NCDC with SKUAST-Jammu organizes training for Fish Farmers Producer Organization in Doda

JAMMU: National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC), Chandigarh in collaboration with the Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology of Jammu (SKUAST-Jammu) successfully organized a three-day training program aimed at empowering Fish Farmers Producer Organizations (FPOs) in the Doda district of Jammu region.
