SC collegium recommends repatriation of Justice Atul Sreedharan back to MP High Court

JAMMU: The Supreme Court Collegium, during its meeting on March 6, 2025, has recommended the repatriation of Justice Atul Sreedharan, currently serving as a Judge of the High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, to his parent High Court in Madhya Pradesh. Justice Sreedharan was initially appointed as a Judge of the Madhya Pradesh High Court on April 7, 2016. In early 2023, he sought a transfer from the Madhya Pradesh High Court, citing that his elder daughter was set to commence her legal practice and would be appearing before the District Court and the Indore Bench of the High Court. To avoid any potential conflict of interest and to uphold the integrity of the judiciary, Justice Sreedharan requested a transfer. The Supreme Court Collegium, acknowledging his concerns, recommended his transfer to the High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh on March 28, 2023. Born on May 24, 1966, Justice Atul Sreedharan completed his law degree and began his legal practice in 1992. He worked under Senior Advocate Gopal Subramaniam before practicing independently in Delhi and later in Indore. Over the years, he represented various government and private entities, specializing in criminal, civil, and service matters. Justice Sreedharan was appointed as a Judge of the Madhya Pradesh High Court on April 7, 2016.

HC restrained from making any promotions unless candidates belonging to SC/ST reserved categories entitled for consideration for reservation in promotions are considered

JAMMU: Justice MA Chowdhary of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court restrained respondents from making any promotions unless candidates belonging to the SC/ST reserved categories entitled for consideration for reservation in promotions are considered. This judgment has been passed in a petition seeking an appropriate writ, order or direction including one in the nature of Certiorari for quashment of impugned Circular No. 10-JK (GAD) of 2021 dated March 5, 2021 issued by the Respondent No. 3 whereby all the administrative secretaries have been asked to keep the slots meant for reserved employees vacant/unfilled, the same being ultravires to Articles 14 and 16(4A) of the Constitution of India and also issue an appropriate writ, order or direction including one in the nature of Mandamus commanding the

respondents to promote the petitioners as well as other reserved category employees of the UT of J&K to their respective next higher posts on their roster slots under their respective Reserved Categories strictly in terms of J&K Reservation Act, 2004 and J&K Reservation Rules, 2005 and also seeking direction including one in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the petitioners as well as other reserved category candidates of the UT of J&K on the roster slots under their respective categories strictly in terms of J&K Reservation Act, 2004 and J&K Reservation Rules, 2005. Justice MA Chowdhary after hearing both the sides observed that the benefit of reservation in promotions is stated to be accorded all across India in accordance with Article 16(4A) of the Constitution of India and applying the directions issued in terms of Circular dated

March 5, 2021 in denying benefits of reservation in promotion in UT of J&K amounts to denying/treating reserved category employees/candidates of the UT of J&K differently than the reserved category employees/candidates of the rest of the Country, which amounts to class legislation, which is antithetical to the concept of equality laid down in the Constitution of India. Be that as it may, since in its affidavit referred hereinabove, the respondent-UT of Jammu and Kashmir has taken a stand before the Apex Court with regard to its intentions to implement the reservation in promotions, therefore, denying reservation to all the members of the service, who are entitled to such reservation in promotions, amounts to denying them of their constitutional rights. Court further observed that with the application of relevant Article 16(4A) of the Constitution of India, provid-

ing for reservation in promotions being applicable to the UT of Jammu and Kashmir; the respondents should have gone for an exercise to collect the quantifiable data as per the judgment passed by the Apex Court in Jarnail Singh's case (supra) to take a view in case the Government was not satisfied with the percentage providing for reservation of 8% and 10% to the SCs and STs in the matter of promotions. The Apex court has, in Jarnail Singh's case, simplified the collection of data which, for the UT of Jammu and Kashmir, was an easy task with short cadres unlike other bigger states. This exercise could have been done by the Administrative Departments in a couple of days instead of waiting for years and there was no need to issue the impugned Circular to scuttle the constitutional rights of the reserved SC/ST categories officers/officials to provide for reservation in promotions,

there being inadequate representation to the marginalized and disadvantaged communities. With these observations, High Court disposed of the petition with the directions that the respondents shall collect quantifiable data having regard to the 'cadre' as 'unit' for consideration of collection of quantifiable data within a period of six weeks from the date of this judgment and then accord consideration to the reservation in promotions to the petitioners as and when promotions to the next cadres are considered. Court further directed that in absence of collecting any quantifiable data as directed vide direction No. (i), the respondents shall proceed to consider the petitioners for reservation in promotions against the reserved slots in view of Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and rules framed thereunder till the exercise for collection of quantifiable data is made by

the Administrative Departments. High Court further restrained respondents from making any promotions unless candidates belonging to the SC/ST reserved categories entitled for consideration for reservation in promotions are considered. In a press release issued from the party's state central office, state chief Manish Sahni said that free travel in e-bus for women and increase in marriage amount is a welcome step. But not giving any relief on the demands of temporary employees and daily wagers is disappointing. SRINAGAR: The Press Club of Kashmir expressed surprised over the statement of Omar Abdullah, Chief Minister of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir regarding the Press Club of Kashmir and Jammu on the floor of the assembly in Jammu, wherein he said that he would work for the revival of the clubs. The executive bodies of both clubs felt that CM Omar Abdullah intended to give the impression that the clubs are defunct, which is far from the truth. The executive bodies of both clubs reiterated that two clubs are functional under the incumbent executive bodies. However, the members expressed concern over the CM's ignorance that both the Press clubs at Jammu and Srinagar already exist under proper management. The Executive Members of the Club in

meeting on Friday met here, also appreciated the sentiments of the CM Omar Abdullah about Press freedom, which they hoped would be implemented in letter and spirit. Importantly, Press Club of Kashmir is functional from a rented private building at Amira Kadal, near Gurudwara in Srinagar. The president Mohammad Saleem Pandit and president Press Club of Jammu, Sanjeev Pragal presided over the meeting. The members equally criticized CM Omar Abdullah for skipping to provide any financial support to the respective clubs, notwithstanding the fact that the Clubs come under the purview of the LG of UT. The meeting was attended, among others by vice president Ayaz Hafiz, General Secretary Zulfikhar Majid, Treasurer Farzana Mumtaz, while Jammu based Executive members

including Asfaq Gowhar of Gulistan TV News and others joined the meeting virtually, besides the president of Press Club of Jammu. General Secretary Zulfikhar shed light on the future proposals of the Press Club of Kashmir and disclosed that the executive body is proposing to offer a health insurance cover to the club members and their family members in the coming future, which will help mitigate the health issues of the journalists in the valley in particular.
