Notorious drug peddler arrested with heroin

JAMMU: Continuing its mission against drug peddlers in Jammu District, Police Party of Police Post Narwal while patrolling in the Rajiv Nagar area apprehended one person who was moving under suspicious conditions & on seeing the police party, he tried to escape but the alert police party chased and over powered him. During questioning, he disclosed his name as Biru, son of Suresh Kumar, resident of Rajeev Nagar, Narwal and on search 7 grams of heroin (Chitta) like substance was recovered from his possession. Accordingly FIR No.59/2024 under sections 8/201/22 NDPS Act has been registered against him at Police Station Bahu Fort, Jammu.

Bootlegger arrests with 24 bottles of illicit liquor

Notorious drug peddler arrested with cannabis

KISHTWAR: Kishtwar Police arrested one notorious drug paddler and recovered 56 Gms Cannabis like substance from his possession. As per details, a party of Police Station Kishtwar was conducting routine patrolling in Umar Mohalla / Bhagwan Mohalla Kishtwar. While Patrolling observed a suspicious moment of one pedestrian who on seeing the police patrolling party tried to flee from spot but alert cops of police party overpowered and apprehended him. On his personal search a white coloured polythene in which Cannabis (Charas) like substance weighing 56 gms was recovered and accused person was arrested from the spot. On enquiring the accused disclosed his identity as Firdous Ahmed S/o Abdul Kabeer Butt, resident of Umar Mohalla Kishtwar. In this regard a case FIR No. 66/2024 under section 8/20 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Kishtwar and investigation taken-up. SSP Kishtwar, Abdul Qayoom, issued a stern warning to drug syndicates, cautioning them to cease their activities or face legal repercussions. He also urged the general public of Kishtwar to share any information related to the sale of drugs with PCR Kishtwar at 9906154100. The identity of informants shall be kept confidential and they will be suitably rewarded.

Three inter-state drug smugglers held with 15 kg Ganja

JAMMU: District Police Jammu continue its zero tolerance policy against drugs abuse arrested three Orissa-based narcotic smugglers in Domana area of Jammu district and seized 15 Kg narcotics (Ganja)

A police team of Police Station Domana led by SHO Police Station Domana Insp. Arun Sharma, Assisted by PSI Younis Khanday while on patrolling duty at Muthi area rounded up three suspects later identified as Rakesh Mallick, son of Puran Chandra Mallick, resident of Ragajuda, Police Station Tikabal District Kandhamal, Orrisa; Sibasana Kanhar, son of Kanhar, resident of Rangamatia, Police Station Chakabad District Kandhamal Orrisa and Dayanidhi Naik, son of Bharat Naik, resident of Pochalundi, Police Station Tarshing District Ganjal Orrisa. Police attaches property worth Rs 5 lakhs linked to notorious drug peddler

AKHNOOR: In continuation its drive against drug peddlers to annihilate properties of drug peddlers in District Jammu, District Police Jammu today executed another attachment operation resulting in the freezing/ seizure of movable property (private Car) of approximately Rs 5 lakhs owned by spouse of peddler at Akhnor District Jammu. The said property belonged to the spouse of notorious drug peddler Rohit Dutta, son of Hoshiar Chand, resident of Rah Salyote, Tehsil Chowki -Choura, District Jammu. District police Jammu executed this operation under sections 68 A (d) & E read with 68-F of the NDPS Act of 1985, dealing with provisions for attachment of properties of family, relatives and associates of accused involved in drug peddling. The mandate has been provided for accused detained under PIT-NDPS ACT also. The drug peddler Rohit Dutta, son of Hoshiar Chand, resident of Rah Salyote is presently detained under PIT NDPS Act by the Akhnor police in a warrant issued by Divisional Commissioner Jammu and is lodged in district jail Kathua. There are many cases against said accused including several serious cases of drug peddling. The property, identified as proceeds of narcotics from ill-gotten gains acquired through illicit drug trafficking was uncovered during thorough investigation and inquiry conducted by police team of Akhnor Subdivision with the help of transport department. The property attachment operation was conducted by the team headed SDPO Akhnor, Mohan Sharma, SHO Akhnor Tariq Ahmed, under supervision of SP Rural Brijesh Sharma.
