## Association of Industries raises concern over eviction process

JAMMU: Association of Industries Gangyal on Sunday convened a meeting under the leadership of President Tejwant Singh Reen wherein concerns were raised regarding the eviction process initiated by the Jammu & Kashmir UT for leased premises of permanently registered units.

Entrepreneurs strongly opposed this move, attributing the closure of their units to factors

beyond their control, such as the withdrawal of marketing support by local authorities like SICOP.

The association voiced its apprehension that public notification of the eviction process would further tarnish the image of these units, which have been striving to revive without adequate support from UT authorities.

The association suggested that the government should have consulted them and

constituted a high-level committee involving industrial representatives to address the causes of unit dysfunctionality.

The association appealed for the formation of a high-powered committee to review and initiate revival/rehabilitation processes, along with the immediate release of pending payments to govern-

ment departments/agencies amounting to nearly Rs. 300 crores.

The association resolved to urge the J&K Govt. to halt eviction actions until the impacted units are adequately revived, seeking the personal intervention of the Lt. Governor to ensure this.
