CRIME REPORT

3 vehicles seized for illegal mining

SAMBA: Intensifying its drive against illegal mining in the district, Samba Police has seized three vehicles in the jurisdiction of Police Station Samba which were being used for illegal transportation/mining of the construction material.

A Police team of Police Station Samba headed by SHO Police Station Samba while performing patrolling duty in jurisdictional area, has seized one tractor trolley without registration number for illegal mining/transportation of construction material in the area. Whereas, a Police party of Police Post RakhAmb/Talli headed by Incharge Police Post RakhAmb/Talli while on patrolling duty in the area has seized one tractor trolleys bearing regd. Nos. JK21H-9554 for illegal mining/transportation in the area.

Similarly, a Police party of Police Post Mansar headed by Incharge Police Post Mansarduring patrolling duty in the area has seized one dumper bearing regd. No. JK14F-8303 for illegal mining/transportation in the area.

The above mentioned vehicles have been seized by Samba Police and handed over to Geology & Mining Department, Samba for further action.

5 drug peddlers arrested; contraband substances recovered

SRINAGAR: In continuation of its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police have arrested 05 drug peddlers in Sopore & Ganderbal and recovered contraband/ psychotropic substances from their possession.

In Sopore, a police party headed by Incharge Police Post Watergam under the supervision of SDPO Rafiabad and SHO PS Dangiwaacha at a checkpoint established at Hib Dangerpora Crossing, intercepted 02 persons who on seeing the police party tried to flee from the spot, but were apprehended tactfully. During search, 583 tablets of banned drugs have been recovered from their possession. They have been arrested and shifted to Police Station Dangiwaacha where they remain in custody.

In Ganderbal, a police party of Police Post Naghal at a checkpoint established at Gratabal crossing intercepted a vehicle (i10) bearing registration number JK01AF-6330 with 03 persons on-board. They have been identified as Mohd Furqan Mir (driver) son of Ali Mohd Mir resident of Bilal Colony Soura, Rayees Ahmad Makdooomi son of Nazir Ahmad Makdooomi resident of Khalmulla Ganderbal and Dildar Ahmad Hajam son of Gh Hassan Hajam resident of Rangil Ganderbal. During search of the vehicle, 2.6 Kgs (Approx) of crushed cannabis was recovered and seized on the spot. They have been arrested and shifted to Police Station where they remain in custody. Vehicle used in the commission of crime has also been seized.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered at respective Police Stations and investigations have been initiated.

Illicit timber recovered

MVD team recovers Rs 11,400 fine during enforcement drive

RAMBAN: On the directions of Deputy Commissioner, Ramban, Baseer-Ul-Haq Choudhary, a team of Motor Vehicle Department, led by ARTO, Sheetal Kumar Sharma today conducted an enforcement drive on the Kanga, Ramban to Gool route.

During the drive, the team checked 53 vehicles. As many as 8 vehicles were found to be operating in contravention to various provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act and were issued challans.

An amount of Rs 11,400 fine was recovered on the spot, while 2 Driving Licenses were also seized. During the drive, a number of school vehicles were also checked for fitness, provision of first aid, fire extinguisher. The operators were asked to comply with the traffic norms so as to ensure the safety of the students. The drive specifically targeted overloading, fitness inspections, validity of route permit and over-charging in vehicles.

Absconder wanted in NDPS cases nabbed

CB registers FIR against National President of fake NGO, others

JAMMU: Crime Branch Jammu on Wednesday registered FIR against self-styled National President of fake NGO 'Yuva Shakti Jagriti Mission' and his three accomplices for fraudulently duping innocent people of Banihal and adjoining areas on the pretext of opening Cancer Hospital, Vidyalayas , Hostels , Laptop Agencies and other big projects for general public.

SSP Crime Jammu, Benam Tosh has constituted a Special Investigation Team (SIT), headed by an experienced gazetted officer to investigate case FIR No.12/2024 registered under relevant sections of law at Police Station Crime Branch (EOW) Jammu and in-depth investigation has been started.

The booked accused have been identified as Satendra Kumar of Delhi, who happened to be the National President of NGO, Bashir Ahmad Jagal of Kupwara, at present Sidhra Jammu, Sharda Verma and Satya Prakash Verma of Delhi.

A complaint was lodged by the victims of fraud with Crime Branch (EOW) Jammu and preliminary verification (PV) was conducted by the investigating agency during which it transpired that the self-styled National President of fake NGO Yuva

Shakti Jagriti Mission and his aides duped the people of huge money on the pretext of providing big projects for general public, made several members of the fake NGO and after collecting huge money fled away from the area and went underground . As this commission was cognizable offence, FIR has been registered.

Properties of drug dealers worth Rs 97 lakhs seized

JAMMU: In a first ever crackdown on properties of drug dealers in District Samba, Deputy Commissioner Samba and SSP Samba orchestrated a meticulously planned operation resulting in the confiscation of a single-storey residential property valued at approximately Rs. 15 lakhs in Rakh Barotian area in Vijaypur. This property belonged to the notorious drug dealer Shamas Din, alias Baeche, son of Maskeen Ali, hailing from Rakh Barotian tehsil Vijaypur in district Samba.

Another property, a residential house worth Rs 32 lakhs, belonging to notorious drug peddler Masoom Ali alias Kala, son of Dulla, resident of Rakh Barotian Teh Vijaypur District Samba has also been seized.

The administration, bolstered by the unwavering support of law enforcement agencies, executed this operation under sections 68-E read with 68-F of the NDPS Act of 1985, in connection with FIRs that have been registered at Police Station Vijaypur respectively .

The residential properties identified as ill-gotten gains acquired through illicit drug trafficking, were uncovered during thorough investigation and inquiry conducted by the vigilant officers of Police Station Vijaypur and established backward linkage of the properties of the accused with the drug peddling.

As part of the campaign, a strong message has been sent to curb the activities of drug peddlers by attaching the property of a notorious drug peddler. This action underscores the administration's firm resolve to tackle drug-related issues and ensure the safety and well-being of the community, a handout stated.

District Police Jammu orchestrated a meticulously planned operation resulting in the freezing/ seizure of property (residential house) of approximately Rs 50 lakhs at Rah Salyote Tehsil Chowki-Choura District Jammu . This property belonged to the notorious drug dealer Rohit Dutta, son of Hoshiar Chand, resident of Rah Salyote.

District Police Jammu executed this operation under sections 68-E read with 68-F of the NDPS Act of 1985, dealing with provisions against accused involved in drug peddling. The mandate has been provided for accused detained under PIT-NDPS ACT also.

The drug peddler Rohit Duta, son of Hoshiar Chand, resident of Rah Salyote is presently detained under PITNDPS Act by the Akhnoor Police in a warrant issued by Divisional Commissioner Jammu and is lodged in District Jail Kathua.

There are many cases against the said accused including several serious cases of Drug Peddling.

The property, identified as proceeds of narcotic gains/acquired through illicit drug trafficking, was uncovered during thorough investigation and inquiry conducted by the Police team of Akhnoor Subdivision with the help of revenue authorities. This operation serves as a stern reminder of the unwavering commitment of the District police Jammu to eradicate the drug menace from Jammu District. The property attachment operation was conducted by the team headed SDPO Akhnoor;SHO Akhnoor , Naib-Tehsildar Rah Salyote under supervision of SP Rural in presence of prominent citizens of the area.
