## HC expresses serious concern over forceful removal of couple from court premises

JAMMU: Justice Rahul Bharti of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court recently expressed serious concern over the forceful removal of a couple from the court premises on March 11. A girl along with a man had approached the Court for protection after having married against the wishes of their families. They were forcibly taken away from the court premises by persons in civilian clothes including the brother of the girl. Justice Rahul Bharti directed the Srinagar Police to avoid the repeat of the "omission and commission" that led to the incident. Justice Rahul Bharti further said that the incident also exposed the chinks in security measures at the court complex and thus directed the Registrar Judicial to conduct an audit of CCTV installations. Court further observed that "this development also exposes lack of appropriate security measures including deficient CCTV installation on the court premises so as to ensure that each and every nook and corner gets under CCTV surveillance. In this regard, this court directs the learned Registrar Judicial, Srinagar to audit the CCTV installation on the court premises and submit a report by the next date," the judge directed. Following the incident, the High Court had demanded the personal appearance of SSP Srinagar along with SSP security. "The very fact that the two petitioners have been taken away from the very court premises itself is a serious breach of security lapse on the part of the Security establishment posted at the High Court premises," the Bench had observed. Meanwhile, considering the age of the girl, the Court ordered her temporary lodging at the Child Welfare Committee Shelter Home. Further, it directed that only her parents be allowed to visit her. The investigation in the First Information Report (FIR) against the man was meanwhile ordered to be kept in abeyance. The Court also granted him protection from arrest.

## Despite several opportunities officer fails to file response CAT expresses anguish, stops JKAS officer's salary with immediate effect

JAMMU: A Bench of Central Administrative Tribunal comprising Member (J) Rajinder Singh Dogra and Member (A) Ram Mohan Johri at Jammu has stopped the salary of Shubhra Sharma, the then Director Animal Husbandry, Jammu with immediate effect and directed the DDO concerned to ensure that her salary be stopped with immediate effect till further orders. While expressing its displeasure over the non-filing of reply by the Director, Animal Husbandry, Jammu and Chairperson, Committee Against Sexual Harassment at Workplace (CASH) which was headed by Shubhra Sharma being its Chairperson on the ground that the Committee did not follow the procedure and the Guidelines/SOPs framed by the Government of India on the basis of Vishakha Guidelines, and the law laid down by the Supreme Court was not implemented in its letter and spirit and the entire enquiry was conducted in a manner unknown to law. The Bench of CAT at Jammu while taking serious note of casual

directions passed in an application filed by Anu Bala, Assistant Director, Fisheries Department, presently posted at Udhampur challenging the report of the Committee Against Sexual Harassment at Workplace (CASH) which was headed by Shubhra Sharma being its Chairperson on the ground that the Committee did not follow the procedure and the Guidelines/SOPs framed by the Government of India on the basis of Vishakha Guidelines, and the law laid down by the Supreme Court was not implemented in its letter and spirit and the entire enquiry was conducted in a manner unknown to law. The Bench of CAT at Jammu while taking serious note of casual

approach of Chairperson of the CASH Committee of the Animal Husbandry Department, Govt. of J&K observed that on perusal of records, it was revealed that vide orders dated 18-10-2024, 20-11-2024, 18-12-2024 and 10-02-2025, the respondents were granted last and final opportunity to file their reply and in case, the same is not filed, then coercive action would be taken against them and still, the respondents did not bother to file reply till date, after availing sufficient time. The Bench further observed that despite issuance of conditional orders, the respondents have neither filed the reply nor they have appeared before the Court to explain why it has not been filed till date.

The CAT Bench was infuriated over the callous attitude and conduct of the Senior JKAS Officer and her non-serious approach towards the Court Orders as the Tribunal while expressing its deep concern observed that, "non filing of the reply by the respondents leads to unnecessary delay in giving justice to the litigants and justice delayed is justice denied. The poor litigants who have no access to the Administration, knock the door of this Court in the hope that they will get justice here. The aggrieved litigant is running from pillar to post in order to get justice. It is very unfortunate that due to the callous attitude of officers/officials, public faith in the judiciary is getting eroded.

However, innocent litigants cannot be made to suffer for the lackadaisical approach of the respondents." The Tribunal further observed that, "nobody is above the law, so in order to uphold the majesty of law, this court was compelled to pass such an adverse order." With these serious observations and directions, the Bench of CAT at Jammu comprising Member (J) Rajinder Singh Dogra and Member (A) Ram Mohan Johri directed that salary of Shubhra Sharma (JKAS), Director Animal Husbandry, Jammu presently MD JKRLM be stopped with immediate effect till further orders and directed her DDO to ensure the stoppage of her salary till further orders.

## Migrant property cannot be handed over to anyone without owner's written consent: HC

JAMMU: Justice Javed Iqbal Wani of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court upheld the eviction order passed by the Financial Commissioner in evicting the illegal occupant of a migrant property. The court held that the occupant-petitioner herein could not have taken over the possession of the land in question except with the express consent of the migrant in writing, to be handed over by the District Magistrate alone. The court said that even if the agreement existed, it did not confer legal ownership or valid possession. The petitioner relied on an agreement to sell allegedly executed by the contesting respondents. Justice Javed Iqbal Wani added that although there was an agreement to sell the property by which the said land was possessed, the court held that the Migrant Act, 1997, prohibits the alienation of migrant property without prior government permission. The court held that since the possession was taken without written consent and official permission, the petitioner was deemed an unauthorized occupant under Section 2(i) of the Migrant Act.

The court added that under Sections 54 and 138 of the J&K Transfer of Property Act, 1977, a sale of immovable property is valid only if executed by a registered sale deed. The court also held that an agreement to sell does not create ownership rights, meaning the petitioner's claim was legally unsustainable. The petitioner challenged the order passed by the Financial Commissioner, which upheld an eviction order issued by the District Magistrate, Pulwama. Respondent No. 5, Kamla Devi, filed an application under the J&K Migrant Immovable Property (Preservation, Protection, and Restraint on Distress Sales) Act, 1997, seeking eviction of the petitioner from 11 kanals and 3.5 marlas of land. She claimed she was a migrant and that the petitioner had illegally encroached upon her land. A portion of this land (5 kanals and 8.5 marlas) had already been sold with prior permission from the Divisional Commissioner to Respondents 6 and 7 through a sale deed. The District Magistrate ordered eviction, directing the Tehsildar to remove the petitioner and hand over the alienated land to the

purchasers. The petitioner first challenged the eviction order, which was disposed of with liberty to avail appeal remedies. The subsequent appeal was dismissed by the Financial Commissioner on May 28, 2019. Further challenges, including an LPA and an SLP before the Supreme Court, also failed. The Supreme Court, however, granted liberty to the petitioner to file an appeal under Section 7 of the 1997 Act after complying with the required legal formalities. After surrendering possession as per the Supreme Court's order, the petitioner filed an appeal, which was dismissed by the Financial Commissioner on October 3, 2023, leading to the present writ petition.
