Bootlegger arrested

SAMBA: Continuing its drive against the sale of illicit liquor, Samba Police has arrested a bootlegger and recovered ten bottles of illicit liquor of 750 ml each from his possession.

Illegal extraction & transportation of minerals: Police seizes four vehicles, arrests drivers

Bovine smuggler arrested, 4 bovines rescued

SAMBA: Samba Police on Saturday foiled bovine smuggling attempt and arrested bovine smuggler, rescued four bovines and seized vehicle used in the illegal transportation of bovines. Over 5 lakh penalty imposed on excavator for illegal mining at Bhini Nallah

The area of Excavation was also measured by the officials of the mining department and found over 2000 MT Nallah muck lifted from the spot thereby resulting in several pits and trenches in the Nallah.

The Excavator after seizure as per the rules of Geology and Mining department kept in the custody of police till realization of penalty.

Deputy Commissioner Dr. Rakesh Minhas has already passed instructions to the mining department to take strong action against stone crushers and other violators if they indulge in illegal mining anywhere in the district.
