

CRIME REPORT

3 notorious drug peddlers arrested; another booked under PSA

KUPWARA: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Sunday arrested 3 notorious drug peddlers in Kupwara and recovered contraband substances from their possession. Besides, booked another drug peddler under PSA. As per the details, based on specific input about drug peddling, a police party from Police Post Drugmulla led by SHO Police Station Kupwara SI Rafiq Lone at a checkpoint established at Bumhama near FCI in presence of concerned Magistrate intercepted a person identified as Ashiq Ahmad Rather son of Habibullah Rather resident of Kandi. During checking, officers were able to recover 200 grams of Charas like substance from his possession. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Meanwhile in another action, a police party of Police Station Kupwara at a checkpoint established at Regipora crossing intercepted a suspicious person identified as Waseem Ahmed Kaboo son of Farooq Ahmed kaboo resident of Maratgaam, Handwara. During checking, officers were able to recover 20 grams of brown sugar like substance from his possession. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody. During questioning the accused person disclosed that he was contacted by some drug addicts of Kupwara area to deliver the drugs.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered in Police Station Kupwara and further investigations in the cases are going on and more arrests are expected.

Moreover, another drug peddler identified as Hilal Rashid Khan son of Abdul Rashid Khan resident of Maidanpora Lolab was today detained under Public Safety Act by Kupwara Police after obtaining sanctions from the concerned authorities. He was involved in peddling of narcotics and other criminal cases in the jurisdiction of Police Station Lalpora Kupwara. Apart from his involvement in several FIRs, the accused had created an atmosphere of terror and fear among general public of the area. Meanwhile, a party of Police Station Pampore at a checkpoint established at Galander Crossing intercepted a suspicious person identified as Adil Ahmad Bhat alias Taigo son of Ab Majeed Bhat resident of Tulbagh Pampore. During checking, officers were able to recover 3Kgs of grinded Cannabis from his possession. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR number 27/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at PS Pampore and investigation has been initiated.

4 gamblers arrested; stake money seized

BARAMULLA: Acting tough against social crimes, Police on Sunday arrested 4 gamblers and seized stake money from their possession.

As per the details, acting on specific information, a police party from Police Station Baramulla raided a gambling site at Kanthbagh, Baramulla following inputs about gambling activities and apprehended 04 gamblers. They have been identified as Mudasir Ahmad Yatoo son of Gh Nabi Yatoo resident of Kanispora, Ab Ahad Tantray son of Ab Aziz Tantray resident of Kanthbagh, Rayees Ahmad Sheikh son of Khazir Mohammad Sheikh resident of Seelo Sopore and Mukhtar Ahmad Hajam son of Alam Hajam resident of Anderkote Sumbal.

Officers have seized stake money of Rs 14,500 and playing cards from the gamblers. They have been shifted to police station where they remain in custody.

Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law has been registered in Police Station Baramulla and further investigation has been initiated.

4 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized

RAMBAN: District Mineral Officer(DMO), Ramban, Kulwant Singh on Sunday seized 4 vehicles used in illegal mining and transportation of minor minerals, during raids in different areas of Sub-Division Ramsoo and Banihal.

On the directions of the Deputy Commissioner, Ramban Mussarat Islam, the DMO along with his team conducted raids and vehicles including 2 dumpers, 1 excavator and screener used in illegal mining, transportation of raw materials were seized. "The Team also recommended to impose a heavy fine on the violators.

"We are trying to discourage the menace of illegal mining and as per the direction of the DC, a massive drive has been launched across the district ", he added.

The DMO advised consumers to purchase minerals from legal sources only and stay away from illegal miners. He warned that FIR will be lodged against habitual violators if found involved in illegal transportation of minerals second time.

4 arrested with Charas, heroin

JAMMU: Police on Sunday recovered 500 grams of Ganja and 11 grams of heroin

from four drug peddlers.

As per the details, a team of Police Station Gandhi Nagar led by SHO GandhiNagar Inspr Pankaj Sharma intercepted a vehicle (JK05C 4047) driven by Abid Hussain Shiekh, son of Ghulam Mohi-ul-Din Shiekh, resident of Chersoo Awantipora, Pulwama. During search, 500 grams of Charas was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 65/2022 under section 8/20/25 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Gandhi Nagar. The arrest and recoveries were made under the supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma.

Similarly at another Naka by team of Police Post Sidhra constituted under the supervision of SDPO Nagrota Pardeep Kumar and led by SHO Nagrota Inspr Vishav Pratap Singh assisted by In-Charge Police Post Sidhra SI Shakil Ahmed, police rounded up three different suspects at Asarabad area and Sidhra bridge Naka. During search,11 grams of heroin was recovered from their possession.

Accused identified as Pawan Singh, son of Vakeel Singh, resident of Sherpur Katra; Tasleem Arif, son of Javed Ahmed and Mohammad Asgar, son of Mohammad Akbar , both resident of Nardani Bantalab Jammu, were arrested and case under relevant section of law was registered against them.

Vehicle theft case solved; 2 arrested, stolen vehicles worth Rs 40 lakh recovered

JAMMU: Two thieves involved in multiple vehicle thefts in Narwal area have been arrested and stolen vehicles worth Rs 40 lakhs have been recovered from their possession.

As per the details, a complaint was lodged at Police Post Narwal by one person namely Dhiraj Janwal, son of Rashpal Singh Janwal, resident of Sadyal Kharamadhana Samba stating that his truck (JK02BG/5942) cost worth Rs 20 lakh was stolen from Transport Nagar, Narwal, Jammu.

On this information, FIR No. 73/2022 under section 379 IPC was registered at Police Station Bahu Fort and investigation started.

After this, a team of Police Station Bahu Fort under the supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari led by SHO Bahu Fort Inspr Nayat Ali assisted by In-Charge Police Post Narwal SI Aechal Rana did strenuous efforts and with the help of CCTV footages of the area finally rounded up two suspects namely Karun Verma, son of Hukum Chand, resident of Tikri Udhampur and Kamal Kishore, son of Chuni Lal, resident of Majalta Jammu.

During sustained questioning, accused confessed their involvement in the above case and on their disclosure stolen truck was recovered from their possession. Also, they confessed their involvement in an earlier theft case in case FIR No. 116/2021 under section 379 IPC of Police Station Bahu Fort and therefore one Tanker (JK02AG/3754) worth Rs 20 lakhs involved in this case was also recovered from their possession. The recovery and arrest was done under the supervision of SP South Mamta Sharma.

Drug peddler nabbed with over 15 kgs of charas

KATHUA: Police on Sunday recovered approx. 15.114 kilograms of Charas like narcotics near Tourism Building Lakhampur; arrested the accused and seized the vehiele in this connection. As per the details, on the overall directions of SSP Kathua, R.C Kotwal, a team of Police Station Lakhampur led by Insp. Vijay Kotwal SHO Lakhampur under the supervision of DySP DAR Kathua Sukhdev Singh during patrolling/ Naka checking duty near Tourism Building Lakhampur noticed one suspicious Truck (JK13F-4897) being driven by a person namely Manzoor Ahmed Darzi, son of Abdul Aziz Darzi, resident of Pinjoor Tehsil & District Shopian enrouted from Srinagar towards Punjab was directed to stop for checking. On Physical search, approximately 15.114 kilograms of Charas like narcotics was recovered from his possession. The accused was arrested on the spot and FIR No. 32/2022 under section 8/20 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Lakhampur.
