## DB imposes costs Rs 20000 for misleading Court with view to get favourable order

JAMMU: The Division Bench of the Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court, comprising Chief Justice N. Kotishwar Singh and Justice Wasim Sadiq Nargal, imposed a fine of Rs. 20,000 on the appellants for misleading the court with the intention of obtaining a favourable order.

This decision came in response to a Letters Patent Appeal (LPA) filed by the appellants against the judgment dated February 19, 2024, passed in WP(C) No. 314/2024 titled "Sukhdev Singh & Anr Vs. UT of J&K and Ors."

In the original writ peti-

tion, the appellants challenged the setting aside of mutation No. 42 dated October 3, 2005, by an order of Respondent No. 2.

The order reveals that the same has been issued pursuant to the representation preferred by the appellant namely Sukhdev Singh, Romesh Singh and Shubash Singh and accordingly, the Collector has sought a report from the concerned Tehsildar Pargwal along with the relevant revenue record and after perusing the same, the violations which have been observed by the concerned Collector.

The Division Bench noted that the appellants had pre-

viously approached the Deputy Commissioner seeking redressal of their grievance, and the Collector had subsequently issued an order addressing their concerns.

However, the appellants later contradicted their previous stance by challenging the jurisdiction of the Deputy Commissioner to the writ petition before the court. The Division Bench observed that the appellants' contradictory actions and attempts to mislead the court were unacceptable.

They emphasized the importance of parties presenting accurate information and not concealing
