- 1. After opening of the tender if the rates quoted by the lowest bidder are found to be high & value of work is more than the advertised cost, the bidder is advised to negotiate his/her quoted rates with the department / offer his/her consent within five days after opening of the tenders, failing which the work shall be put to fresh tender.
2. Vide Finance Department Circular No. 01 (Adm) FD of 2025 Dated:- 08-07-2025, Every participating supplier/contractor to mandatory disclose the bank account number which is linked with their GSTIN at the time of bid submission no payments shall be released by the Government Department/Agency to any other bank account except the one linked with the GST registered number of the successful bidder.
3. Bid must be accompanied with cost of Tender Document in shape of Treasury Challan Debited to MH.0215 REW and earnest money in the shape of CDR @ 2% of the advertised cost in favour of Executive Engineer REW Division Poonch failing which the tender will be rejected out rightly. The tender fee will be accepted only in the form of Treasury Voucher and No other mean will be accepted. It is mandatory to mention the name of the contractor in the shape of CDR @ 2% of the advertised cost in favour of Executive Engineer REW Division Poonch. The date of start of bid and Bid Submission date) pledged to Executive Engineer REW Division Poonch.
4. Successful bidder will submit 3% additional performance security in the shape of CDR/PDR/ B.G. The total 5% will be released after completion of defect liability period of the work.
5. As per order issued by this office vide No. XEN/REW/P/4058-61 Dated:-21-02-2025, The Extra CDRs shall be released after successful completion of works.
6. The lowest bidder shall have to provide the CDR/PDR/B.G. within weeks' time for the issuance of allotment failing which he/she will be imposed to provide the CDR issue date to be uploaded, shall not before the date of e-NIT and no other CDR shall be accepted as replacement, under rules.
7. The successful bidder / Contractor who fails to start work within seven (07 Days) from the date of issuance of Allotment will be imposed to provide the CDR issue date to be uploaded, shall not before the date of e-NIT and no other CDR shall be accepted as replacement, under rules.
8. The tender receiving authority reserves the right to accept or reject any tender or all tender without assigning any reason there off.
9. No tender document will be accepted displaying firm/company name without proprietor name against which the tender documents will be prepared.
10. After opening of Financial Bid, within 05 days, if the successful Bidder doesn't approach with the CDR, the 2nd Lowest bidder, shall be approached for the negotiation and allotment of work at rates quoted by L1.
11. The already defaulted contractors are not allowed to participate in any tendering work of REW Division Poonch.
12. Subletting of allotted work is not allowed and will attract strict legal action, even cancellation of contract with imposition of costs and penalty etc., if any successful bidder is found involved in same at any stage.

PUBLIC NOTICE

Subject: Compliance Requirements for Manufacturers dealing with Packaged Drinking Water (PDW) and Mineral Water (MW) under Food Safety and Standards (Food Products Standards and Food Additives) Regulation, 2011.

Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has gazette notified omission of the provision for mandatory BIS certification under Food Safety and Standards (Prohibition and Restriction of Sales) Regulation, 2011 vide dated 17th October, 2024. The mandatory Bureau of Indian Standards Certification Mark is no longer required for Packaged Drinking Water (PDW) & Mineral Water (MW).

Meanwhile, a scheme of testing has been issued by FSSAI vide communication No. RCD-15001/19/2025-Regulatory-FSSAI dated 17.12.2025, for the Food Business Operators (FBOs) manufacturing "Packaged Drinking Water" & "Mineral Water" in order to ensure safety & uniform compliance of the said food products as per Regulation 2.10.8 and 2.10.7 of and related regulations.

A. Scheme of Testing for Packaged Drinking Water (PDW) in accordance with FSSR 2.10.8.

- 1. Testing & Records
- Conduct tests as per prescribed Levels of Control on the entire production.
- Maintain complete test records and batch-wise mineral addition records (where applicable).
- Ensure compliance with Schedule IV of the Food Safety and Standards (Licensing and Registration of Food Businesses) Regulation, 2011.
2. Microbiological Compliance
- Non-compliant batches shall not be released.
- Resume production only after corrective action and satisfactory results for 5 consecutive batches.
- Maintain records of such instances for minimum 5 years.
3. Source Water
- Test source water for all parameters from FSSAI-notified NABL accredited laboratories before use.
- Re-test in case of non-compliance.
- If radioactive contamination is detected, immediately abandon the source, recall product, and inform the Authority.
- Any new source must be fully tested prior to use.
- Treatment, re-mineralization, and disinfection shall conform to Regulation 2.10.8.
4. Packaging
- Packaging materials (plastic containers, pouches, glass bottles, cartons, aluminum cans) shall comply with the Food Safety and Standards (Packaging) Regulation, 2018.
- Reused containers (5L & above) must be durable, cleanable, and disinfected. Damaged containers shall not be reused.
5. Hygiene & Disposal
- Follow hygienic practices as per Schedule IV.
- Maintain documented procedures and display activity schedules.
- Dispose of rejected products separately with proper records; do not store with conforming stock.

B. Scheme of Testing for Mineral Water (MW) in accordance with FSSR 2.10.7

- 1. Test Records: Manufacturers shall maintain complete and updated records of all tests conducted to establish product conformity.
2. Packing Requirements: Mineral Water shall be packed strictly in accordance with the applicable Packaging Regulations, 2018.
3. Production & Quality Control:
- All tests prescribed under the applicable standards shall be conducted on the entire production.
- Entire production shall comply with Schedule IV of Licensing & Registration Regulations, 2011.
- Appropriate control records must be maintained.
4. Microbiological Compliance:
- In case of non-conformity, affected stock shall be re-tested and released only after conformity is ensured.
- Production shall resume only after corrective actions are completed and satisfactory microbiological results are obtained for five consecutive batches.
- Records of such instances shall be maintained for a minimum of five years.
5. Source Water Testing:
- Source water must be tested as per Regulation 2.10.7 from an FSSAI-notified NABL accredited laboratory (ISO/IEC 17025 certified).
- Mineral content shall not be altered during permitted treatment.
- In case of radioactive contamination, the source shall be abandoned immediately and authorities informed.
- Any change in source water requires fresh comprehensive testing prior to use.
6. Reused Containers:
- Only durable and properly sanitized containers (5 litres and above plastic containers & glass bottles) shall be reused.
- Damaged or deformed containers shall not be used.
7. Hygienic Practices:
- Collection, processing, storage, packing, and marketing shall comply with Schedule IV (GMP & hygiene requirements).
- Hygiene shall be maintained at both factory premises and water source.
8. Rejection & Disposal:
- Non-conforming products shall be disposed of in accordance with regulations.
- Separate records of rejected batches and disposal methods shall be maintained.
- Rejected material shall not be stored with conforming product.

The effective date of compliance shall be 01.01.2026, and any non-compliance shall invite action under the Food Safety and Standards Act and applicable regulations.
