Ajatshatru condemns Dy CM's remarks on J&K Maharajas

JAMMU: Senior BJP leader and former minister, Ajatshatru Singh, grandson of Maharaja Hari Singh, has expressed profound dismay over the recent comments made by Deputy Chief Minister Surinder Choudhary, who referred to the late Maharaja as a "dictator."

He emphasized that such statements not only misrepresent historical facts but also tarnish the legacy of a ruler who was instrumental in shaping modern Jammu & Kashmir. Maharaja Hari Singh's reign (1925-1947) was characterized by progressive reforms that laid the foundation for the region's development.

He championed education by establishing numerous schools and colleges, promoted social justice by opposing untouchability, and upheld religious harmony by ensuring equal rights for all communities. His decision to accede Jammu & Kashmir to India in 1947 was pivotal in integrating the state into the Indian Union.

Ajatshatru remarked, "Maharaja Hari Singh's visionary leadership and commitment to the welfare of his subjects are well-documented and celebrated." He highlighted that the Maharaja's contributions continue to influence the socio-cultural fabric of the region. The former Minister called upon Deputy Chief Minister Surinder Choudhary to retract his statement and issue an unconditional apology to the people of Jammu & Kashmir.

He stressed the importance of respecting historical figures who have played significant roles in the region's past and cautioned against making unfounded remarks that could sow discord among communities. Ajatshatru Singh urged political leaders to exercise restraint and ensure that their statements are rooted in historical accuracy and contribute positively to societal harmony.

SERVING CUSTOMERS WITH A SMILE

Makhan Din's Custodial Torture Sub-Judge/Spl. Mobile Magistrate Kathua directs SHO Billawar to register FIR

JAMMU: In a significant order, Sub-Judge/Special Mobile Magistrate, Kathua, Amandeep Kour has directed the SHO, Police Station Billawar to register an FIR and initiate a thorough investigation into the custodial torture allegations concerning Makhan Din while he was in police custody. The order was passed following complaints filed by Mohd Mureed (father of the deceased) and Juna Begum (widow of the deceased). In a four-page order, the Special Mobile Magistrate considered arguments presented by Advocate Appu Singh Salathia, representing the complainants, and Senior PO Munish Kumar, representing SSP Kathua and SHO Billawar. The court disposed of two complaints-one by Advocates Mohd Anwar Chowdhary and Sheikh Shakeel Ahmed and the other by the father and widow of the deceased. Referring to Lalita Kumari v. Govt. of UP, the court reaffirmed the Supreme Court's mandate that an FIR must be registered in cases

involving cognizable offences. Several other landmark judgments, including Ramesh Kumari v. State (NCT of Delhi), State of Haryana & Ors. v. Ch. Bhajan Lal & Ors., Sirajuddin v. State of Madras, and Priyanka Srivastava & Anr. v. State of UP, were cited in court.

During the hearing, Advocate Appu Singh Salathia presented a compilation of thirteen Supreme Court judgments on custodial torture, inquest proceedings, FIR registration, and dying declarations.

On behalf of the police, Senior PO Munish Kumar submitted an Action Taken Report (ATR), stating that inquest proceedings under Section 194 BNSS, 2023, were initiated on February 5, 2025, and a Magisterial Inquiry was ordered by the District Magistrate on February 6, 2025. He further noted that SDPO Billawar had allowed a preliminary inquiry, assigning the investigation to PSI Rahul Sharma, who found no evidence of torture in his inquiry. However, the three

ongoing inquiries remained inconclusive.

Advocate Appu Singh Salathia, representing the complainants, strongly contended that police officials had violated the principles laid down in D.K. Basu v. State of West Bengal and emphasized that an FIR must be registered based on the dying declaration of Makhan Din. The court was informed that before his death, Makhan Din publicly swore on the Holy Quran inside a mosque, alleging that he was subjected to third-degree torture to force a false confession of links with anti-national elements, despite being innocent.

Salathia further presented video evidence of Makhan Din's last recorded words, arguing that the video deposition alone constituted sufficient evidence for an FIR. She accused the Billawar Police of shielding the accused officers by deliberately failing to register a case, which compelled the complainants to seek judicial intervention.

After hearing arguments from both sides, Sub-Judge Amandeep Kour directed the SHO, Police Station Billawar

to register an FIR and conduct a thorough investigation as per the law. The court allowed the application filed by Makhan Din's father and widow but rejected the request for a separate FIR on behalf of Advocates Chowdhary and Ahmed, ruling that their complaint did not introduce new facts warranting another FIR.

With these directives, the court disposed of the matter, ensuring that a formal investigation is initiated. Present in court during the proceedings were complainant Advocates Mohd Anwar Chowdhary and Sheikh Shakeel Ahmed, along with Mohd Mureed (father of the deceased) and Advocate M. Zulkarnain Chowdhary.
