Yasha Mudgal reviews operational status, liquidation roadmap of J&KSCARD Bank

STATE TIMES NEWS JAMMU: Commissioner Secretary, Cooperatives, Yasha Mudgal on Wednesday chaired a review meeting at Civil Secretariat here to evaluate the current operational status and liquidation roadmap of the Jammu & Kashmir State Cooperative Agriculture and Rural Development Bank (J&KSCARD Bank).
 The meeting was attended by Registrar Cooperative Societies, J&K, Mohammad Shafiq Chak; Special Secretary, Cooperatives, Ulfat Jabeen; Director Finance, Cooperative department,



other senior officers of the department, representatives from the Finance department and NABARD. During the

meeting, Registrar Cooperative Societies presented a comprehensive update on the Bank's status and future roadmap for the progress of its liquidation process, being carried out in accordance with the provisions of the Jammu & Kashmir Cooperative Societies Act, 1989.
 He also informed the meeting that the process of appointing a panel of liquidators is in the final stages of preparation.
 Addressing the officers during the meeting, Yasha Mudgal emphasized that the liquidation must proceed in a transparent, systematic and

strictly time-bound manner, with full compliance to all statutory procedures and legal requirements. She directed the concerned officers to ensure that the appointed liquidators immediately undertake a thorough assessment of Bank's assets, liabilities, records, and finalize the proceedings within the stipulated timeframe.
 The Commissioner Secretary underscored the paramount importance of protecting the interests of all stakeholders, particularly depositors. She issued strict instructions for maintaining meticulous documentation, completing full

financial reconciliation and ensuring adherence to all applicable legal provisions at every stage. Yasha Mudgal also called for close coordination among the Cooperative department, Finance department and other relevant agencies like NABARD, to enable smooth, efficient and timely execution of the liquidation process.
 She also called for expeditious completion of all pending formalities related to the appointment of liquidators, so that the proceedings can commence at the earliest and conclude within a structured and time-bound framework.

Com JMC inspects Wards 26, 39, 66; assures time-bound redressal of civic issues

STATE TIMES NEWS JAMMU: Commissioner, Jammu Municipal Corporation (JMC) Dr. Devansh Yadav on Wednesday undertook an extensive inspection tour of Wards 26, 39 and 66, covering the areas of Top Sherkhania, Subash Nagar, Suryavanshi Nagar, Lower Roopnagar and Muthi, to take firsthand stock of the civic issues and challenges being faced by the residents.
 During the visit, Dr. Yadav interacted with locals, who apprised him of a range of pressing concerns affecting their day-to-day lives. Prominent among these were demand for a comprehensive improvement in the drinking water supply system, immediate repair and maintenance of

drainage networks to prevent waterlogging and black-topping of dilapidated roads. Residents also emphasized the need for tiling work in inner lanes to enhance accessibility and cleanliness. In addition, the locals raised serious concerns regarding sanitation conditions in various pockets of the locality and highlighted the issue of non-functional streetlights, which pose safety risks, especially during night hours.
 Taking prompt cognizance of

these issues, Dr. Yadav issued on-the-spot directions to the concerned officials to ensure swift and effective action. Health Officer, Dr. Vinod Sharma was directed to intensify sanitation measures in the area and to carry out regular inspections, including daily monitoring of the attendance and performance of sanitary workers to ensure accountability and efficiency.
 Further, officials from the Electrical Division were instructed to conduct a comprehensive survey of streetlights in the area and ensure immediate repair or replacement of all non-functional units. Directions were also issued to the engineering wings to assess the requirements for drainage repairs, road black-topping and lane-tilting work and initiate necessary action at the earliest.
 Reaffirming the commit-

ment of the Jammu Municipal Corporation towards improving civic amenities, Dr. Yadav assured the residents that all genuine demands would be addressed on priority and within a stipulated time frame. He emphasized that coordinated efforts among various departments of JMC would be ensured to deliver tangible results on the ground.
 Dr. Yadav further stated that such field visits are part of the Corporation's ongoing efforts to directly engage with citizens, understand their concerns and implement need-based solutions in a transparent and efficient manner.

3-day Workshop on GYAN BHARATAM MISSION concludes at Jammu

workshops. The Director also highlighted the objectives of GYAN BHARATAM MISSION and its goal to digitize and share India's ancient knowledge and manuscripts. He said that these manuscripts to cover Ayurveda, Agriculture Science, Vedas, and everyday life topics etc. The Director said that post training program, the line department officer teams will search manuscripts door-to-door, like "Har Ghar Dastak" & Digitize with the custodians' to create a universal Indian Knowledge System portal and make it accessible to scholars, universities and the public
