

Harvesting of tomatoes begins at Krishi Bhawan Jammu

JAMMU: Director Agriculture Production & Farmers Welfare Jammu, K. K. Sharma on Sunday inaugurated the first picking of Tomatoes being grown under protected conditions here at Krishi Bhawan Talab Tillo.

Tomatoes besides, Coloured Bellpeppers, Seedless Cucumbers have been grown under Naturally Ventilated Polygreen House (NVPGH) structure using advanced vegetable cultivation practices for demonstration and popularization among the farmers.
