

PHDCCI J&K holds webinar on 'Potential of AYUSH for universal healthcare'

JAMMU: Proposing few resolutions to promote Ayurveda, Padma Bhushan Devendra Triguna, Patron of AMAM & President of All India Ayurvedic Congress and Ayurveda Maha Sammelan said that quality of Ayurvedic services and medicine should be of utmost importance. Pradeep Multani, President, PHDCCI, while deliberating the Presidential address mentioned that J&K can be measured by historical fact that the popularity and practice of Ayurvedic System of Healthcare was established in Ancient Kashmir. "Ayurveda had been backbone of healthcare activities in past but the Universal Health coverage initiative reiterates commitment for providing health services for all the people without suffering any financial hardship," said President PHDCCI, adding that universal health coverage cannot be assured

merely through medicines, treatments, hospitals and insurance provisions. "Today 70 per cent of population spends out of own pockets for basic healthcare thus facing financial hardship but the resolutions can be provided by activities like development / upgradation of AYUSH healthcare infrastructure, AYUSH wellness tourism and AYUSH drug manufacturing which shall be carried out through private investment as per schemes laid out by Central and UT Governments," added Multani. Dr Mohan Singh, Director Indian System of Medicines Ayush Union Territory of J&K, raise some issues faced by this sector in terms of infrastructure like lack of colleges and high tech equipments for research which is a main cause for lagging behind. He also mentioned that students have to go out of UT to study Ayurvedic subjects and emphasized on opening more

colleges and universities. Earlier, Rahul Sahai Chairman PHDCCI Jammu, in his Inaugural address, set context of webinar by stating that PHDCCI tried to involve all stakeholders for presenting their views and suggestions that how policies should be made in synchronisation with stakeholders to facilitate prospects and deal with the challenges in AYUSH sector. Dr Shashi Sudan, Principal, Government Medical College Jammu, Govt Ayurvedic Medical College cum Hospital mentioned that time has come to provide adequate weightage to the traditional Indian system of medicines and to integrate Ayurveda, Unani and homeop-

athy as it prevent and cure non communicable diseases. Others who spoke on the occasion included Baldev Singh Raina, Chairman PHDCCI Kashmir; Dr Sharada Principal Jammu Institute of Ayurveda and Research; Dr Nasser Hakim, Founding Director Dr Nasser's Unani & Panchkarma Group of Hospitals; Dr Sahil Gupta, BHMS/MD Homeopathy Jammu; Prof Sheikh Bilal Ahmed, Regional Director (National Medicinal Plants Board) Regional-cum-Facilitation Center Jammu & Kashmir; Ladakh and Dr Shazia Noor, Principal Kashmir Tibbiya College Hospital and Research Center.

MJR-47 hails Govt's decision to extend relief scheme for PoJK DPs

JAMMU: Welcoming the recent decision of the Government regarding extension of relief scheme for PoJK Displace Persons till 2025-26, MGR-47 said that it was the most considered and far-sighted decision of the administration which will ameliorate sufferings of DPs seeking the claim.

In a press statement issued here, Spokesperson of the organization, Suchwant Singh said that it is more than seven decades since 1947 when DPs were uprooted from PoJK and now DPs' third and fourth generation is there, as first and majority of second-generation has left the world. "A family of 3-4 members has grown to 8-10 members in 4th generation. During all these years, most of the descendants migrated to various places for earning their livelihood. Various DPs' organisations have been urging Government to prepare a fresh record of all descendants of DPs of 1947 and issue ID cards to all descendants," he added.

Singh further said that MJR -47 would like to express gratitude towards Government's action of recognizing claim of PoJK PDs and urges for extending the scheme to 5,300 left-over families, living in other States by releasing full package of Rs 30 lakh per family in their favour. "MJR -47 also demands political representation by announcing 24 assembly seats to PoJK DPs for providing them full strength in J&K assembly in terms of Section 14 of J&K Reorganization Act, 2019," he added.

IGNOU December 2021 term-end exams to begin today

JAMMU: The December 2021 Term-end Examinations of the Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) for various Academic Programmes offered by the University will commence from March 4, 2022 and conclude on April 11, 2022. The University has established 800 Examination Centres including 19 overseas centres and 89 centres in Jails for Jail inmates.

Under Jammu Region, 32 Examination Centres have been established including four Examination Centres in District Jail Kathua, District Jail, Ambphalla, District Jail Udhampur and Central Jail, Kot Bhalwal for Jail inmates and also one Examination Centre in Northern Command

Udhampur exclusively for Army personnel. Hall Tickets (Examination Intimation Slips) have been issued to 6,76,790 eligible students who had applied for appearing in the Term-end Examinations. The hall tickets are available on IGNOU website www.ignou.ac.in. The students may download the Hall Tickets from the University website and appear in the examinations. The Examination Centres have been instructed to allow students to appear in examinations even if they do not possess the Hall Ticket (Examination Intimation Slip), but their names exist in the list of examinees for these centres. In order to avail this, however, students are advised to be in possession of the valid Identity Card issued by the University/Govt. during the Examination. Mobile phones and any other electronic gadgets are not permitted inside the examination halls.

All the Examination Centre Superintendents have been communicated to follow the Corona Protocol issued by the Govt. of India/State Governments to contain the spread of COVID-19 while conducting the examination.
