and it was informed that over 90 percent medical shops have installed CCTV cameras and computerized billing in retail medical shops is also ensured. Moreover, the ALC Samba along with the team of excise department and Narcotics department, Samba shall continue the awareness drive in various industrial units and also inform the workers/labourers about the pros and cons of drugs and brief them about the ill effects of drug abuse. Among others the meeting was attended by SSP Samba, Vinay Kumar, ADC Samba, Suresh Sharma, representative from BSF including 2IC Jay Prakash and Deputy Commandant Deepak Kumar, ACR Samba, Kusum Chib, SDM Gaghwah, SDM Vijaypur, DIO and other district and Sectoral officers.

2 absconders arrested

4 missing females traced, reunited with families

JAMMU: Police on Friday traced 4 missing females and reunited them with their families. One person (name withheld) of Tulli (Udhari), Tehsil Chassana, District Reasi, lodged a written complaint on 21 of February 2024 at Police Station Chassana that her daughter (name withheld) age about 26 yrs had left her home without informing anyone and had not returned. He started searching for her but she could not be found anywhere. Sensing the gravity of incident SSP Reasi Mohita Sharma constituted a special team to trace out the missing girl at the earliest. Enquiries from the family, relatives & friends gave sufficient clues of the missing girl & accordingly sources of police were activated. After meticulous track-following, with the help of technical team of District Police Reasi & consistent hectic efforts, team of Police Station Chassana zeroed upon the location of the girl at Yairupura District Kulgam. Police team headed by SHO Chassana Inspector Ranjeet Rao raided at different locations and recovered the missing girl. After completing all the legal formalities the missing girl reunited with her family. All family, relatives & community people expressed gratitude to Police for sincere efforts in searching & recovering the missing girl. Samba Police also reunited a missing woman with her family whose missing report was lodged at Police Station Rangarh on September 5, 2023, by her husband stating therein that his wife went out from home and did not return. All efforts were made out by the family members but the whereabouts of the missing lady could not be ascertained. With continuous strenuous efforts, a police team of Police Station Rangarh has traced out the said missing woman and handed over to her legal heirs after completing all legal formalities. Accordingly, the said missing report has been closed. Meanwhile, a missing report of girl, a resident of Jammu was lodged by her mother on November 22, 2014. The said girl was traced out by hectic efforts of team consisting of ASI Swarn Singh and ASI Satnaam Kour of PP Gadi Garh, Police Station Satwari. The missing lady was subsequently handed over to her legal heirs. In another instance, On March 24, 2024 missing report of one lady (name withheld) Distt. Jammu was entered at Police Station Miran Sahib. A party of Police Station Miran Sahib under the supervision of SDPO R S Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO Police Station Miran Sahib inspector Bupinder Singh searched various places and with technical assistance alongwith timely human intervention traced the said missing lady and reunited with family. After completing all legal formalities the said missing lady handed over to her legal heirs. Moreover missing report stands closed.

Drug peddler arrested with 5.34 grams heroin

JAMMU: Jammu Police nabbed a domestic violence accused who was trying to flee to UK from IG Airport Delhi. On 26th March 2024, one lady Dali Kumar, wife of Sushil Kumar, resident of Hakkal, Jammu submitted an application against her husband namely Sushil Kumar about domestic violence being faced by her, on which the enquiry was initiated, and was entrusted to ASI Kulbir Kour of Police Post Chatha, who recorded the statements of victim and other circumstantial witnesses. As per statements recorded, offence were proved against the said person and case FIR No. 56/2024 under section 498-A/494/504/506/120-B IPC was registered in Police Station Satwari. Further, suspecting fleeing of the said accused person from India to abroad, SSP Jammu issued Look Out Circular (LOC) against the said accused person, which was circulated to the Assistant Director, Bureau of Immigration, New Delhi to enable Jammu Police to nab him and produce him in the court of law. Today, the said accused person has been detained at IGLA, New Delhi while trying to flee from the country, and a team of Satwari Police Station has been mobilised to take his custody. Further investigation into the matter is underway.


4 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized
