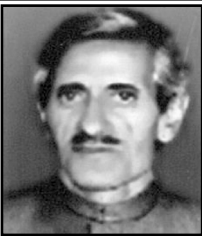

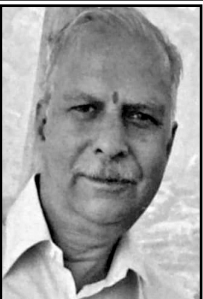

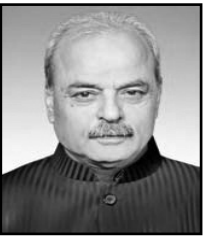

CRIME REPORT

3 drug peddlers arrested; contraband recovered

SRINAGAR: Continuing its relentless drive against menace of narcotics, Police on
Thursday arrested three drug peddlers in Kupwara & Anantnag and recovered contra-
band substances from their possession.

As per details, based on specific input about drug peddling, police party led by
SHO Police Station Kupwara along with Incharge Police Post Kandi under the
supervision of DySP Hqrs Rashid Younus at a checkpoint established at Radbugh,
in presence of concerned Magistrate, intercepted one Showkat Ahmad Rather, son
of Gh Ahmad Rather, resident of Kawari.

During checking, 1 Kg Charas was recovered from his possession. He was arrested-
and shifted to police station where he remained in custody. During preliminary
investigations, he revealed that he was on way to sell narcotics in small quantities
among the youth of Kupwara. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was
registered and further investigation started.

Similarly, Police Station Bijbehara received a specific information that two persons
namely Farooq Ahmad Dar, son of Ghulam Mohammad Dar and Shakeel Ahmad
Dar, son of Mohd Maqbool Dar, both residents of Tulkhan Bijbehara are indulged in
peddling of narcotics and accordingly have hoarded narcotic substances in a cow-
shed. In this regard a case under relevant sections of law was registered and inves-
tigation started. A party from Police Station Bijbehara alongwith Magistrate con-
cerned raided the spot and during search, recovered 700 gm Charas powder and 500
gm Charas. Both accused were arrested and shifted to police station where they
remained in custody. Further investigation in case is going on.

5 bovines rescued, vehicle seized

SAMBA: Police on Thursday foiled an attempt to smuggle bovines, by reseuing 5
bovines.

As per details, a police party led by SHO Ghagwal, Inspector Vijay Kumar Verma
while performing vehicle checking duty at Naka Tapyal, signaled a Mahindra vehi-
cle (JK08B-4980) to stop, but instead of stopping vehicle, driver accelerated the
speed and crossed Naka point. However, alert cops intercepted the vehicle a few
meters away from Naka. During checking of vehicle, 5 cattle were found laden in it
which were rescued. FIR No. 32/2022 under sections 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act
was registered at Police Station Ghagwal and investigation started. The vehicle was
also seized by Police.

Two missing boys, woman traced; reunited with families

JAMMU: Police on Thursday traced two missing boys & a woman and reunited them
with their families.

As per details, two different missing complaints were lodged at Police Station
Gandhi Nagar i.e., missing report of a boy namely Ajeet Singh, son of Govind Singh,
resident of Ramnagar, Udhampur and missing report of a minor boy namely Ankit
Sharma, son of Kamal Kumar, resident of Jourian, Akhnoor; by legal-heirs of miss-
ing persons stating that they went missing from their homes.

In this regard two different missing reports were registered at Police Station
Gandhi Nagar and investigation started.

On this, a team of Police Station Gandhi Nagar under the supervision of SDPO
South Sachit Sharma led by SHO Gandhi Nagar Inspr Pankaj Sharma, after put-
ting in hectic efforts, traced both the missing boys. Subsequently, their families
were informed and both were handed-over to their respective family members after
completing all the legal formalities.

Neel Police also traced a woman missing. On February 9, 2022, a missing report
was lodged at Police Post Neel by one Mohd Iqbal Wani, stating that his wife name-
ly Arbina Begum went missing. Accordingly, a missing report was lodged and search
started to trace her.

Acting on missing report, a special police team was constituted to trace woman and
after hectic efforts, she was traced out after which she was handed over to her legal-
heirs. The entire search was affected by a police team led by Incharge Police Post
Neel PSI Shiv Dutt under guidance of SHO Ramsoo and under the supervision of
SDPO Banihal Nisar Ahmed Khoja and overall supervision of Mohita Sharma, SSP
Ramban.

Three absconders nabbed

JAMMU: Police on Thursday nabbed three absconders who were evading their
arrests for 2 years, 9 years and 7 years.

As per details, an information was received through reliable sources at Police
Station Channi Himmat regarding presence of three absconders, including Vijay
Kumar, son of Nagar Mal, resident of R S Pura Jammu who was evading arrest
from past two years in FIR No 1/2013 under sections 4/25 of A Act registered at
Police Station Channi Himmat; Parvez Ahmed, son of Ab Rashid, resident of

Malipath evading for 9 years in FIR No 171/2009 registered under sections
457/380 of RPC and Babu Ram, son of Ram Lal, resident of Udeyvala Jammu
evading arrest for 7 years in FIR No 40/2022 under sections 279/304-A of IPC.

Two absconders namely Parvez and Babu Ram were arrested by SHO Bahu Fort
Inspr Nayat Ali and respective cases were also registered against them in Police
Station Bahu Fort while third was arrested by team of Police Station Channi
Himmat led by SHO Inspr Deepak Katoch.

It is pertinent to mention that a warrant under section 512 of CrPC was issued
against Vijay Kumar by 1st Additional Munsiff Judicial Magistrate Jammu and a
warrant under section 512 of CrPC was issued against Parvez Ahmed by court of
Special Mobile Court Jammu and another warrant under section 512 of CrPC was
issued against Babu Ram by Court of Sub Judge Electricity, Jammu.

Police restores lost purse to owner

owner.

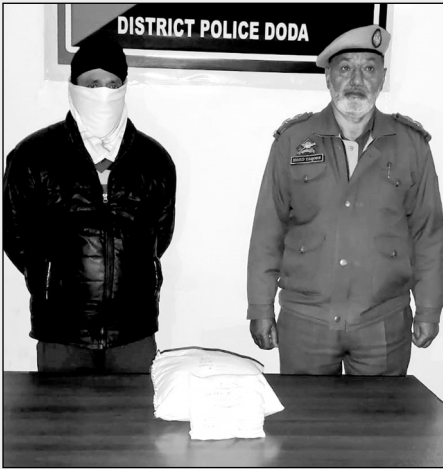
As per details, a missing complaint was lodged at Police Post Parade by a woman
namely Radha Gupta, wife of Rakesh Gupta, resident of Dewan Mandir, Pacea
Danga stating that she lost her purse containing Rs 15,000 cash and other valuable
documents. On this a missing report was lodged and investigation started. After
this, a team under supervision of SDPO North Sharad Kalu and led by Incharge
Police Post Parade PSI Lalit Kumar did strenuous efforts and with help of CCTV
footages of the area, recovered the lost purse, which was handed-over to owner after
verifying her details.

Pedestrian arrested with 2.250 Kg poppy straw

BHADARWAH: Police on Thursday arrested a pedestrian and recovered 2.250 Kg
poppy straw from his possession.

Doda Police said that a party from
Police Station Bhadarwah, during
routine patrolling duty in Kotli
area, intercepted a suspect with a
black-coloured bag. During frisk-
ing, police found a yellow polythene
bag kept inside bag in which coarse
powder substance, apparently look-
ing like poppy straw weighing, 2 Kg
and 250 gm was found. The
accused, identified as Harvinder
Singh, son of Krishan Lal, resident
of Simbal Camp, Miran Sahib
Jammu, was arrested and FIR No.
28/2022, under sections 8/15 of
NDPS ACT was registered against
him at Police Station Bhadarwah.
The arrest of accused and recovery
was made under supervision of Insp
Jatinder Singh SHO Police Station Bhadarwah
and SDPO Bhadarwah Meer Gafoor.



Drug peddler arrested with Charas

DODA: Police on Thursday nabbed a drug peddler and recovered 450 gm Charas
from his possession.

Doda Police said that a party of
Police Post Khellani led by PSI
Aman Sharma during routine
patrolling in Khellani market spot-
ted a suspect.

During search, a bag containing
narcotics substance (Charas) weigh-
ing about 450 gm was recovered.
The accused, identified as Fareed
Ahmed, son of Nizam Din, resident
of Trown Tehsil and District Doda
was arrested and FIR No. 39/2022
under sections 8/20 of NDPS Act
was registered against him at Police
Station Doda. The recovery and
arrest was made by Police party led by SHO Police Station Doda Insp Arun Prakash
under overall supervision of Master Popsy SP Hqrs Doda.



Cop found hanging inside friend's room

RAJOURI: Body of a policeman was found under mysterious circumstance inside a
rented room of his colleague in Rajouri district on Thursday.

As per details, body of 36-year-old Sgct Ifthar Ahmed, son of Manzoor Ahmed of
Ari Mendhar Poonch, presently posted at DPL Rajouri, was found hanging from
ceiling of a rented room of his friend, who is also a policeman, in ward-8 of Rajouri.
SSP Rajouri Mohammad Aslam Choudhary told that investigations are underway
and all angles including suicide is being investigated.

**1 killed, businessman from Kashmir among
4 injured in Haryana road mishap**

SRINAGAR: A person was killed and four others, including a businessman from
Kashmir, got injured after a vehicle, they were travelling in, met with an accident in
Haryana's Karnal city on Thursday.

As per details, an accident took place after a truck collided with vehicle in Karnal
city, leaving a person dead and injuring four others. While identity of deceased
besides three other non-Kashmiri persons could not be immediately ascertained, an
injured person from Kashmir was later identified as Nissar Ahmad Peer (40), son
of Ashiq Hussain Peer, a resident of Kulmuna, Kupwara. The injured were rushed
to a nearby health facility for treatment.

Army Jawan dies, 4 injured in Kupwara mishap

SRINAGAR: An Army Jawan was killed while four others got injured after a vehi-
cle, they were travelling in, met with an accident in Kupwara district.

As per details, an army vehicle carrying personnel from 21 Mahar Regiment
turned turtle near Sarkulli, while on way from Machil. Five army personnel sus-
tained injuries and were evacuated to 168 Military Hospital Drugnalla for treat-
ment, however one of them was declared as dead on arrival by doctors.

Forest Guard suspended after recovery of illicit timber

SRINAGAR: Authorities on Thursday placed a forest guard under suspension after
recovery of illicit timber in Kupwara district. "Consequent upon receipt of reports
regarding seizure of about 90 cfts of Kail timber (sawn), outturn of 3 damaged
trees, in compartment 79/NL of Doban Beat of Khurhama Block, prima facie active
connivance of concerned field staff in listed-up forest damages, pending departmen-
tal enquiry, Mohd Abass Khan, Forest Guard (I/C Beat Guard, Doban Beat) is here-
by placed under suspension," Divisional Forest Officer, Kamraj Forest Division
Zagli Kupwara said in an order. Khan has been attached with Forest Check Post,
Kulngam with immediate effect.

"Fairoz Ahmad Marazi, Range Officer, North Lolab will conduct in-depth enquiry
in matter and submit report after conducting thorough checking of the entire con-
cerned forests within 3 days positively," the order added.

**Truck hits police vehicle, car; retired ASI
killed, cops among 5 injured**

JAMMU: A retired ASI was killed while cops among 5 other got injured after a
truck hit a police vehicle and a car parked on roadside in Gangyal area.

As per details, a car hit a stranded water tanker near Gangyal, following which a
police van came to the spot and started enquiring matter. In the meantime, a speed-
ing truck hit both the vehicles, injuring 6 persons including cops. They were shifted
to hospital where doctors declared one of them as brought dead. The deceased were
identified as Rampal, son of Dhanuram, resident of Bishnah, a retired ASI while
injured were identified as SgCT Makhana Lal of Gangyal Police Station, resident of
Kathua; Cont Naresh Kumar, resident of Billawar; ASI Krishan Kumar, resident of
Jammu; Anil Kumar, resident of Digiana and Surinder Kumar.

3 batteries stolen

JAMMU: Batteries of three vehicles were stolen in Jandiyl area of Gharota.

their houses.

Meanwhile, thieves also stole battery from a tubewell of Jal Shakti Deptt in
Khandwal area of Satwari. Police has registered all cases and started investigation.

Missing Army Jawan found dead in Budgam

SRINAGAR: An Army Jawan, who went missing three days back, was found dead
in an orchard in Budgam on Thursday, officials said. Sameer Ahmad Malla, went
missing from his village Lokipora in Khag area on Monday. His body had no bullet
marks but showed signs of blunt injuries, officials said. A preliminary examination
indicated that he was hit with a rod on his face, killed and later buried. 28-year-old
Jammu and Kashmir Light Infantry soldier; who was posted in Jammu, was on
leave to be with his wife for birth of their second child, the officials said. He last
spoke to his mother from mobile, saying that the phone battery was running low and
he would call her if they get disconnected.
