JAMMU: District Police Jammu continue its zero tolerance policy against drugs abuse arrested three Orissa-based narcotic smugglers in Domana area of Jammu district and seized 15 Kg narcotics (Ganja)

A police team of Police Station Domana led by SHO Police Station Domana Insp. many cases against said accused including several serious cases of drug peddling. The property, identified as proceeds of narcotics from ill-gotten gains acquired through illicit drug trafficking was uncovered during thorough investigation and inquiry conducted by police team of Akhnoor Subdivision with the help of transport
