PUBLIC NOTICE

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India, New Delhi has notified the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 for better management of solid waste across the country.

As per Clause No. 4(p) - Duties of Waste Generators, "The waste generator shall store horticulture waste and garden waste generated from his premises separately within his own premises and dispose of the same as per the directions issued by the local body from time to time."

In accordance with the "Polluter Pays" principle, which states that "those responsible for waste generation shall pay for its collection and disposal", the general public is hereby informed through the medium of this notice that Municipal Committee Yaripora shall:

- Provide vehicles for the separate collection of garden / horticulture waste on a paid basis.
- Impose a fine on violators who dispose of garden/ horticulture waste in front of their houses, on public places, or in vacant plots.

➤ **Whereas**, the above-mentioned work was allotted to you vide NTP No. SE/PMGSY/J/21458-67 Dated 29-10-2018 and completed on December 2021 is presently under 5th Year Defect Liability Period.

➤ **Whereas**, it has been reported by the Executive Engineer, PMGSY Division Kathua that since September 2023, you have failed to carry out the required maintenance works resulting in dilapidated condition of the road, causing inconvenience to the general public.

➤ **Whereas**, the Executive Engineer, PMGSY Division Kathua has repeatedly reported that despite issuance of several notices including final notices, no effective maintenance has been carried out by your firm since September 2023, as conveyed vide references cited above.

➤ **Whereas**, a letter received from your end on dated 24-07-2024, wherein you assured to resume the maintenance work after the rainy season and accordingly, the termination proposal submitted by the Executive Engineer PMGSY Division Kathua vide No. EE/PMGSY/KUA/1342-47 Date 16-07-2024 was kept on hold but after lapse of more than 18 months from the said assurance, no maintenance work has been resumed till date.

➤ **Whereas**, your continued failure to discharge contractual obligations despite repeated opportunities amounts to gross violation of contract conditions, SBD provisions and PMGSY guidelines governing maintenance during Defect Liability Period

➤ **Whereas**, the Executive Engineer PMGSY Division Kathua letter No. EE/PMGSY/KUA/648-53 dated 26-05-2025 has worked out detailed calculation of physical and financial with penalties and liquidated damages as per clause 44.1 of General conditions of the contract of the SBD and clause 53.1(i) of the SBD. The Executive Engineer PMGSY Division Kathua has worked out the total penalty of Rs. 141.98 lacs to be recovered from you and recommended for the termination of this contract.

During the site visit of the undersigned on 04-02-2026, it has been witnessed that the various stretches of road, excluding sinking portion, has been deteriorated due to your negligence regarding the maintenance of road from time to time as per clause 32.4 which reads as :

- Potholes on the road surface to be repaired soon after these appear or brought to his notice either during the Contractor's monthly inspection or by the Engineer.

- Road shoulders to be maintained in proper condition to make them free from excessive edge drop offs, roughness, scouring or potholes.
- Cleaning of surface drains including reshaping to maintain free flow of water.
- Cleaning of culverts and pits for free flow of water.
- Maintenance of road signs, pavement markings and other traffic control devices.
- Any other maintenance operation required to keep the road traffic worthy at all times during the maintenance period.
- Maintenance of Cross Drainage Works
- The maintenance activity includes clearing of tree branches to keep the sight distance visible all the time.

"Neglecting the "Road Maintenance" exacerbated the effects of rain leading to the deterioration of road conditions during latest rainy season. If the road would have maintained by you properly as per schedule and as per clause 32.4, especially "Cleaning of surface drains including reshaping to maintain free flow of water and the Cleaning of culverts and pits for free flow of water", such colossal damage of the road due to incessant rains in August-September 2025 was averted. The poorly maintained drainage system saturated the road base and subgrade which compromised the structural integrity of the road."

Neglecting timely maintenance of pavement also led to a range of consequences with various cost implications viz.

- Increased Repair Costs:** Small issues like cracks or potholes can quickly become larger and more serious problems if not addressed promptly. The cost of repairs escalates significantly for more extensive damage, as more materials, labour, and time are required to fix them. For example, failure to carry out resurfacing maintenance at the appropriate time soon leads to the need to carry out strengthening overlay works, which is at least twice expensive as resealing. Similarly, if the overlay is not carried out soon enough, major deterioration sets in and pavement reconstruction will be required, which is at least three times more costly than an overlay.
- Decreased Lifespan of Pavement:** Regular maintenance can significantly extend the life of pavement by preventing the escalation of minor damages. Without timely maintenance, the pavement deteriorates at a faster rate, leading to decreased lifespan of pavement
- Impact on Drainage:** If the required maintenance are not carried out, drainage will become ineffective and surface defects will worsen, both of which result in water penetrating the structure of the pavement and accelerate the pavement deterioration.
- Safety Hazards and Liability:** Damaged pavement can pose serious safety hazards to vehicles and pedestrians, including accidents or damage to vehicles.

In view of the above, you are hereby called upon to Show Cause within 15 (Fifteen) days of receipt of this notice as to why:

- You should not be held liable for such colossal damage of the road.
- The contract should not be terminated for fundamental breach of contract as per Clause 52.2 (c).
- Liquidated damages should not be imposed as per Clause 44.1.

Your reply, if any, must be specific, supported with documentary evidence, and submitted within the stipulated time. Failure to respond shall be construed as having no explanation, and further action shall be taken without any further notice.
