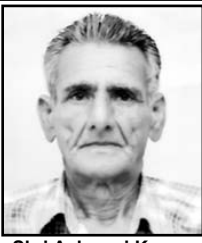

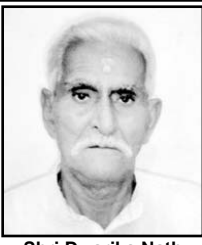

CRIME REPORT

Inter-state gang busted; 3 arrested, 7 stolen vehicles recovered

JAMMU: Police on Wednesday achieved a major success by recovering 7 stolen vehicles i.e., 4 vehicles from an inter-state gang operating in Satwari and 3 vehicles from a thief in Canal road. Three accused were also arrested.

As per details, information was received at Police Station Satwari regarding two persons identified as Ram Narayan, son of Kalu Ram, resident of Bhamuja Tehsil Barisadri, District Chittorgarh (Rajasthan) and Nitin Sharma, son of Ashwani Sharma, resident of village Mehmoodpur District Anbala (Haryana), presently living in rented accommodations at Jeevan Nagar and Sanjay Nagar respectively and were involved in illegal trade of stolen vehicles. On this, FIR No 52/2022 under sections 420/467/468/471/2/120B of IPC was registered and investigation started. A team from Police Station Satwari under the supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma was constituted, which, led by SHO Satwari Inspr Sameer Jeelani, arrested both the accused.

During sustained questioning, accused confessed their involvement in crime and on their disclosure stolen vehicles along with a lot of fake documents were recovered from their possession which included a Hyundai Creta (HR 51BH 1059); Maruti Baleno (UK3B 9619); Maruti Brezza (MH12NU 4392) and Maruti Desire (HR26DF 1397). It is pertinent to mention that accused used to bring stolen vehicles from outside J&K and then use fake registration numbers/plates and fake documentation to sell the same thereby running an inter-state racket. Thorough questioning is going on and more arrests are likely in coming days.

Similarly, a complaint was lodged at Police Post Canal regarding theft of vehicle in area. On this, FIR No 30/22 under section 379 IPC was registered at Police Station Nowabad and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Post Canal Road under supervision of DySP Hqrs led by SHO Nowabad Inspr Vijay Kumar assisted by Incharge Police Post Canal Road PSI Ishfaq Ahmed Kasana, after putting in strenuous efforts and with help of analysis of CCTV footages of area, rounded up a suspect later identified as Vishal Kumar alias Bobby, son of Dewan Chand, resident of Jahu Chak. During intensive questioning accused confessed his crime and on his disclosure three stolen vehicles along with a master key was recovered. The recovered vehicles included a Maestro Scooty (JK 02 BN 5338); Yamaha FZ M/cycle (JK 02 AX 8828) and Super Splendor (JK02 BX 6955). The overall arrests and recoveries in cases were made under the supervision of SP South Mamta Sharma and SP North Kulbir Handa.

7 drug peddlers arrested with haul of contraband

SRINAGAR: To eradicate menace of drugs from society, Police on Wednesday arrested 7 drug peddlers in a series of actions across Kashmir valley. Contraband substances were also recovered from their possession.

In Awantipora, acting on specific information, a party from Police Station Pampore headed by SHO Pampore at a special checkpoint established at Patalbagh Pampore intercepted 2 suspects identified as Adil Mir alias Magarnmach, son of Bashir Ahmad Mir and Adil Ahmad Bhat alias Gabru, son of Farooq Ahmad Bhat, both residents of Litterbal Pampore. During checking, 4 Kg grinded cannabis was recovered from their possession.

In Kulgam, a party from Police Station Kulgam at a checkpoint established at Chatalab Crossing intercepted a vehicle (PB10GZ-3462). During checking, 2 gunny bags containing 17 Kg Poppy Straw like substance was recovered from possession of the driver; identified as Bidh Singh, son of Balbir Singh, resident of Ludhiana, Punjab and Manjeet Singh, son of Nirmal Singh, resident of Nawanshahar Punjab.

Similarly, at another checkpoint established at Yamrach, a party from Police Station Behibagh intercepted a motorcycle (JK05-7926) driven by one Intiyaz Ahmad Palla, son of Abdul Ahad Palla, resident of Reban, Shopian. During checking 16 Kg Poppy Straw like substance concealed in a gunny bag was recovered from



him.

Meanwhile in Pulwama, on a tip off, a party of Police Station Rajpora at a surprise checkpoint established at Cheeki Badri Nath Rajpora intercepted a vehicle (JK01V-9211) with two persons onboard, who were identified as Javid Ahmad Matoo, son of Wali Mohd Matoo & Nisar Ahmad Das, son of Ahmadullah Das, both residents of Bijbehara, Anantnag. During checking, 6 Kg poppy straw was recovered from vehicle.

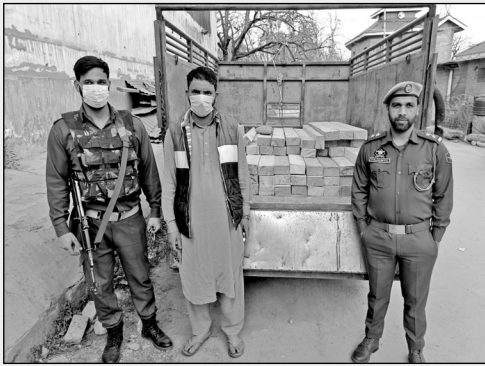
All drug peddlers were arrested and shifted to respective police stations where they remained in custody. Besides, vehicles used in crime were also seized. Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law were registered at respective police stations and investigation started.

Timber smuggler arrested

He has been shifted to Police Station where he remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 18/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Rajpora and investigation started.

RAMBAN: Police on Wednesday traced a missing woman and reunited her with family at Ramban.

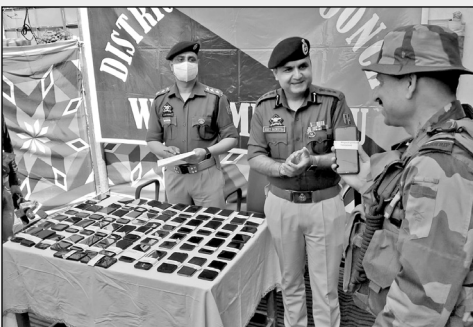

Army Jawan commits suicide
