

JKBOSE to implement uniform curricula across all affiliated schools

JAMMU: The Jammu & Kashmir Board of School Education develops textbooks strictly in alignment with the curricular goals envisaged in National Curriculum Frameworks. The process is carried out by a dedicated panel of experts drawn from higher education, school education and other distinguished fields. The process of reviewing, editing and finalization of textbooks is conducted solely by experts engaged and entrusted based on their academic credentials and subject expertise. This ensures that textbooks are developed with academic rigor, free from any undue intervention. JKBOSE reviews and develops syllabi, courses of studies and textbooks for class 1st to 12th as per the guidelines and recommendations of National Curriculum Frameworks which are seminal documents on the National Education Policy to have uniformity in the education system throughout the country. This has facilitated our students to compete at national and international level. Section-10 of the JKBOSE Act of 1975 mandates the JKBOSE to develop courses of instruction, prepare curricula, and prescribe textbooks from pre-primary to higher secondary levels and Elementary Teachers Training Course. Further, as per SRO 123 Clause 11(a), every affiliated school must follow the curriculum and textbooks prescribed by JKBOSE. Any deviation from this directive is a violation of regulatory norms, and no external publisher can dictate or alter the prescribed textbooks. On the top of that the High Court has also reaffirmed that all affiliated schools must adhere to SRO 123, reinforcing that JKBOSE is well within its rights to make it mandatory for all the Private Schools to prescribe Textbooks published by JKBOSE.

The State Affiliation Committee/ Recognition Committee in its meetings held on 7th August, 2013 and 18th May, 2023, has resolved that any deviation or non-compliance of the Instructions or orders of the JKBOSE or Government of Jammu and Kashmir issued from time to time regarding prescribed text books and curricula by any academic institution shall warrant a disciplinary action, imposition of a penalty up to Rs.50,000 or both and that it shall be reinforced for strict implementation. Accordingly, the Jammu and Kashmir Board of School Education issued a notification bearing No. F (Acad-C)/E-File-7318285/TEXT/BK-XIV/23. Dated 22-12-2023 for implementation of JKBOSE curriculum and textbooks published/prescribed by JKBOSE from academic session 2024-25 for classes 1st to 12th with the strict directions that no school shall force any parent/student

Shiv Sena demands reconsideration, planning of unemployment allowance

JAMMU: It is unfortunate that the government does not have any scheme or money to give allowance to the educated unemployed, but the consensus on increasing their salary, pension, development fund in a jiffy forces one to think that the aim of the people in power is 'only their own happiness', stated by Manish Sahni, President, Shiv Sena (UBT) Jammu and Kashmir unit. In a press conference held today at the party's state central office, state chief Manish Sahni said that the growing unemployment in Jammu and Kashmir is a matter of deep concern, the young generation disappointed by not getting employment is getting trapped in depression and is rapidly moving towards the web of drug addiction and crime. Despite more than four months having passed since the formation of the government, no concrete steps have been taken to provide relief to the youth from unemployment. According to the data presented by the government, 3.70 lakh unemployed are registered in the state, although the ground figures are much higher than this.

Sahni has demanded from the Omar Abdullah government to give allowance to educated unemployed youth. To purchase books and material other than those published by JKBOSE. The BOSE shall take all measures to implement its statutory mandate of ensuring uniform curricula in all schools as has been endorsed by the High Court also in line with the provisions of National Education Policy. Of late it has been decided that special teams will be constituted in collaboration with School Education department to carry out inspections across the Union Territory to ensure compliance of uniform curricula in all the schools, and if any educational institution affiliated with BOSE is found violating the instructions, it might face action as per the relevant provisions of Board of School Education norms. While free textbooks stand already distributed in all the government schools in winter zone, the BOSE has taken measures in earnest to make sure that the supply of textbooks meant for private schools is also readily available with registered book sellers in the market. Apt to mention that the textbooks prescribed by BOSE are well developed and cost effective. The printing is up to the mark and well researched. These textbooks are based on the NCERT format and content and are locally contextualised with local specific touch and infusion thus creating a sense of belongingness

Subject: Licensing of Contractor under Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970 and other labour laws.

NOTICE

The Labour Department is mandated to enforce the implementation of Labour Laws in order to safeguard the rights of workers and promote their overall welfare. It has been observed that various Contractors, to whom this Act applies, are undertaking/ executing the works through contract labour without obtaining the License from the Licensing Officer (Assistant Labour Commissioner) of the district. Whereas, Section-12 of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970, reads as under:

1. With effect from such date as the appropriate Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint, no contractor to whom this Act applies, shall undertake or execute any work through contract labour except under and in accordance with a license issued in that behalf by the licensing officer.
2. Subject to the provisions of this Act, a license under sub section (1) may contain such conditions including, in particular, conditions as to hours of work, fixation of wages and other essential amenities in respect of contract labour as appropriate Government may deem fit to impose in accordance with the rules, if any, made under section-35 and shall be issued on payment of such fees and on the deposit of such sum, if any, as security for the due performance of the conditions as may be prescribed.

Further, it is also important to note that as per Section-13 of the Contract Labour Act:

- 1) Every application for the grant of a license under sub-section (1) of Section-12 shall be made in the prescribed form and shall contain the particulars regarding the location of the establishment, the nature of process, operation or work for which contract labour is to be employed and such other particulars as may be prescribed.
- 2) The licensing officer may make such investigation in respect of the application for grant of license as he may deem fit to make and may cause to be investigated the licensing officer shall follow such procedure as may be prescribed.
- 3) A license granted under this section shall be valid for the period specified therein and may be renewed from time to time for such period, and on payment of such fees and on such conditions as may be prescribed.

Furthermore, as per Chapter-V (Sections - 16 to 21) of the Act, in every establishment where one hundred or more contract labours are employed by the contractor, the Contractor shall:

- provide and maintain one or more canteens for the use of contract labour;
- provide and maintain rest-rooms for the use of the contract labour required to halt at night in connection with the work of an establishment;
- provide sufficient supply of wholesome drinking water, number of latrines and urinals, washing facilities, as to be convenient and accessible to the contract labour in the establishment.
- provide and maintain first-aid facilities to the contract labour during all working hours;
- pay wages to each contract labour before the expiry of such period, as may be prescribed before 7th day where less than 100 workers are employed and in other cases before 10th day of the preceding month.

Moreover, every Contractor shall maintain such registers and records giving such particulars of contract labour employed nature of work performed by the contract labour, the rates of wages paid to the contract labour and such other particulars in such form as may be prescribed. The Contractor shall also keep exhibited within the premises of the establishment, where the contract labour is employed, notices in the prescribed form containing particulars about the hours of work, nature of duty and such other information as may be prescribed.

Penalties and Non-compliance:

As per Section-23 of the Contract Labour Act, 1970, whoever contravenes any provisions of the Act or any rules made thereunder prohibiting, restricting, or regulating the employment of contract labour, or contravenes any condition of license granted under the Act, shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three months, or with fine which may extend to Rs. 1000/-, or with both and in the case of continuing contravention with an additional fine which may extend to Rs. 100/- for every day during which such contravention continues after conviction for the first such contravention. Section-24 of the Act also provides for punishment with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three months, or with fine which may extend to Rs.1000/-, or with both, for the offender for which no other penalty is elsewhere provided. Similarly in terms of Inter-State Migrant Workmen Act (RE & CS), 1979, the penal provisions for non-compliance shall also be invoked.

Therefore, in view of the above quoted law, it is impressed upon all the Contractors of District Ramban to strictly abide by the provisions as laid down under the Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970 and other Labour Laws and Rules made thereunder and promptly initiate the Licensing process under Section-12 & 13 of the Contract Labour Act to avoid any legal repercussions and to uphold the rights and welfare of contract labourers.
