

# Samoon calls for expediting works on ITIs

JAMMU: Principal Secretary, Skill Development Department, Dr. Asgar Hassan Samoon, on Wednesday chaired a meeting to review targets achieved by the department between November and March months of the current financial year here at Civil Secretariat.  
Principal Secretary was apprised that the constitution of Institute Management Committee for Model ITI Jammu has been drafted.  
Dr Samoon directed for conducting timely meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC). He also directed the respective officers to make list of top ITIs of the UT for further development activities.  
Principal Secretary was also apprised of employing Management Interface System (MIS) for tracking pass outs from various

skill institutes under PMKVY 3.0.  
He asked the executing agencies to complete pending and languishing works being executed on ITIs in all the districts of Jammu and Kashmir.  
He called for efficient and judicious utilisation of funds and sought monthly progress reports from the executing agencies.  
Samoon also directed the

executing agency to expeditiously complete allied works on model ITIs including construction of approach roads, water and electricity connections etc.

It is hereby notified for the information of all the concerned candidates that the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India has lowered the percentile cut off marks for NEET PG to 35th percentile for General Category, candidates, 30th percentile for persons with disability (UR) and 25th percentile for SC/ST/OBC category candidates for the academic year 2020-21.  
Consequent upon the above, corresponding cut off score for eligibility is now notified as under:-  
General (UR/EWS) = 247 Score  
Reserved Category (SC/ST/OSC/RBA/ALC/PSP) = 210 Score  
UR-PWD = 229 Score  
The candidates who fall within the ambit of said revised percentile score and are willing to participate in the special round of counselling against the following unfilled seats shall register themselves and submit their documents as notified vide Notification No. 002-BOPEE of 2022 dated 08-01-2022 physically in Board Office Srinagar/Jammu w.e.f. 16-03-2022 to 18-03-2022 (till 03:00 P.M.) and any eligible candidate, who has not registered earlier and does not figure in the UT merit list of 2021 but wants to be considered against the following unfilled seats/seats fallen vacant due to non-joining of candidates may also report for registration within the prescribed time schedule indicated hereinabove.

i. The candidates are also advised to report at BOPEE Office, Jammu/Srinagar along with original documents and also one set of Xerox copy of self-attested documents/certificates for registration purposes.

ii. Mere registration of candidates does not confer any right to have a claim on any vacant seat(s) which as of now are to be filled up on the basis of the available candidates in the BOPEE Office and willing to opt for a seat subject to the merit/preference of the candidates.

iii. Counselling will be held at BOPEE office Jammu/ Srinagar simultaneously on 22-03-2022

iv. The eligible and willing candidates are advised to report in the BOPEE office Jammu/Srinagar for registration and fulfillment of other formalities from 09:00 A.M. upto 10:00 A.M. on 22-03-2022 for counselling and candidates are advised to see seat matrix a day before counselling.

v. The candidates who are participating for the first time in the counselling process shall have to deposit a fee of Rs.2000/- (Rs. two thousands only) as a counselling fee at the time of registration. However, the payment shall be made through POS machine available in the BOPEE Office by using credit/debit card.

The following shall be eligible to participate in this special round of physical counselling:-

1 Candidates who have not been allotted a seat during the 1st / 2nd / Mop up round of counselling can participate in this special round of counselling in terms of conditions contained in the Information Brochure.

2 Candidates who have been allotted a seat during 1st / 2nd round of counselling and have joined the college but have not been upgraded during the mop up round and those candidates who have been allotted seat during the mop up round of counselling and have joined the college/institution and wish to participate in this special round for purpose of upgradation. However, any candidate who has been upgraded during the 2nd / Mop up round shall under no circumstances be eligible to participate in the special round.

3 The candidate(s) who will be allotted seat(s) during this special round of counselling shall have to necessarily join the college/institution upto the last date fixed by the Board. However, such candidates, who do not join the college upto to the prescribed date or resign subsequently, will attract penal provisions under SRO 48 of 2018 dated 30-01-2018 and shall be debarred for 3/2 years as the case may be as laid down in the said SRO and also reiterated by the Board from time to time .

The candidates should, therefore, take a conscious decision about participation in the special round of counselling for allotment/upgradation of a seat;

4 The candidates should go through all relevant Notifications/Notices along with the e-Brochure notified by the Board with particular reference to the mop-up round of counselling;

5 The candidates who have already resigned against the seats allotted to them during first/second rounds of counselling shall not be eligible to participate in the mop up round of counselling.

6 The candidates, who have joined ASCOMS under HM/NRI/OM Quota and are desirous to participate in the mop up round against seats available in Government Institutions shall be eligible to participate in the mop up round.

7 The candidates who have been upgraded / allotted seats during mop-up round of counselling but failed to join the respective college shall not be eligible for this special round of counselling.

8 Seat Matrix shall be uploaded a day before start of counselling

9 The other terms and conditions shall remain the same as contained in the e-information Brochure, Notifications/ Notices issued by the Board from time to time in this regards.
