Man killed after getting hit by train

The body of unidentified man, hit by Varanasi Express, was found on track near Bari Brahmana on Monday, the official said, adding that body has been shifted to Government Medical College (GMC) Jammu for post-mortem and identification.

5 drug peddlers arrested, contraband recovered

SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs from society and taking stringent action against drug Peddlers, police on Tuesday arrested five drug peddlers and recovered contraband substances from their possession.
As per details, officers from Police Station Kheerbawani during routine checking at Shafa-Kadal intercepted a suspect, identified as Nisar Ahmad Rather, son of Wali Mohammad Rather, resident of Gangerhama and recovered 1 Kg Charas Powder, 50 gm Charas like substance and cash amounting to Rs 19,000, believed to be proceeds of narcotics sales, from his possession. He was arrested and shifted to police station where he remained in custody. In Avantipora, a party of Police Station Tral during routine checking at Guna Kochoa Tral intercepted a vehicle bearing chassis number MA3JMT81SMM603458 with two persons onboard, who were identified as Owais Ashraf Trag, son of Mohammad Ashraf Trag, resident of Tral and Rafiq Ahmad Sheikh, son of Ab Aziz Sheikh, resident of Machama Tral. During checking, 1,050 Spasmoproxyvon capsules were recovered from their possession. They were arrested and shifted to police station where they remained in custody and vehicle used in crime has also been seized.
Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law were registered at respective Police Stations and further investigation started.
Meanwhile, Officers from Police Station Kreeri and Police Post Wagoora under supervision of SDPO Kreeri during routine checking at Watergam Kreeri intercepted a vehicle bearing registration number JK05H-9954 with two persons onboard, identified as Ab Hamid Bhat, son of Ab Samad Bhat, resident of Hygam Sopore and Irfan Ahmad Mir, son of Gh Mohd Mir, resident of Kawcheck, Kreeri and recovered 8.5 gm Heroin like substance. They were arrested and shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Vehicle used in crime has also been seized. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Kreeri and investigation started.

Scooty rider injured in mishap

The injured was identified as 40-year-old Monika Devi, wife of Jasbir Singh, resident of Sanoora, Ghagwal. Police has registered a case for investigation.



Ramban Police's biggest operation against bovine smugglers; 828 cattle rescued, 46 vehicles seized in a day

RAMBAN: In a massive crackdown against bovine smugglers, Ramban police accomplished biggest operation till date wherein a total of 828 bovines were rescued across

districts during intervening night of March 28-29, 2022.
Acting on specific inputs of transportation of bovines, a party from Police Station Batote intercepted nine vehicles (JK03 E 5680, JK14 A 1001, JK03 G 7052, JK03 E 3720, JK14 D 3743, JK03 D 8085, JK02 AC 7289, JK03 E 3251 & HP11 4861). During checking, it was found laden with 190 bovines which were rescued and drivers were arrested on spot. FIR Nos 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61 & 62/2022 under sections 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act were registered at Police Station Batote.
In another incident, a party of Police Station Chanderkote intercepted 13 vehicles (JK03 A 8661, JK02 CD 8841, JK02 AS 7981, JK18 A 9339, JK19 5275, JK19 5655, JK02 AU 4456, JK02 AQ 3147, JK02 AR 8377, JK18 B 9459, JK18 A 0849, JK18 1226 & JK03 E 3570) and rescued 277 bovines. The drivers of vehicles were arrested and FIR Nos 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59 & 60/2022 under sections 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act were registered at Police Station Chanderkote.
In another incident, a party from Police Station Ramban intercepted 14 vehicles (JK09 A 0892, JK14 D 9626, JK03 K 3837, JK02 CV 1420, JK03 D 7537, JK18 A 9855, JK02 AT 0665, JK13 A 7659, JK03 B 8711, JK19 6981, JK18 8600, JK19 3305, JK03 E 5167 & JK02 AS 8186) and rescued 238 bovines laden in vehicles. The drivers of vehicles were arrested and FIR Nos. 99, 100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111 & 112/2022 under sections 188/109 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act were registered at Police Station Ramban. In yet another incident, a party of Police Station Ramsoo intercepted three vehicles (JK19 A 1417, JK02 AD 2747 & JK03 H 0767). During checking, 33 bovines were found laden in it, which were rescued. The drivers of vehicles were arrested on the spot and FIR Nos 32, 33 & 34/2022 under sections 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act were registered in Police Station Ramsoo. In yet another incident, a party of Police Station Banihal intercepted five (JK02 CT 5864, JK20 B 5221, JK02 CT 5899, JK02 CL 7740 & JK20 B 6452) and during checking, found them laden with 35 bovines, which were rescued. The drivers of vehicles were arrested and FIR Nos 59, 60, 61, 62 & 63/2022 under sections 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act were registered in Police Station Banihal.
In a similar incident, during routine checking, a Naka party of Police Post Jawahar Tunnel intercepted two vehicles (JK18 B 0284 and one without number). On checking of vehicles, 21 bovines were found laden in them, which were rescued. FIR Nos 64 & 65/2022 under sections 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act were registered at Police Station Banihal.
The overall rescue operation was made by police parties under command of PSI Vinod Saini Incharge Police Post Patnitop, PSI Harish Kumar IC Police Post Jawahar Tunnel, Insp Sudhir Sadotra, SHO Batote, Insp P D Singh SHO Chanderkote, Insp Sandeep Charak SHO Ramban, Insp Nazir Ahmad SHO Ramsoo & Insp Naem-ul Haq SHO Banihal, under the supervision of Pardeep Singh Sen, DySP Hqrs Ramban & Nissar Khoja SDPO Banihal, under overall supervision of SSP Ramban, Mohita Sharma.

7 bovines rescued, 7 smugglers arrested

REASI: Police on Tuesday foiled three bovine smuggling bids by rescuing 7 bovines and arrested seven smugglers at Reasi.
As per details, a team of Police post Talwara laid a surprise Naka at Dolsi-Jerri, intercepted a Tata mobile (JK20 1092) and rescued 3 bovines possession of bovine smugglers namely Talib Hussain, son of Mir Hussain; Manzoor Hussain, son of Ahmed Din and Mukesh Kumar, son of Deep Raj, all residents of Pouni, district Reasi. The accused were arrested and FIR no 80/2022 under sections 188 of IPC , 3/11 of PCA Act were registered at Police Station Reasi. Meanwhile, a team of Police Station Pouni during surprise Naka checking foiled bovines smuggling attempt in Kothian area of Pouni and rescued two bovines from a Mahindra pickup (JK 11 2072). FIR no 13/2022 under sections 188 of IPC , 3/11 of PCA Act were registered at Police Station Pouni and accused Mohd Latief, son of Mohd Ismail, resident of Marchola Tehsil Sunderbani, District Rajouri and Satish Kumar, son of Tirath Ram, resident of Siot district Rajouri were arrested.
The vehicle was also seized. In another incident, a team of Police Post Dera Baba intercepted one pickup truck (JK20B 2159) at Haji Morh and rescued two bovines from it. In this regard, FIR no 81/2022 under sections 188 of IPC, 3/11 of PCA Act were registered at Police Station Reasi.
The vehicle was seized and two bovine smugglers namely Mohd Qasim, son of Mohd Yousuf, resident of Dharmari, Arnas, and Mohd Arfan, son of Gulzar Ahmed, resident of Gool, district Ramban were arrested.

Absconder arrested
