The other participants who graced the event were Farooq Ahmad Khan, Joint Director, Skill Development, Jammu and Ravi Gupta, Assistant Director, Joint Director Office, Jammu.

Welcoming the dignitaries and participants, the Executive Director SGEPC, Tarun Dewan briefed about the training programme for Cricket Bat manufacturing in Jammu, being sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India.

The Principal Director, MSME TDC, Sunil Gupta highlighted the activities of the training programme viz duration, registration, course fee, certification etc. He also stated that the training will be conducted in four phases with each batch consisting of 25 candidates/trainees starting from March 28, 2022.

Area of 40716 ha, annual irrigation potential of 91073 ha and installed capacity of 89.5MW.

It was informed in the meeting that Shalpur Kandi Project is a national project which is being executed by the Punjab Project Authority. After completion, J&K will get its due share of 1150 cusecs of water which will provide irrigation to 32173 hectare of area.

Principal Secretary, I&FC desired to visit the project site along with all the stakeholders to have on spot assessment of all the issues like cutting of trees, land acquisition, structures involved for resolution.

He directed the concerned to complete the requisite formalities and resolve all the issues so that the work of Tawi Barrage may be

started at an earliest.

He also directed the concerned Chief Engineers to start recharging of all the canals including New Pratap Canal, Ranbir Canal, Tawi Canal, Ravi Canal and Kathua Canal from 1st of April, 2022 in a phased manner in view of approaching season of Kharif Crops.

Principal Secretary said that he along with Divisional Commissioner and District Development Commissioner Jammu will visit the Ranbir Canal to resolve the issues with the National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) and National Highway Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL) so that canal may be recharged within the given timeline.

Navin sets deadline for farmer welfare delivery

JAMMU: Principal Secretary Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Department, Navin Kumar Choudhary, on Tuesday called for achieving hundred percent coverage under flagship farmers' welfare schemes of Government of India.

Navin Choudhary, while chairing a meeting of the department held in this regard, set deadline for achieving complete saturation under schemes like PM KISAN, PM Fasal Bima Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Kisan Maan-Dhan Yojana besides providing Soil Health Cards and Kisan Credit Cards

to all farmers of the UT.

Principal Secretary directed the officers to ensure that all farmers be issued Soil Health Cards by May 31, this year. In this regard, he asked the Joint Director to monitor progress in districts and submit consolidated reports on daily basis.

Navin Choudhary, while verifying all pending applications under PM by April 20. He also directed for disposal of every new application within a period of 30 days with uploading of the respective data on government's portal. He said the district officers would be held accountable for any kind of delay in the process. Navin Choudhary,

while reviewing PM Fasal Bima Yojana, stressed the need for adopting cost efficient tendering process. He suggested that separate tenders be issued for different crop varieties.

He called for issuance of Kisan Credit Cards to all farmers including orchardists and dairy farmers of the UT by April 20 this year. He also set deadline of May 31 for providing benefits under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Maan-Dhan Yojana scheme to respective beneficiaries.

The meeting was attended by heads of agriculture department among other senior officers.
