It is for the information of general public that the Rural Development Department is going to finalize the draft guidelines for incurring expenditure out of Own Source Resources (OSR) of Panchayats in J&K.

The intelligentsia of the UT and the stake holders in particular are requested to go through the draft guidelines and pool their valuable comments/ inputs so that these guidelines are finalized and notified at the earliest.

The comments/inputs in this regard, if any, shall be furnished through email on jnkpanchayat@gmail.com by or before **31st March, 2022** after which no such comments/inputs shall be entertained.

Draft guidelines for OSR

Section-14 of the J&K Panchayati Raj Act, 1989, provides that every Halqa Panchayat shall have a fund to be called "Halqa Panchayat Fund". Section-15 of the Act empowers the Panchayats to levy fee on several items Section-21 of the Act lays down the procedure for the preparation and approval of annual budget for Halqa Panchayat.

Further, Section-13 provides for several assets, which have been made property of the Halqa Panchayat from which also the Halqa Panchayat can earn revenue. Rule 89 to 94 of the Jammu & Kashmir Panchayat Raj Rule-1996 provides for the procedure for preparation of the Panchayat Budget.

With the passage of time, and empowerment of Panchayats, the Panchayats shall acquire considerable funds as their own revenue and, therefore, it is required that clear guidelines/rules to be laid down for the purpose.

In light of the above, the following guidelines for utilization of own resources, revenue raised by the Panchayats are recommended:-

I. Every Panchayat shall maintain a separate account for each scheme under which funds are transferred to it e.g. 14th FC, 15th FC Mid Day Meal Scheme, KDs, Jal Shakti etc. and also maintain separate books of accounts including cash book for each scheme under double entry system of accounts.

II. The Own Source Revenue account shall be different from all other accounts and its books of accounts shall also be maintained separately.

III. The fund under Own Source Revenue shall be utilized as per a separate budget prepared and approved in Ward Sabhas and Gram Sabhas, and priorities decided for the same. The procedure for calling a meeting of Ward Sarpanches/Gram Sabhas shall be as prescribed under the Act/Rules within a minimum quorum of 1/10 of total members. The Annual Budget shall be prepared in accordance with provisions of Section-21 of the J&K Panchayati Raj Act, 1989 and Chapter-VI of the J&K Panchayati Raj Rule-1996.

IV. The option of GIS planning is available under e-Gram Swaraj Portal which should be utilized for planning activities.

V. The annual budget for Own Source Revenue shall also form a part of the Gram Panchayat Development Plan.

VI. The Gram Sabha/Panchayat shall accord priority to:-

i. SC/ST women/minority welfare programmes/schemes and income enhancing and livelihood support activities like agriculture, horticulture, animal/sheep husbandry, fisheries etc.

ii. Addressing critical gaps identified during Mission Antyodaya Survey.

iii. Repair of Government/community assets and any serious educational/health issue facing the Panchayat.

iv. Critical gap funding/bridge financing for different Centrally Sponsored Scheme and UT Government Schemes where funds are inadequate for completion of a project.

v. Whenever new constructions are taken up, they should always be for community benefit and civic amenities creation and preferably revenue generating activities.

vi. Any scheme being implemented on priority by the Government should automatically be prioritized by said Panchayat.

VII. In case of urgency, if any activity is to be taken up outside the annual budget prepared, the Panchayat shall call a special meeting of the Gram Sabha and get the activities approved.

VIII. The Government may notify priority areas for expenditure from Own Source Revenue from time to time

IX. Panchayats may incur expenditure on any of the subjects transferred to them under Schedule-I(A) of the J&K Panchayati Raj Act,1989 after Approval of the Gram Sabha and as per priorities notified. In case of constructions activities, tendering guidelines shall be followed for activities costing above Rs. 3.00 as provide under Rule- 49

(X) The Panchayats shall exercise all financial prudence and follow GFR while spending the Own Source Revenue Fund. Private Assets shall not be repaired/constructed by Panchayat Funds, under any circumstances.

(XI) No donation /Charity work/social assistance etc. can be carried out of the OSR funds.

(XII) The Panchayats shall maintain a complete file for every work taken up from Own Resource Revenue including pre, during and, post execution photographs, and shall follow all guidelines prescribed by the Government from time to time. A single PDF file including all the above documents shall also be maintained for each work

XIII) The Rural Engineering (REW) shall assist the Panchayat in preparing estimates for tendering activities and preparing bills for the activities under Own Source Revenue. The procedure for which shall be same as in other activities of the Rural Development Department. The Rural Engineering Wing ensure all estimates are prepared before the preparation of annual Budget so that the figures reflected in the annual Budget are covered and no issues arises at the time of audit of Panchayat Accounts.

(XIV) If the activities are taken up by the Panchayats in convergence with any government schemes like MGNREGA, 14th FC, 15th FC etc. The guidelines of the Government scheme shall apply mutatis mutandis to the expenditure from Own Source Revenue also.

(XV) If any activity is taken exclusively from own source revenue funds then, the following guidelines shall apply:-

1. Up to Rs. 1 lac-Administrative Approval (AA) by Sarpanch jointly with Panchayat Secretary and Technical Sanction by JE

2. Up to Rs. 3 Lac- Administrative Approval by Sarpanch Jointly with Panchayat Secretary and Technical Sanction by AE.

3. Up to Rs 5.00 Lac- Administrative Approval by Panchayat and Technical Sanction by AEE.

4. Above Rs 5.00 Lac up to Rs 20.00 lac- Administrative Approval by BDC Chairperson and Technical Sanction by Ex- En.

5. Above Rs 20.00 lac up to Rs 30.00 lac- Administrative Approval by BDC Chairperson and Technical Sanction by Ex- En

6. Above Rs 30.00 lac up to Rs 50.00 lac- Administrative Approval by Chairperson of Zilla Parishad and Technical Sanction by Ex- En.

7. Above Rs 60.00 lac- Administrative Approval by Zilla Parishad and Technical Sanction by Ex- En.

In the absence of a duly constituted Panchayat, OSR would not be spent. In the Absence of BDC and Zilla Prashad the Administrative Approvals and Technical Sanction above Rs 20.00 lacs shall be as per existing system of Department of Rural Development in place.

(XVI) No activities outside the annual plan as approved by Gram Sabha can be taken up. All files for Administrative Approval at Panchayat level shall be processed by Panchayat Secretary through the Panchayat Account Assistant. All files for Administrative Approval at Block Level shall be processed through the office of BDO. All files at Zilla Parishad shall be processed through Zilla Parishad. The Powers shall be exercised at all level within the provisions of J&K Panchayati Raj Act, 1989 and Rules there under and also instructions issued by the government from time to time.

(XVII) The Panchayat shall frame a Social Audit Committee for conduct social audit of activities being undertaken through own source revenue. The Panchayat shall submit a quarterly report card of activities undertaken under OSR to the Gram Sabha with 5 days of close of every quarter along with a copy of the social audit report. The Bio- Diversity Management Committees framed at Panchayat level shall also monitor the OSR activities to ensure they are environment friendly and sustainable and NGT compliant.

(XVIII) A copy of the quarterly report/social audit report and Bio-diversity Management Committee report shall be forwarded to the BDO , DPO and CEO Zilla Prishad also.
