SIU Srinagar produces chargesheet against 2 terrorists

SRINAGAR: Special Investigation Unit (SIU) Srinagar on Thursday produced chargesheet against two terrorists in case FIR No. 39/2022 in the Court of NIA Srinagar.

"Today, the charge sheet bearing No. 03/2024 of case FIR No. 39/2022 under section 7/27 A Act, 302 IPC, 13, 16, 18, 20 & 38 UA(P) Act of Police Station Soura, Srinagar stands presented before the Court of NIA Srinagar. The case has been presented against the two accused terrorists namely Adil Ahmad Parray,

son of Habibullah Parray, resident of Badragund Ganderbal (A1) and Basit Ahmad Dar, son of Late Abdul Rashid Dar, resident of Redwani Payeen Qaimoh Kulgam", according to SIU statement.

"Among these two accused terrorists, former one stands killed and the later one is absconding, who is still on run regarding whom the Court has been prayed to take cognizance as abated and under Section 299 CrPC respectively. The next date of hearing is fixed on March 28, 2024", the statement added.

Burglary case solved; 6 accused arrested, stolen property worth lakh recovered

KULGAM: Police on Thursday solved a burglary case and have arrested six accused persons involved in the commission of crime and recovered stolen property from their possession. Police Station Kulgam received complaint regarding burglary and accordingly a case vide FIR No. 21/2024 under relevant sections of law was registered and investigation was initiated. During the course of investigation, six suspected persons were zeroed in on who later on confessed their involvement in the commission of crime. They have been identified as Reyaz Ahmad Lone son of Abdul Rashid Lone resident of Boh DH Pora, Mohd Amin Wani son of Mohd Afzal Wani resident of DK Marag, Mohd Amin Malik son of Mohd Jamal Malik resident of DK Marag, Mohd Ishaq Malik son of Asadullah Malik resident of Lalpur DK Marag, Mohd Aslam Bargath son of Mohd Qasim Bargath resident of Rajouri and Nazir Ahmad Lone son of Abdul Gani Lone resident of Suilkhenan DK Marag. Subsequently, all the six accused persons were arrested and shifted to Police Station Kulgam where they remain in custody. On their disclosure, stolen property including four stolen Animals were recovered. Besides, vehicle (Tata Bolero) bearing registration number JK19A-1662 used in the commission of crime has also been seized.

Police reunites missing woman with family

7 vehicles seized for illegal mining

Exchequer of worth Rs 1,38,17,971/- by way of cheating and falsification of accounts at Sub Treasury Dharmari arrested today.

SSP Further added that Two other accused namely Ajeet Kumar, son of Punjabi Ram, resident of Rayala Tehsil Pouni Disrict Reasi Roopnagar, Reasi (assistant treasury officer, Sub treasury Dharmari) and Balbir Singh, son of Kirpa Kotli Lalpat Bhomag District Reasi at present Geeta Nagar, Reasi (account assistant), were arrested for involvement in the criminal conspiracy of the act committed.

ACB registers DA case against retired SE, conducts searches

SRINAGAR: Anti Corruption Bureau has registered FIR into the allegations of acquisition of Disproportionate Assets accumulated by a public servant, namely Mohammad Ayub Wani, son of Abdul Ahad Wani, resident of Railway Colony, Nihama, Pulwama, Superintendent Engineer PMGSY Circle Baramulla, now retired. "The suspect is in possession of huge assets both immovable, movable and purchased gold ornaments worth lakhs of rupees. The assets were found disproportionate to his known source of income during the verification", according to a statement issued by the ACB.

The omissions and commissions on the part of the retired public servant constitute offences punishable U/S 5(1)(e) r/w 5(2) J&K PC Act. Svt. 2006. Accordingly a case FIR No. 05/2024 has been registered in PS ACB Srinagar and further investigation taken up. After obtaining search warrant from the Court, searches were carried at the three separate locations-- residential house at Afandi Bagh Rawalpura Srinagar; residential house at Railway Colony Nihama Pulwama and a flat in "Ansal Tower" at Sainik Colony, Jammu simultaneously.

During the search, incriminating material including revenue papers, finance and bank documents etc were recovered and seized as evidence in the instant case. Further investigation of the case is going on.
