Missing woman, boy traced; reunited with families

REASI/JAMMU: Police on Sunday traced a missing woman and a boy and reunited them with their families.

One person (name withheld) of Talwara lodged a written complaint on 16th of February 2024 at Police Post Talwara that her wife (name withheld) went missing. He started searching for her but she could not be found anywhere. Sensing the gravity of incident SSP Reasi Mohita Sharma constituted a special team to trace out the missing women at the earliest.

Enquiries from the family, relatives & friends gave sufficient clues of the missing women & accordingly sources of police were activated.

After meticulous track-following, with the help of technical assistance by ESU Reasi & consistent hectic efforts, team of Police Post Talwara zeroed upon the location of the women.

Police team of PP Talwara raided at different locations and recovered the missing women. The whole operation is led by SHO Reasi Chaman Gorka under the supervision of Dy.SP Hqrs Reasi Neeraj Padyar. After completing all the legal formalities the missing women reunited with her family.

Meanwhile, On March 8, 2024, one missing report of Surjeet Singh alias Sachin, son of Krishan Lal, resident of Kotli Mian Fateh Tehsil R.S Pura District Jammu was lodged in Police Station R.S.Pura on the written complaint of his father namely Krishan Lal, son of Sansar Singh, resident of Kotli Mian Fateh Tehsil R.S Pura District Jammu.

Acting upon this, a Police team led by SHO RS Pura, did strenuous efforts and with the help of technical assistance, said missing boy, was got traced by the police team, he has, now been reunited with his family and after completing all legal formalities, has been handed over to his legal heirs.General public has applauded the efforts of Jammu Police.

3 bovine smugglers arrested, 15 bovines rescued, vehicle seized

SAMBA: Continuing its drive against the bovine smugglers and their propagators, Police on Sunday foiled bovine smuggling attempt in the early morning hours, arrested three bovine smuggler, rescued fifteen bovines and seized truck in the jurisdiction of Police Station Ghagwal.

A Police team of Police Station Ghagwal headed by SHO Police Station Ghagwal while performing vehicle checking duty at NHW nakaTapyal, signalled to stop a truck bearing registration number JK03F-4511 coming from Kathua side for checking. But the driver of the vehicle accelerated the speed endangering the life of police personnel on naka duty and hit the vehicle with naka road barrier causing damage to it. The alert cops successfully intercepted the vehicle and during checking fifteen bovines were found laden inside the vehicle which were tied in a cruel manner and were being transported illegally without any valid permission.

The bovine smugglers identified as Razak Ahmed, son of Altaf Hussain, resident of Usdara, Trigam, tehsil and district Kishtwar; Yaqoob Ali, son of Mohd Hussain, resident of Jeora Chakrohi Tehsil R.S.Pura district Jammu and Mir Sain, son of Sheru Ali, resident of Airwan District Kathua have been arrested and the truck used for illegal transportation of bovines has also been seized.

A case FIR No. 30/2024 U/S 188, 336 IPC, 11 PCA Act, 3 PDPP Act has been registered at Police Station Ghagwal and investigation started.

8 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized in Pulwama

Bike theft case solved; thief arrested, stolen property recovered

JAMMU: Bike theft case was solved by Police Post Nehru Market, Gandhinagar by arresting a thief and stolen property was recovered.

As per details, On March 8, 2024, a written complaint was lodged by Ramesh Kumar, resident of Kirpalpur, Phallian Mandal regarding the theft of his splendor motorcycle (JK02BJ-8722) by some unknown thieves from Bikram Chowk, Warehouse.

On receiving the complaint case FIR No. 58/2024 U/S 379 IPC was registered in PS Gandhinagar and investigation was started.

During the course of investigation, Police Party of Police Post Nehru market under incharge Police Post Sub inspector Ajesh Jamwal rounded up one suspect namely Mohd Akram alias Akri, resident of Kheriyaan Tehsil Gole Gujral Jammu and on his disclosure motorcycle bearing registration no JK02BJ-8722 has been recovered and seized in the instant case. Moreover two more splendor motorcycles bearing Chasis no and engine nos MBLHA10A3EHC26481 HA10ELEHC53477 and MBLHA10BFH103839 HA10ELEHJ34085 have been recovered on his disclosure which were also seized u/s 102 CrPC.

It is pertinent to mention here that the said accused person is already involved in different theft cases in different police stations of Jammu district. Further investigation of the case is going on.People have applauded the prompt action by the Jammu Police.

Drug peddler arrested; contraband substances recovered

BARAMULLA: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police has arrested drug peddler in Baramulla and recovered contraband substances from his possession.

A police party of Police Station Pattan headed by SHO PS Pattan at a checkpoint established at Chinar Crossing Pattan near Pandav Park, intercepted a person identified as Amjad Wahan Wani son of Ab Wahab resident of Wani Mohalla Machil Kupwara.
