Two bootleggers arrested, illicit liquor seized

POONCH: Foiling a bid to smuggle illicit liquor, police in Mendhar sub division of Poonch district arrested two bootleggers on Thursday and recovered 130 bottles of illicit liquor from their possession.

The accused, identified as Mehmood Ahmed, son of Mohd Aslam, resident of Behra Mendhar and Shah Nawaz, son of Mohd Taj, resident of Sangla Mendhar, were arrested on the spot. As per details, a team led by PSI Suman Sharma under the supervision of SHO Mendhar Manzoor Kohli laid a Naka and intercepted a car (JK12 5338) on Balakote road. During frisking, 130 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered and seized from vehicle. Police said that a case in FIR 40/2022 under sections 48 of Excise act was registered at Mendhar police station and further investigation is going on. In Mendhar sub division of Poonch district, Police teams headed by SDPO Sheezan Bhat under supervision of SSP Poonch Rohit Baskotra are taking every possible measure to take action against those involved in unlawful acts.



Busting of inter-district gang of vehicle-lifters; 2 more stolen vehicles recovered

BUDGAM: Police on Thursday recovered 2 more vehicles in connection with FIR number 28/2022 pertaining to busting of an Inter District Gang of vehicle lifters. Earlier, 5 accused persons were arrested & 15 stolen vehicles were recovered in the instant case.

As per the details, during the course of investigation, two more stolen vehicles with fabricated registration numbers were recovered from Padshahi Bagh area of Srinagar and Narkara area of Budgam, taking number of total recovered vehicles to 17. The vehicles included a White-coloured Scorpio S11 with fake registration number JK21F 8841 while its original registration number was DL2CAZ-6685 and Silver coloured Alto-800 with registration number JK02AD-8264. The investigation of case is still going on and more arrests & recoveries are expected.

Notorious drug peddler arrested; contraband recovered

BUDGAM: Continuing efforts to eradicate menace of drugs, Police on Thursday arrested a notorious drug peddler in Budgam and recovered contraband substance from his possession.

As per details, a party from Police Station Magam at a checkpoint established near Petrol Pump Magam intercepted a suspect carrying a polythene bag, who was identified as Irfan Ahmad Beigh, son of Manzoor Ahmed Beigh, resident of Badran Magam. During checking, 480 tablets of Spasmaproxyn Plus and 3 bottles of Codeine-based syrup were recovered from his possession. He was arrested and shifted to police station where he remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 29/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Magam and investigation started.

20 bovines rescued; 2 smugglers arrested

NOWSHERA/SAMBA: Police on Thursday foiled three bovine smuggling bids by rescuing 20 animals from clutches of 2 smugglers, who were arrested on the spot.

Police said that during intervening night of Wednesday and Thursday, police team from Kalakote police station established a Naka at Dhyala on Kalakot Rajouri road and a vehicle JK11D 8214 was signaled to stop. However, on seeing Police, driver of vehicle abandoned it some distance before Naka and escaped from spot. During checking, two bovines were found laden in vehicle which were rescued and vehicle was seized. FIR under relevant sections of law was registered in police station and manhunt has been launched to trace the accused.

In another case, Tata mobile (JK11F 3203) was intercepted by police team of Nowshera police station and two bovines, being smuggled in the vehicle, were rescued. Driver Sajid Ahmed, son of Mohammad Azam, resident of Thalka Nowshera and Yasir Khurshid, resident of Thannamandi were arrested on the spot. The vehicle was also seized and a case under relevant sections of law was registered. SSP Rajouri Mohammad Aslam said that action against bovine smugglers is one of the main priorities of police for which necessary directions stand issued to all Police Stations and Posts across the district.

Meanwhile, a party from Police Station Ghagwal led by SHO Ghagwal, Inspector Vijay Verma while performing vehicle checking duty at Naka Tapyal, signaled a truck (JK13A/ 8566) to stop, but instead of stopping vehicle, the driver accelerated the speed and jumped Naka point. However alert cops intercepted the truck just a few meters away from Naka, but the driver managed to flee. During checking, 16 cattle were found laden inside vehicle, which were rescued. FIR No. 28/2022 under section 188 IPC, 11 PCA Act was registered at Police Station Ghagwal and investigation started.

Search operation launched along border areas

Theft case solved; accused arrested, stolen cash recovered

JAMMU: Police on Thursday solved a theft case by arresting an accused and recovered stolen cash amounting to Rs 12,000.

As per details, a written complaint was lodged at Police Station Bagh-e-Bahu regarding theft in area. On this FIR No. 19/2022 under sections 454/380 of IPC was registered at Police Station Bagh-e-Bahu Jammu and investigation started.

A team of Police Station Bagh-e-Bahu under supervision of SDPO East Syed Zahaer Abbas Jafari led by SHO PS Bagh-e-Bahu Insp Arjun Singh Chib did strenuous efforts and after connecting various leads, rounded up a suspect namely Deepak Kumar alias Deepu, son of Amit Kumar alias Manga, resident of Kalka Colony Bahu Fort Jammu. During sustained questioning, accused confessed his involvement in crime and on his disclosure stolen cash amounting to Rs 12,000 was also recovered.

7 missing persons traced, reunited with families

JAMMU: Police on Thursday traced seven missing persons and reunited them with their families.

As per details, six different complaints were lodged at different Police Stations of Jammu i.e., including missing report of a woman at Police Station Gandhi Nagar; two missing reports regarding two women at Police Station Miran Sahib, one regarding missing of a girl at Police Station Janipur, another regarding missing of a girl at Police Station Domana and one missing report of a girl at Police Post Pounichak. The members of missing persons alleged that they went missing from their respective houses.

On this, special police teams were constituted who after putting in hectic efforts and with help of technical assistance along with timely human intervention, traced all missing persons successfully. The recoveries were made by SHO Gandhi Nagar Insp Pankaj Sharma, SHO Miran Sahib Insp Sultan Mirza, SHO Janipur Insp Ajaz Haider, SHO Domana Insp Mahesh Sharma and Incharge Police Post Pounichak PSI Nitish Khajuria respectively. Subsequently, families of missing persons were informed and they were handed-over to their respective family members after completing all legal formalities.

Meanwhile, District Police Samba traced a missing girl within 24 hours, whose missing report was lodged at Police Post Mansar by her father, a resident of Mansar. Acting swiftly on complaint, a team from Police Post Mansar after putting in hectic efforts traced missing girl from Jammu. After completing all legal formalities, she was handed-over to her legal heirs.

Three absconders arrested

JAMMU: Police on Thursday arrested three absconders who were evading arrest since long.

As per details, an information was received from sleuths of DSB Jammu at Police Station Nowabad regarding presence of two absconders namely Ajay Kumar, son of Amar Nath, resident of Amb Tehsil Bhalwal and Munna, son of Daleep Kumar, resident of Gandoo Di Chawani, Kanji House, Jammu, wanted in FIR No 90/2014 registered under sections 341/323/34 of RPC of Police Station Nowabad.

On this, a team of Police Station Nowabad under supervision of DySP Hqrs Swati Sharma led by SHO Nowabad Insp Rajesh Khajuria did strenuous efforts and with help of technical assistance, arrested both the absconders.

It is pertinent to mention that an arrest warrant under section 512 CrPC was also issued against aforesaid absconders by learned Sub Judge JMJC Jammu on December 6, 2018. Further investigation is going on to ascertain other activities of

these absconders since lodge of FIR.

Similarly, an information was received at Police Post Panjtirthi through reliable sources regarding an absconder namely Gurmeet Singh alias Prince, son of Anlok Singh, resident of Gadigarh, Jammu who was evading his arrest since long in FIR No 123/2020 under sections 8/15/29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Pacca Danga Jammu. After this, a team of Police Post Panjtirthi led by SHO Pacca Danga Insp Raghurib Singh assisted by SI Rahul Sharma, after putting in strenuous efforts, arrested the absconder, who will be produced before the court of 1st Additional Session Judge, Jammu.

Traffic SI, biker injured in road accident

Two narcotic-smugglers apprehended with 1.5 Kg cannabis

TA Jawan dies in mysterious firing; CRPF man dies of cardiac arrest
