

CRIME REPORT**3 drug peddlers arrested; psychotropic substances recovered****STATE TIMES NEWS**

SOPORE: To eradicate menace of drugs from society, Police on Tuesday arrested 3 drug peddlers in Sopore and recovered psychotropic substance from their possession. As per details, a party from Police Station Sopore led by SHO Sopore at a checkpoint established at Chinkipora Sopore intercepted two suspects from whom possession 840 Spasmoproyvon tablets were recovered. They were arrested and shifted to police station where they remained in custody. In another action, a police party of Police Post Warpora at a checkpoint established at Warpora arrested a drug peddler identified as Bilal Ahmad Rather, son of Abdul Qayoom, resident of Dangerpora, Sopore. During search, 672 capsules of Spasmoproyvon were recovered from his possession.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law were registered at Police Station Sopore and investigation started.

Two notorious illicit liquor smugglers arrested; 22 lts Hooch recovered**STATE TIMES NEWS**


REASI: Continuing drive against drug abuse and illicit liquor, a party of Police Post Dera Baba laid a surprise Naka at Bhaber Brahma and intercepted a suspect, who on seeing police tried to flee. On search, 20 lts illicit liquor (Hooch) was recovered from his possession. The accused, identified as Charan Singh, son of Baldev Singh, resident of Bhaber Brahma, Reasi, was arrested and FIR No. 77/2022 under sections 48(A)/50 of Excise Act was registered at Police Station Reasi. Further investigation is going in to unearth other forward and backward linkages of smuggler.

Pertinently, accused Charan Singh is a notorious illicit liquor smuggler of area, already arrested in FIR No. 102/2021 registered under sections 48(E) of Excise Act, 307/336/34 of IPC at Police Station Reasi and facing trial.

In another incident, a team from Police Station Arnas also apprehended a suspect identified as Karnai Singh, son of Dewan Singh, resident of Jig Arnas during routine Naka checking along with 2 lts illicit liquor. FIR No. 37/2022 under section 48(A) of Excise Act was registered at Police Station Arnas.

Two missing girls reunited with families by Jammu Police**STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU: Police on Tuesday traced two missing girls and reunited them with their families.



As per details, two missing reports were lodged in two different Police stations of Jammu District regarding missing of two girls by their legal heirs stating that they went missing from their respective homes.

On this two different missing reports i.e., a missing report was registered at Police Station Jhajjar Kotli on January 16, 2022 while another was registered at Police Station on September 18, 2020. After this, special police teams of concerned police stations were constituted.

Finally after hectic efforts and with help of CCTV footages of area, both missing women were traced. The recoveries were made under by teams led by SHO Jhajjar Kotli Insp. Devinder Singh and SHO Nowabadi Insp. Vijay Kumar in their respective jurisdictions.

Subsequently families of missing women were informed and they were handed over to their respective families after completion of all legal formalities.

Three absconders nabbed**STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU/SURANKOTE: Police on Tuesday nabbed three absconders who were evading arrest since long.

As per details, an information was received at Police Station Bahu Fort through reliable sources regarding an absconder namely Sardar Gurcharn Singh, son of Puran Singh, resident of Pouri Parth Reasi Jammu who was evading his arrest since 18 years i.e., 1994 in FIR No. 163/1992 registered under section 304-A of RPC at Police Station Bahu Fort Jammu.

On this, a team of Police Station Bahu Fort under supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari led by SHO Bahu Fort Insp. Nayat Ali, after putting in strenuous efforts, arrested the accused from Reasi area. It is pertinent to mention that a warrant under section 512 of CrPC was issued by the court of Addl. Munsif Forest Court Jammu against accused since October 18, 1994. The absconder shall be produced before the Court for further proceedings.

Meanwhile, 2 absconders namely Abdul Razak, son of Mohd Rashid, resident of Mohra Bachai Tehsil Surankote, who were evading arrest since 2019 in FIR No. 294/2019 registered under sections 366/376 of IPC at Police Station Surankote and Mohd Sharif, son of Lal Din, resident of Samote Tehsil Surankote who was evading his arrest since 2016 in FIR No. 205/2016 registered under sections 468/380/323 of RPC at Police Station Surankote were arrested and produced before the Session Court Poonch.

The police teams of Police Stations Jhajjar Kotli, Domana, Akhmoor, Gharota and Police Post Sainik colony acted stringently on specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 8 different vehicles involved in illegal mining.
