HYDERABAD: Mining major NMDC became the first company in the country to cross 40 million tonnes (MT) iron ore production in a year. From a production of 4 MTPA in the late 1960s to 40 million tonnes (MT) now, the growth trajectory of the largest iron ore producer of the country has been exceptional.
