

Prpl Secy SED inspects various schools in Jammu district

JAMMU: Principal Secretary, School Education Department (SED), B.K. Singh on Sunday inspected various schools of district Jammu to take note of the day to day working in view of the recent reopening of schools for offline classes.

Director School Education Jammu, Dr. Ravi Shankar Sharma, Chief Education Officer Jammu, Suraj Singh Rathore and other officials accompanied the Principal Secretary during the visit.

On his visit to GHSS Boys Gole Gujral, Principal Secretary inaugurated the newly constructed Art & Craft Room and Computer Room. He also inaugurated Volleyball court and witnessed a friendly match there.

The Principal Secretary also announced the remodelling of the institution by opening a model 'SUPER 100' Coaching Centre for Students of Jammu division in the school with specialized teaching faculty for competitive examinations like NEET, JEE (IIT) etc. The highlight of the project is that it will host complete residential facilities within the school premises along with other amenities.

On the occasion, the Principal Secretary also announced that every year 10 seats will be reserved for the student of the school to

boost their morale and tap the enormous talent of the local students of the area.

During the visit, the local Sarpanch and other public representatives interacted with the Principal Secretary and apprised him about the prevailing situation, condition and the existing status of the Education sector in the area.

The Principal Secretary assured the public representatives, general public present at the venue, parents, students and the staff members that every possible step will be taken to ensure that the students receive the best quality education.

Thereafter, the Principal Secretary visited Govt. Girls HS, Gole Gujral wherein he interacted with the students and also held a meeting with the Head Master and staff members of the institution. During the visit, the Principal Secretary announced the construction of 16 new rooms after dismantling of unsafe building.

Meanwhile, the Principal Secretary visited Government Higher Secondary School, Bhalwal where he released the first ever issue of the School Magazine KARVAAN. He also participated in plantation drive in the botanical garden of the school premises. The Principal Secretary then click-started

the newly installed CCTV system of the school and also inaugurated a synthetic volleyball court, an Art & Craft room, Happiness zone for the institution.

The Principal Secretary also interacted with the students, encouraged them to make their classroom learning a two way process with their active participation in it and apply their learning to their day-to-day life.

On the occasion, a tricolor was also hoisted in institutions and melody of patriotism was spread all around with the national anthem sung by the students. The Saraswati Vandana, other cultural items and inspiring speeches also kept the audiences mesmerized.

SRINAGAR: Advisor to Lieutenant Governor, Farooq Khan, on the occasion of "7th Technology cum Seed Sale Mela" organized by SKUAST-K, distributed superior quality willow saplings being used for manufacture of cricket bats among the beneficiaries associated with Sethar cricket bat cluster.


Vice Chancellor, SKUAST-K, Dr. Nazir Ahmed, Divisional Commissioner Kashmir, P. K. Pole and various Deans and Head of Departments were present on the occasion.

On the occasion, Director Industries and Commerce

Kashmir, Mehmood Ahmed Shah, said that under the World Bank funded Jhelum Tawi Flood Recovery Project (JTFRP), Faculty of Forestry SKUAST-K has been engaged for identification and propagation of best quality willow (*Salix Alba var caerulea*) being used for manufacture of cricket bat. He added that it is expected that with the use of superior willow the quality of cricket bats being manufactured in the Valley would be comparable to those which are manufactured in rest of the World. Dean Faculty of Forestry briefed that the department has completed the research work

for the application for GI Tag for Kashmir Willow and in collaboration with the Industries Department they would shortly approach the Registrar of GI Chennai for allocation of the GI Mark.

Various representatives of the Cricket bat Cluster who attended the event hailed the efforts made by the Principal Secretary I&C, Ranjan Prakash Thakur, for development of cricket bat industry. Further, various stakeholders suggested identification of suitable land in Anantnag district for propagation of superior quality of willow on a large scale.




