

DC Jammu reviews progress under District Capex Budget 2021-22

JAMMU: Deputy Commissioner Anshul Garg on Tuesday reviewed the progress of works proposed under District Capex Budget 2021-22 including DDC, BDC, PRI components.

The concerned official informed the chair that of the total 4493 proposed works 4430 have been tendered, 3387 allotted and 2170 completed. The Deputy Commissioner was informed that out of 4493 approved works, 224 works are under UT component, 204 under BDC, 208 under DDC and 3857 are under PRI component. It was further apprised that under UT component, out of 224 works, 209 were tendered, 196 allotted and 97 stand completed in all respects.

The Deputy Commissioner was further informed that out of 3857 works under PRI component, tenders of 3831 works have been floated, 2887 have been allotted and 1924 have been completed. Similarly, under the

DDC component out of 208 works, 192 were tendered, 143 allotted and 65 were completed. Under the BDC component, out of 204 works 198 were tendered, 161 allotted and 84 completed.

After taking the work wise review under all the components, the Deputy Commissioner asked the officers to formulate the District Capex Plan 2022-23 and submit the same before 20th March. He instructed the officers to complete the works proposed in next year's Capex plan within one year or maximum two years. He said that no more time will be allotted to complete the works under any circumstances. The Deputy Commissioner also asked

them to incorporate only those works in next year's Capex plan which are urgently required. He also asked them to submit the feasibility certificate along with the proposed works.

Among others, CPO Yoginder Katoch and senior officers of the concerned departments were present in the meeting.

1. The objections/representations, if any, against their rank/ category, be submitted physically at BOPEE office Jammu/Srinagar upto 17-03-2022 (till 03:00 P.M.) No objections/representations shall be entertained by the Board from any candidate after 17-03-2022.
2. The Board have received few representations from eligible candidates regarding the change of their category status already notified in the provisional merit list in Annexure "A" of Notification No. 006-BOPEE of 2022 dated 24-01-2022 and accordingly their status is updated in Annexure "A" to this Notification.
3. If Board does not receive any objections/ representations, this revised provisional merit shall be treated as final and shall accordingly be utilized for the purpose of online counselling of the candidates for filling-up of seats of Ayush/ BPT courses.
4. Online counselling for filling-up of seats under Ayush/ BPT courses-2021 shall tentatively start w.e.f. 22-03-2022 to 25-03-2022 (mid night).

IMPORTANT:

1. The names of few candidates (who have not uploaded either their domicile certificate or 12th class marks card or DOB certificate) have been provisionally included in this revised provisional merit list and shall be allowed to participate in the counselling process and in case of allotment of a seat to them, they shall have to produce the same in the allotted college along with other requisite certificates/ documents at the time of admission failing which their provisional selection, shall be cancelled on their own risk and responsibility, without any further notice to them.
2. 3. The Counselling fee for NEET-UG candidates is chargeable from candidates once only and the registered candidates who have already paid the same for counselling of MBBS/BDS courses need not to deposit the counselling fee again for AYUSH/BPT courses.
4. The candidates who have made fresh registration shall have to pay online counselling fee of Rs.1500.
5. Reservation shall be applicable in Government Ayurveda / Unani Colleges only.
6. Candidates applying for BUMS course must note that as per eligibility laid down by CCIM (Central Council of Indian Medicine) under MSE-2016 No. 11-76/2016 for admission to Bachelor of Unani Medicine & Surgery-B.U.M.S. courses, a candidate must have passed 10th standard with Urdu or Arabic or Persian language as a subject or clear the test of Urdu of 10th standard (wherever there is a provision to conduct of such test) in the entrance test conducted by the University or Board or registered Societies or Associations authorized by the Government to conduct such examination.

Consequent upon the conduct of second round of counselling (physical) from 08-03-2022 to 11-03-2022 in pursuance of Notification No. 021-BOPEE of 2022 dated 05-03-2022 and on the basis of merit cum preferences and application of reservation rules, the list of candidates upgraded/selected provisionally for undergoing MBBS/BDS courses 2021 in various colleges of UT of J&K, is hereby notified as per **Annexure "A"** to this notification which shall be available on website of the Board <http://www.jkbopee.gov.in> only. The College Authorities shall keep their admission counters open even on holidays/ off days and designate Nodal Officers to facilitate the candidates in the process of admission. They shall also request their concerned Bank Branches to keep their Branches open on the holidays also to enable the candidates to make payment of fee on such days. However, the candidates should, in their own interest, avoid waiting for the last day to complete the admission formalities as such delay has the potential of causing hardships to the candidates only.

The Colleges shall submit the shortfall, if any, by 15th of March, 2022 upto 05:00 P.M. positively to enable the Board to take further necessary action in the matter.

Note:-

1. The admission of the candidates is purely provisional and shall be liable to be cancelled in case any information furnished by any candidate proves to be false/fabricated, and action as warranted under law shall be initiated against such candidate.
2. The candidates can join at their respective allotted colleges/institutions both through offline/online mode. In case of online joining the candidates should send their confirmatory e-mail regarding acceptance of seat and up-load scanned copies of all relevant / required documents / certificates subject to verification by the respective college/institution and pay the requisite fees online to the account of the college mentioned in Annexure "B" to the Notification No.016-BOPEE of 2022 dated 27-02-2022.

The concerned Colleges/ Institutions shall ensure that, any person with disability, if selected in open merit or some reserved category constitute a special Medical Board to assess such candidates and make recommendations based on which colleges shall take further necessary action. In case any such candidate does not fulfill the bench marks of eligibility, he/ she shall not be admitted to the course/college and the matter shall be reported to the BOPEE.
