They demonstrated the practical application of various digital tools such as e-Sakshya, e-Summon, Medleapr, etc - essential platforms for improving investigation workflows and ensuring transparency. The session featured key addresses by resource persons, including Inspector Kali Charan, Inspector Deepak Thakur, and Sg. Ct.

Shabir Ahmed (CCTNS), who elaborated on the technological advancements and procedural updates. Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP) Sanjay Parihar, along with Senior Public Prosecutor (Sr PO) Neha Nayyar and Deputy Superintendent of Police (Dy SP) Javaid Iqbal

JAMMU: In line with the provisions of the Food Safety and Standards Act (FSSA), the teams of the Food Safety DFCO Jammu have intensified their efforts with a comprehensive Milk Drive across the Jammu Division in preparation for the upcoming Eid-ul-Fitr and Navratra festivals.

The drive aims to ensure the safety and quality of milk and milk products, as well as other food items in the market.

Led by the Deputy Commissioner of Food Safety Jammu, the teams conducted inspections and raids on milk vendors in areas like Police Naka Janipur, Jammu.

During this extensive drive, 30 milk and milk product samples were tested on the spot using the MFPIV (Mobile Food Testing Vehicle). Out of these, three milk samples and one paneer sample were sent to laboratories for further

analysis under the legal provisions of the FSSA.

The teams have been directed to carry out consistent drives across all districts of Jammu Division, especially during the festive season, to curb the menace of adulteration.

Food Business Operators (FBOs), including sweet shops, bakeries, and dairy vendors, have been advised to maintain hygiene, cleanliness, and sanitation standards.
