CRIME REPORT

2 drug peddlers arrested, 185 grams Charas recovered

SAMBA: Continuing its drive against drug menace, Samba Police arrested two drug peddlers in the jurisdiction of Police Station Ghagwal and recovered 185 grams approximately Charas like narcotic substance.

A Police party of Police Post Rajpura headed by Incharge Police Post Rajpura while performing patrolling duty near village Sanoora has intercepted a person who was moving under suspicious circumstances. During frisking in presence of Executive Magistrate 1st Class, Charas like narcotic substance weighing 185 gms approximately was recovered from his possession which was wrapped in a polythene.

The arrested drug peddler identified as Davinder Singh, son of Neter Singh, resident of of Sanoora tehsil Rajpura district Samba has been arrested.

A case FIR No 25/2024 U/S 8/20/29 NDPS Act has been registered against him at Police Station Ghagwal and investigation started.

During sustained interrogation of the accused, backward linkage has been worked out and accused namely Saudagar Mal S/o Puri Ram R/o BhagochaChack tehsil Hiranagar district Kathua has been arrested in the instant case. Further interrogation is going on.

Servant arrested for stealing gold from jewellery Store

JAMMU: A theft has been case solved by Gandhi Nagar police by arresting the accused and recovered stolen gold.

As per details, On Feb 25, 2024, an applicant namely Bhavish Mehta, son of Mohinder Pal Mehta, resident of Reshamgarh Colony Jammu produced a written complaint regarding theft in his jewellery Store Talla jeweller at Anqaf Market Gandhi Nagar.

On this, case FIR No.44/2024 U/S 381 IPC got registered at PS Gandhi Nagar and investigation started.

A team of PS Gandhi Nagar led by SHO PMS Gandhi Nagar with the help of CCTV footages of area arrested one person namely Viney Kumar Chouhan, son of Vinod Kumar Chouhan, resident of New Geeta Colony Jalandhar who was servant of said jewellery shop. During questioning accused confessed his involvement in the above case and on his disclosure 12 tolas of gold worth Rs. 09 lakh was recovered from Muthoot Finance Company Jalandhar Punjab.

Two missing minor girls traced, reunited with families

JAMMU: Two missing minor girls were reunited with their families by Jammu Police in the areas under the jurisdiction of Police Station Janipur and Bakshi Nagar.

Two different complaints were lodged at Police Station Janipur and Bakshi Nagar by legal heirs of both minor girls stating that they got missing from their respective homes. In this regard, two different cases i.e case FIR No. 31/2024 U/S 363/IPC got registered at PS Janipur and case FIR No. 23/2024 U/S 363/IPC got registered at PS Bakshi Nagar and investigation got started.

On this special police teams led by SHO PS Janipur and SHO PS Bakshi Nagar did strenuous efforts and finally traced both the missing minor girls.

Subsequently families of both the missing minor girls were informed and the traced minor girls were handed over to their family members after completing all the legal formalities.

Theft case worked out; stolen domesticated animals valuing over five lakhs recovered

RAJOURI: Peeri Police worked out a case of theft of domesticated animals and has arrested the accused involved in crime besides recovery of animals valuing over five lakhs.

Police said that on 25 February, crime namely Ishaq Ahmed son of Mohd Aslam resident of Chambitran Kotranka lodged a written complaint at Police Post Peeri and complained that some persons have stolen his Sheep and Goats from his house at Chambitran; Kotranka.

Accordingly a case in FIR No 18/2024 U/Ss 457/380/34 IPC was registered and investigation was taken up by Incharge Police Post Peeri, PSI Chander Kant under the supervision of SHO Kandi Shakeel Manhas.

During investigation, police team zeroed in over some leads and finally arrested three persons confessed their involvement in commission of crime.

On their disclosure 31 domesticated animals (23 sheep and 08 goats) valuing over five lakhs have been recovered.

Further investigation into the matter is going on and there is likelihood of more recoveries as investigation moves on.

Kishtwar's CIU recovers online defrauded funds of over one lakh

Soldier, cop injured in separate accidental firing incidents

MENDHAR/SRINAGAR: An army personnel was injured when his service rifle went off accidentally near the Line of Control in Poonch district of Jammu and Kashmir, offi-

cial said on Thursday.

The incident occurred on Wednesday night.

The soldier, who was part of a patrolling team in the Balnoi area of the Mendhar sector, slipped after losing balance which led to accidental fire from his service weapon, officials said.

He was injured on the left foot and taken to a hospital, they said.

Meanwhile, a rusty grenade was defused near the border fence in Balnoi on Wednesday evening, officials said.

The grenade was detected by the Army during a patrol. The bomb disposal squad was summoned and the explosive device was safely defused, they added.

Meanwhile, a policeman was injured in Pulwama district after his rifle went off accidentally, officials said.

The incident took place in Pulwama's Arihal village when the cop was on duty, they added.

"A policeman of Pulwama district police got injured in accidental firing from his service rifle while on official duty at Arihal, Pulwama," an official said.

The cop received a bullet wound on his foot and was taken.

D&FCO disallows operation of 115 drug sale establishments

SRINAGAR: The Enforcement Staff of Drugs and Food Control Organisation (D&FCO) on Thursday carried out special drives within the local areas to secure due diligence with the provisions of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act and rules there -under:

During the drive, more than 700 inspections of Retail Pharmacies were carried out and operations of 115 Drug Sale Establishments (46 in Jammu Province and 69 in Kashmir Province) were disallowed u/s 22 (d) of Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 on spot for omissions/ breaches of the provisions of Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 and rules there-under depending upon the quantum.

The defaulters have been warned to desist from repetition of such omissions as otherwise the Empowered Authorities shall proceed for cancellation of licenses.

Statutory drug samples of nearly 165 drug formulations of various categories were lifted randomly and referred to Government Analyst(s) for framing of legal opinion w.r.t strength, purity and other quality parameters.

Emphasis was laid to observe the compliance of Administrative orders issued from time to time w.r.t installation of CCTV Cameras and adoption of Computerized Billing System.

Moreover, stocks of drugs worth Rs 4,96,000 were seized from an unlicensed premises being run by one Ajiaz Ahmed at Hassanpora, Bijbehara for indulging in trade of pharma products without holding licenses for the same. The matter is under investigation and legal recourse in the matter is in offing.

Drugs Controller, J&K, Lotika Khajuria, has requested the Pharma trade fraternity to cooperate with the Local Drug Authorities and help to ensure ethical trade practices.

60 years old man dies in fire incident in Srinagar's Nawa Kadal area

Srinagar: A 60-year-old man died while another was injured in a fire in Nawa Kadal area of the Srinagar city here on Thursday, officials said.

A massive fire broke out in the Jamalata area of Nawa Kadal locality of the city, engulfing three residential houses in the area, they said. Heavy damage was caused to these structures.

Fire tenders were rushed to the spot to douse the flames.

Two people were injured in the fire, including the owner of one of the houses, who later succumbed, officials added.

The deceased has been identified as Bashir Ahmad.
