Enrolment in Regular Cadre	On completion of four years of service, based on organisation's requirements and policies promulgated by the respective services. Agniveers will be offered an opportunity to apply for permanent enrolment in the Armed Forces. These applications will be considered in a centralised manner based on objective criteria including performance during their four-year engagement period and up to 25% of each specific batch of Agniveers will be enrolled in Indian Armed Forces for further re-engagement in regular cadre. Agniveers will not have any right to be selected for further enrolment in to the Govt of India. Selection of the Agniveers for further enrolment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the Govt of India.																																																																															
Marital Status and Pregnancy	Only unmarried Indian male and female candidates are eligible for enrolment as Agniveer. Candidates will have to give a certificate of being 'unmarried' at the time of enrolment. Agniveers shall not be permitted to marry during their entire tenure of four years in the respective services. A candidate shall be dismissed from service if he/ she marries during his/ her tenure or is found to be already married despite giving certificate of being unmarried. Female candidates additionally shall be required to undertake not to get pregnant during the engagement period. Such women Agniveer on becoming Low Medical Category (LMC) due to pregnancy shall be liable to be discharged from service. Pregnancy will debar the women Agniveer for selection into regular cadre.

Pay, Allowances, Allied Benefits and Agniveer Corpus Fund (Seva Nidhi Package)	<p>Agniveers enrolled under this scheme will be paid an Agniveer package of Rs. 30,000/- per month with a fixed yearly increment. In addition, Risk and Hardship allowances, Dress and Travel allowances will be paid. Perks such as ration, clothing, accommodation and Leave Travel Concession (LTC) shall also be provided as per the existing rules.
