

Judicial Academy organizes workshop on "Court Management, Mediation and Legal, Social & Psychological Dimensions of Dowry-Related Offences"

JAMMU: Under the patronage of Chief Justice, High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh (Patron-in-Chief, J&K Judicial Academy), Arun Palli and guidance of Chairperson and Members of Governing Committee for J&K Judicial Academy, the Jammu & Kashmir Judicial Academy organized a one day Integrated Workshop (A-059/25) on "Court Management, Mediation and Legal, Social & Psychological Dimensions of Dowry-Related Offences" for Judicial Officers of Jammu Province today at its Jammu campus. The programme commenced with registration, followed by an introduction and welcome address by Naseer Ahmad Dar, Director, J&K Judicial Academy. He underscored the importance of judicial leadership, effective court administration and sensitivity while dealing with

socially complex offences. The first session on Judicial Leadership & Court Management was delivered by Pawan Dev Kotwal, Former District & Sessions Judge, High Court of J&K. It focused on the role of a Judge as an institutional leader, court and case management principles, control of docket flow, time management techniques and best practices including the use of technology to enhance efficiency in the justice delivery system.

The second session on Role of Judges in Mediation & Drafting of Referral/Settlement Orders was conducted by M.S. Parihar, Former District & Sessions Judge, High Court of J&K. He elaborated on the statutory framework under Section 89 CPC and relevant rules, identification of cases fit for mediation, stage and manner of referral, compo-

nents and ethics of mediation, drafting of effective referral and settlement orders and practical challenges faced in mediation proceedings.

The third session addressed the Legal, Social and Psychological Dimensions of Dowry-Related Crimes, in light of the recent Supreme Court Judgment dated 15.12.2025 in State of U.P. v. Ajmal Beg & Ors.

The session was conducted by Kamlesh Pandita, Former District & Sessions Judge, High Court of J&K and

Ladakh, along with Sumedha Sharma, Clinical Psychologist Associate. The deliberations covered relevant legal provisions and recent judicial directions, the social context and concerns of misuse, psychological impact on victims and families, judicial sensitivity in appreciation of evidence and the need to ensure a fair trial while preventing abuse of process. The workshop witnessed active participation and interaction from the Judicial Officers, followed by a feedback session.

Progress of Digital Crop Survey reviewed

JAMMU: Director Agriculture Jammu, Anil Gupta on Saturday reviewed the progress of the ongoing Digital Crop Survey during a field visit to Village Ladori, Panchayat Nagbani Flora, Sub Division Marh.

A live demonstration of the survey process was conducted. He assessed the on-ground implementation of the survey and interacted with field functionaries to ensure that data collection is being carried out in accordance with the prescribed guidelines and within the stipulated timeline.

The Director was accompanied by Sanjay Anand, Joint Director Agriculture (Extension); Manohar Lal Sharma, Chief Agriculture Officer Jammu; Krishan Kant, Regional Level SMS; Rajeev Katoch, District Level SMS;

Mam Mehta, AEO; along with JAEs and AEs of the concerned Panchayat.

The Digital Crop Survey is a flagship initiative of the Government of India aimed at collecting real-time and accurate data on crop sown area and crop conditions through digital technology. The initiative seeks to enhance transparency; enable evidence-based agricultural planning, ensure timely settlement of crop insurance claims and facilitate efficient delivery of farmer benefits such as PM-Kisan, subsidies, relief assistance and income support schemes. By replacing manual estimation with geotagged and field-verified data, the survey strengthens decision-making, minimizes discrepancies and supports improved policy formulation in the agricultural sector.

Addressing the officers and

field functionaries on the occasion, the Director Agriculture Jammu highlighted the operational aspects of the Digital Crop Survey and underscored the pivotal role of field staff in ensuring accuracy and timeliness of data. He directed adherence to prescribed protocols for reliable and standardized data collection.

The Director further directed that a dedicated grievance cell be established at the Directorate level to address queries and field-level issues promptly so that the survey is completed within the stipulated time frame.

Joint Director Agriculture (Extension) informed that the Digital Crop Survey has already commenced in seven districts of Jammu Division, while the remaining three hilly terrain districts will begin the exercise from Monday.
