

Div Com reviews Shri Amarnathji Yatra arrangements

SASB to use RFID for tracking of pilgrims, vehicles during Yatra; online registrations to start from April 2022

JAMMU: Divisional Commissioner Jammu, Dr Raghav Langer on Thursday reviewed the arrangements for upcoming Shri Amarnath ji Yatra 2022 here at a meeting of concerned Deputy Commissioners and line departments. The meeting was attended in person by Director Tourism Jammu, Vivekanand Rai; DIG CRPF, SSP Jammu, Chandan Kohli; SSP Security; Additional CEO Shri Amarnath Ji Shrine Board, Rahul Singh; Directors of ULB, FCS&CA, Chief Engineer JPDCL, Joint Director Information, ADC Jammu, RTO Jammu besides senior officers of JKRTC, BSNL, JMC, PWD and other concerned Departments while Deputy Commissioners of Kathua, Samba, Udhampur and Ramban along with concerned officers participated through video conferencing.

The Div Com emphasized upon the need to make adequate arrangements well in advance by working in close coordination for smooth conduct of Yatra. Directions were passed for sanitation and start of work on face lifting of Yatri Niwas, toilet complex and langer sheds at Bhagwati

places for langers and accommodation of devotees, vehicles holding in their respective districts. The DCs were also directed to ensure availability of CCTVs, Lighting and genset arrangements at Langer sites.

The Additional CEO Shri Amarnath Ji Shrine Board informed that to ensure the safety of Amarnath Yatris, the board has decided to use Radio frequency Identification (RFID) for tracking movement of vehicles and pilgrims during this year's pilgrimage to the revered Shrine. The RFID tag cards will be issued to all the pilgrims.

Regarding registration, it was informed that online registration will start through banks in the month of April 2022 with a limit of 20000 registrations fixed per day, while on spot registrations will also be held at designated counters during Yatra days. The Div Com instructed the DCs to install an adequate number of toilets; water coolers en-route highway for convenience of the pilgrims.

He further instructed all the concerned departments to start the preparedness to ensure that all necessary arrangements are put in place well in advance.

PIL regarding encroachments by shopkeepers: DB seeks details of scheme, action plan for removing violations

JAMMU: In a Public Interest Litigation filed by Jagdish Chander Gupta to highlight illegal encroachments by shopkeepers and others in JDA Shopping Complex, Mohalla Old Hospital Road, Near City Chowk Jammu and also in other areas adjoining the same, a Division Bench of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court comprising Chief Justice Pankaj Mital and Justice Sindhu Sharma after hearing Adv Ajay Sharma and Adv Meenakshi Salathia for PIL whereas Adv Harshwardhan Gupta for JMC and Sr. AAG S S Nanda for UT, directed

respondents to come out clearly with details of scheme and action plan drawn for removing all encroachments made by shopkeepers who have extended their shops on public way and how respondents wish to tackle the problem so that the encroachments once removed, may not occur again.

When the PIL came-up for hearing, Adv Harshwardhan Gupta and Sr AAG S S Nanda filed affidavits, stating that Rules under Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act 2014 have been notified to be implemented from

January 29, 2021 and so is Model Scheme framed there under. After going through the affidavit, DB observed that aforesaid Rules and Scheme is not sufficient to take care of the menace of encroachment by the shopkeepers.

DB observed that petition seeks removal of all encroachments made by the shopkeepers from every shopping complex, mohalla and road. In this connection, one of status reports revealed that 242 notices were issued to encroachers for removal of encroachments but the outcome has not been informed so far.
