JAMMU: Expressing anguish and concern about action taken so far regarding deportation of illegal immigrants from J&K, Col (Retired) S S Pathania, President Sainik Samaj Party (SSP), J&K said that Government seems to be in no hurry over the matter and a deafening silence is prevalent, even after passage of more than two and half years, since abrogation of Articles 370 and 35A.

In a press statement issued here on Friday, President SSP said that 60 per cent people in our country i.e., 80 crore live below poverty line and the number is likely to swell by another 10 crore, due to COVID outbreak, thereby badly hitting economical growth. Moreover, crime rate and maintenance of law & order are also other major issues which will adversely affect nation's development. "Situation in J&K UT is grimmer as report suggests that Rohingyas and Bangladeshis immigrants are already in possession of ration card, voter and Aadhar cards. J&K UT is already facing Pak-sponsored terrorism and narco-terrorism, and this double whammy, will weaken our fight against Pakistan's proxy war, if the illegal immigrants takes an anti-India stance. Election results too are likely to impact, with participation of illegal immigrants," said Pathania, urging LG and Union Government to take suitable cognizance of this threat and initiate process to start screening, making separate hold-centers and finally deporting all illegal immigrants from J&K, in a time bound manner, as any further delay will surely go against nation's interest and security.
