CRIME REPORT

2 drug peddlers arrested; contraband substances recovered

SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police arrested two drug peddlers in Baramulla & Kulgam and recovered contraband substances from their possession.

In Baramulla, a police party of Police Post Delina headed by IC PP Delina under the supervision of DySP Hqrs Baramulla at a checkpoint established at Delina Marke intercepted a person. During search, 72 capsules of SpasmoProxyvon Plus psychotropic substances were recovered from his possession. He has been identified as Aqib Nazir Malik son of Nazir Ahmad Malik resident of Sangrama Sopore. He has been arrested and shifted to PS Baramulla where he remains in custody.

In Kulgam, a police party headed by SHO Police Station Qazigund at a checkpoint established at Dalwaeh crossing intercepted one suspected person identified as Mohammad Ramzan Lone son of Wali Mohd Lone resident of Hawoora, who tried to flee from the spot but was apprehended tactfully. During search, 4 Kgs of Poppy Straw like substance filled in the nylon bag was recovered from his possession. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered at respective police stations & investigation have been initiated.

Man held with approx. 10 litres of illicit liquor

KATHUA: In an another breakthrough in its drive against the trade of illicit liquor, Kathua police seized approx. 10 Litres of illicit liquor (Desi) in the jurisdictional area of PS Kathua at village Dambra alongwith one person was arrested on spot.

Acting on reliable information regarding the trade of illicit liquor by few persons in the adjoining area of PS Kathua, a police party of PS Kathua under the supervision of DySP Headquarters Kathua & SHO PS Kathua during special checking at Village Dambra apprehended one suspected person namely Shiva Kumar, son of Ashok Kumar, resindet of Dambra Tehsil & District Kathua. During checking approx. 10 litres of illicit liquor was recovered which he had kept in his illegal possession and selling the same to the people of the village Dambra in order to gain illegitimate profit. Meanwhile all the recovered consignment of illicit liquor (approx. 10 litres) was seized alongwith 01 person was arrested. In this regard a case vide FIR No. 65/2024 U/S 48(a) Excise Act got registered at PS Kathua and further investigation is underway.

Vikar call Woman's Reservation Bill, big Jumla

REASI: J&K Pradesh Congress President Vikar Rasool Wani on Saturday asked the party leadership to explicitly expose the duplicity of Bharatiya Janata Party for brazenly implementing anti-people policies in J&K and elsewhere. The Congress stalwart was addressing the J&K Mahila Congress' workers meeting was organised by Mahila Congress District President Shobha Sharma after getting a cue from Mahila Congress National President Alka Lamba. The mega event was aimed at raising the awareness about Congress Leader Rahul Gandhi's nationwide Nyay Yatra.

Chief Guest on the occasion, Vikar Rasool Wani said that time is ripe for puncturing the balloon of lies of BJP because all its policies have failed to satiate the aspirations of the people as the party believes more on rhetoric rather than changing the reality on ground. He said that concerted efforts are needed to uncover the deceit and bogus narratives of the saffron brigade because people today are facing numerous problems including inflation, power sector woes like snarlt metering gaffes, unemployment, etc. He said that every worker of the party especially Mahila Congress activists

should reach out to people at the grassroots level to enlighten and convince them that only Congress can bail out the masses from current morass and arbitrariness of BJP's mis governance. PCC Chief reiterated the party's commitment to empowering women and ensuring their voices are heard in the decision-making process. He alleged that the women's reservation bill was a 'jumla' of the BJP-led central government ahead of the Lok Sabha elections. He criticised the Modi-led government for adding the caveat in the bill that it will come into effect after the delimitation of Lok Sabha constituencies, which will be carried out after the completion of the next population census.

Wani has made it clear that one of his top priorities is to ensure that essential services, such as affordable LPG gas and pensions for widows and the elderly, are accessible to all citizens. He also emphasised the importance of equal representation for women both at the assembly and parliament. Under the leadership of Rahul Gandhi the Congress party is strongly promoting

women's empowerment, he added. Wani boldly expressed that the Congress party is the best choice for voters who are tired of hollow promises and want real change. He asked the Mahila Congress activists to pledge to work tirelessly ahead of Lok Sabha polls to ensure landslide victory of Congress as this is necessary for delivering seamless justice to women in the country. Addressing the meeting as Special Guest, J&K Mahila Congress President Shameema Raina said that the women's wing of the Indian National Congress has time and again reaffirmed its unwavering commitment to empowering and uplifting womenfolk. Notorious drug peddler booked under PITNDPS Act

AKHNOOR: A notorious drug peddler has been booked under PITNDPS Act by Akhnoor Police.

An information was received at Police Station Akhnoor regarding presence of one notorious criminal/Drug peddler namely Vivek Kumar alias Sunny, son of Satish Kumar, resident of Ward No.08 Akhnoor who was involved in cases of drug peddling and evading his arrest for the last one month in the area.

On this information police team of ps Akhnoor headed by SHO police station Akhnoor Tariq Ahmed under the supervision of SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Sharma raided the location of accused and managed to arrest the said accused.

It is pertinent to mention that a warrant under PITNDPS vide order No. 08 of 2024 dated 25/01/2024 under section 3 has already been issued against the accused by Divisional commissioner Jammu after receiving the dossier from district police against the accused.

The said accused was habitual of indulging in criminal activities and there were various NDPS Act cases in which accused was involved which include FIR No. 256/2022 U/S 8/20 NDPS Act of Police Station Akhnoor; FIR No 09/2023 U/S 8/21/22 NDPS Act of Police Station Doman; FIR No 324/2023 U/s 8/21/22/29 NDPS Act of Police Station Akhnoor; FIR No. 205/2013 U/S 341/323/34 RPC of Police Station Akhnoor and FIR No.172/2016 U/S 48 (f) of police station Akhnoor.

Finally today the warrant was executed and the accused was sent to District Jail Kathua.

Teenager dies of asphyxiation in Ramban

BANIHAL: A teenager died and four others fell unconscious due to suspected asphyxiation in Ramban district on Saturday, officials said. The incident took place during a marriage function at Deeda village in sub-divisional Gool, the officials said.

The officials said that they were rushed to the sub-district hospital in Gool where Mohammad Tariq (18) was declared dead, adding four other persons are undergoing treatment.

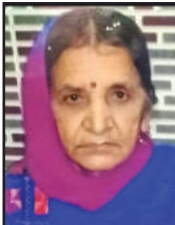
