Whopping Rs 1.18 lakh Cr budget to cater to youth aspirations, women empowerment: BJP

JAMMU: Senior Advocate Abhinav Sharma, Spokesperson BJP J&K on Sunday asserted that the whopping budget of Rs 1,18,500 crore presented by FM Nirmala Sitharaman holds much for employment generation, women empowerment, and catering to youths aspirations besides extraordinary provisions made for promotion of agriculture sector.

The BJP leader was addressing a "Budget Pe Charcha" programme organised at BJP Headquarters in context with J&K Budget 2023 presented by the Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman. The programme was attended by a large number of Yuva

Morcha and Mahila Morcha activists. Arun Gupta, Spokesperson and Sanjita Dogra, President J&K Mahila Morcha were also present. Going by these figures and others after briefing the gathering about the important features of this vital financial document meant for J&K's progress, Abhinav spoke how this budget is more futuristic than the previous one. He said that for youth empowerment, employment, entrepreneurship, skill development and sports activities, an allocation of nearly Rs 396.63 crore has been made under Capital Expenditure for the year 2023-24.

He said that enough planning and thought had been applied to create an overall well-planned and futuristic

budget that would give impetus to economic growth of Jammu and Kashmir keeping in mind that women should be part of every aspect of the growth graph making this endeavour women centric at all levels.

The senior BJP leader said that tax/GDP ratio is projected at 8.82 percent for 2023-24, which is higher than the previous year of 7.77 percent and the debt/GDP ratio for 2023-24 is 49 percent and GDP

Through the medium of this appeal cum notice, public in general and motorists/devotees in particular visiting Kali Mata Mandir Bagh-e-Bahu Jammu and Kandoli Mata Nagrota during the celebration of Holy Navratra festival w.e.f 22.03.2023 to 29.03.2023 for paying obeisance, are advised to follow the particular route to reach the respective Temple to minimize the traffic pressure/ chaos of the approaching routes.

- During the Navratra period, there will be one-way vehicular traffic movement towards the Bagh-e-Bahu Temple to keep the Bahu Fort Route free from obstructions.
- During Navratra period, no vehicle will be allowed to move towards Bagh-e-Bahu via Bahu Fort Road
- P/S Bagh-e-Bahu crossing will be diversion point and all vehicles(LMVs/PSVs) going towards Bahu-Fort shall be diverted from P/S Bagh-e-Bahu Crossing towards Qasim Nagar and from where the vehicles shall further be diverted towards Bye - Pass Road NHW and Forest Check and then towards Kali Mata Mandir".
- The devotees and motorists are advised to follow the one-way route strictly to keep the road free for movement of devotee vehicles without any obstacles.
- During Navratra days No Heavy vehicle (HMV) shall be allowed to enter from Bye-Pass Naka NHW (Sidhra road) towards Bagh-e-Bahu/Bahu-fort area.
- The devotees/general public shall park their Vehicles in a specified parking slot only and not on either side of the road in anyway.
- Wrongly parked vehicles on the said stretch will be dealt under M.V. Act.

1. New JDA Parking
2. Main paid Parking Slot in front of Bagh-e-Bahu Temple
3. Ground of Govt. Hr. Sec. School Bagh-e-Bahu
