Service may apply through proper channel for direct recruitment to a vacant post in any particular class or category in the Service if he/she possesses the educational and other qualifications prescribed for recruitment to such class or category of posts. The upper age limit of such Government servants shall be as provided in the general rules.

**10. Maintenance of seniority lists.**-Seniority of the members of the Service shall be regulated by the Administrative Department under the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

**11. Residuary matters.**-In regard to matters not specifically covered by these rules, the members of the Service shall be governed by the rules, regulations and orders applicable to the Civil Service of Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir in general.

**12. Interpretation.**-If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the matter shall be referred to Administrative Department whose decision shall be final and binding.

**13. Repeal and Savings:-**

- All rules corresponding to these rules and in force immediately before the commencement of these rules viz. J&K Tourism Gazetted Service Recruitment Rules 1992 are hereby repealed.
- Not with standing such repeal, any appointment or order made or action taken under the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under these rules.

Nasser Ahmed, Sanitation Worker is hereby designated as Sanitary Beldar for duties related to sanitation support and assistance in mechanized sewer/septic tank cleaning operations, including handling of equipment support, site preparation, safety compliance and assisting the desludging team as per prescribed safety protocols and PPE requirements.

Sh. Deepak Kumar, Sanitation Worker (Sewer Entry Professional), is hereby designated as Sewer Entry Professional for authorized mechanized sewer/septic tank cleaning operations. He shall perform duties strictly as per safety guidelines, CPHEEO norms, and Standard Operating Procedures, including use of PPE, gas detection protocols, confined space entry norms and emergency response procedures.

Both officials shall ensure strict adherence to safety measures, use of PPE kits, and compliance with the ban on manual cleaning of sewers/septic tanks. The Sanitation Section Incharge shall monitor their deployment and maintain proper records of work carried out.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
