

Army soldier dies of suspected cardiac arrest in Poonch BSF jawan hangs self to death in Samba

STATE TIMES NEWS MENDIAR/JAMMU: An Army soldier died of a suspected cardiac arrest while on duty on the Line of Control in Poonch district, officials said on Monday.

Naik Tilak Singh was posted in the forward Nangi Takri area of Krishna Ghati sector, the officials said.

Paying tributes to the soldier for his courage and commitment to duty, the Army White Knight Corps said in a post on X, "In solemn remembrance, White Knight Corps pays tribute to braveheart Naik Tilak Singh, who was found unconscious while performing duty on the LoC in Krishna Ghati sector on March 15. Despite immediate medical assistance, the brave soldier could not be revived and made the supreme sacrifice in the line of duty."

"His unwavering courage and commitment to duty exemplify the finest traditions of the Indian Army. His supreme sacrifice will continue to inspire generations."

Meanwhile, a Border Security Force (BSF) jawan allegedly committed suicide inside a camp in Samba district early Monday, officials said.

Head Constable Hari Babu, a resident of Uttar Pradesh, was found hanging inside his post at a camp in Penthi area.

The officials said the body was shifted to hospital for post-mortem and other legal formalities.

The motive behind his taking such an extreme step was not known immediately, the officials said, adding police have started inquest proceedings and further investigation is on.

Four assets worth crores linked to drug peddler attached

STATE TIMES NEWS SRINAGAR: Police on Monday attached assets worth crores belonging to an alleged drug peddler in Pulwama district, officials said.

Police attached four immovable properties belonging to "notorious drug peddler" Mukhtar Ahmad Bhat, a resident of Rakhe Lajoura, in connection with an FIR under sections 8/15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act registered at Pulwama police station, officials said. They said the attached properties include a double-storeyed residential house, a shopping complex, a washing centre and another commercial structure, constructed on different land parcels at Rakhe Lajoura (Kunjipora) in Pulwama. The properties were identified as illegally acquired assets generated through proceeds of drug trafficking and attached under provisions of Section 68-F(1) of the NDPS Act, officials added.
