**4 packets of narcotics like substance found from load carrier, 2 held****STATE TIMES NEWS**

POONCH: Police on Thursday said that four packets of narcotics like substance were recovered from a load carrier near Baryani Army Gate area of Pooneh district. "At around 1400 hours, a Tata mobile (JK11C-9009) coming from K a g a Chaperera towards Manjakote was checked at Baryani," a police officer said, adding, "During checking four packets of narcotics like substance were recovered from vehicle." The driver of vehicle namely Shierbaz Ahmed, son of Mohammad Sarwar of Galuti Manjakote was arrested along with other person, identified as Mehmood Khan, son of Mohammad Aslam of Gulati Manjakote.

Drug peddler arrested; over 1 Kg Charas recovered**STATE TIMES NEWS**

SOPORE: Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs, Police on Thursday arrested a notorious drug peddler in Sopore and recovered huge quantity of contraband substance from his possession.

As per details, a party from Police Station Dangiwacha under the supervision of SDPO Raifabad at a checkpoint established at Bahrampora intercepted a suspect identified as Gulzar Ahmad Zargar alias Sheeda. During checking, 1.196 Kg Charas was recovered from his possession. During questioning, he disclosed that he was on way to Raifabad to sell drugs. He was arrested and shifted to police station where he remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 30/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Dangiwacha and further investigation started.

Notorious drug peddler taken into preventive custody**STATE TIMES NEWS**


DODA: Police on Thursday took a notorious drug peddler into preventive custody, who was lodged in District Jail Bhadarwah.

As per details, Amir Ahmed, son of Noor Din Malik, resident of Patti Barumulla at present Akrabad Doda, was taken into preventive custody by police on orders of Executive Magistrate Doda, as he was found involved in illegal activities especially narcotics smuggling. A detailed report of his involvement in illegal activities was prepared by Doda Police and submitted before Executive Magistrate Doda, who issued detention order under preventive sections of Law. The accused was sent to judicial custody in District Jail Bhadarwah.

She was arrested and FIR 05/2022 under section 48(A) of Excise Act was registered against them at Police Station Assar. The recovery of liquor and arrests were made by a police party under supervision of Insp Bhowinder Singh SHO Assar and Shoket Ali, DySP DAR Doda.

6 vehicles seized for illegal mining**STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU: In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police teams made a massive recovery of vehicles involved in illegal mining. The teams from Police Stations Miran Sahib, Satwari & Police Posts Canal Road, Talab Tillo and Sainik Colony acted stringently on specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 6 different vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicles included a dumper bearing Chassis No MAT802027N3A01229 seized by Miran Sahib police; a tipper (JK02CL 7471) seized by Satwari police; a tipper without registration number seized by Canal Road police; tipper (Jk02BD 6131) seized by Talab Tillo police; a dumper (JK02BW 8456) and another without registration number seized by Sainik Colony police.

It is pertinent to mention that a fine of Rs 15,606 was also imposed by Joint Director Geology and Mining Deptt Jammu on accused in Miran Sahib police station. The overall recoveries were made by SHO Miran Sahib Insp Sultan Mirza, SHO Satwari Insp Sameer Jeelani, Incharge Police Posts Canal Road PSI Ishfaq Ahmed Kasana, Talab Tillo-PSI Rajesh Kumar and Sainik Colony-PSI Bhawani Singh in their respective jurisdictions.

4 absconders arrested**STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU: Police on Thursday arrested four absconders who were evading arrest since long.

As per details, an information was received at Police Station Bishnah through reliable sources regarding two absconders namely Bashir Ahmad, son of Dalmir Ahmad and Mohd Aslam alias Slam Din, son of Mohd Qasim alias Roshan Din, both residents of Chak Agra, Tehsil R S Pura who were evading arrests since 2 years i.e., 2020 in FIR No. 169/2020 registered under section 354 of IPC at Police Station Bishnah. On this, a team from Police Station Bishnah under supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh led by SHO Bishnah Insp Vinod Kumar, put in strenuous efforts and arrested both the accused.

Similarly, an information was received at Police Station Channi Himmat about an absconder namely Tarundeep Singh, son of Isher Singh, resident of Nanak Nagar Jammu who was evading arrest since 9 years i.e., 2013 in FIR No. 22/2011 under sections 341/323 of IPC at Police Station Channi Himmat. A team of Police Station Channi Himmat under supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari led by SHO Insp Deepak Katoch, after putting in hectic efforts, arrested the accused. The absconders shall be produced before the Court for further proceedings.



He was arrested in the jurisdiction of Police Station Billawar. As per details, on specific information, a team led by Inspector Kuldeep Raj SHO Police Station Billawar under supervision of SDPO Billawar Arvind Kumar apprehended the accused, namely Mohd Ayoub, son of Shamshdin, resident of Basohli. Further investigation is going on in the matter.
