



## CRIME REPORT

### Three nabbed with heroin, fake currency

**STATE TIMES NEWS**  
KATHUA/JAMMU: Police on Wednesday arrested three narco smugglers and recovered heroin and fake currency from his possession.

As per details, a team from Police Station Kathua under supervision of SHO Kathua Vijay Sharma during Naka checking duty at Bhagthali, noticed a suspicious person who was stopped for checking. Sensing danger, the suspected person tried to escape but was nabbed by alert police party.

On frisking, approximately 5 gram heroin like substance was recovered from the possession of accused namely Liaqat Ali, son of Mir Ali, resident of Devi Chak. A case vide FIR No 160/2021 under Sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him.

Meanwhile, Trikuta Nagar police, on a tip-off laid a Naka in area and intercepted a car. During checking, 8.5 gm heroin and fake currency amounting to Rs 47,000 was recovered from duo who were in car. They were identified as Aslam and Rashid. One of accused has already been slapped with PSA as dozen of cases are registered against him.

### Three bootleggers nabbed

KATHUA/MENDHAR: Taking stringent action against production of illegal liquor, police on Wednesday nabbed two drug peddlers and recovered 15 litres desi liquor and 22 bottles of illicit liquor from their possession.

As per details, a team of Kathua Police Station under supervision of SHO Kathua Vijay Sharma in its jurisdictional area near Chak Drab Khan apprehended a person namely Arjun Kumar, son of Ashok Kumar, resident of Chak Drab Khan Tehsil and District Kathua. During checking, approximately 15 litres of illicit (Desi) liquor was recovered from his possession. The accused was arrested and a case vide FIR No 161/2021 under Section 48 (A) of Excise Act was registered against him.


Meanwhile, a team of Police Station Mendhar led by SHO Mendhar Insp Manzoor Ahmed Kohli under the supervision of SDPO Mendhar Zaheer Abbas and Army 37 RR laid a Naka at Chattral area and apprehended two person namely Waseem Ahmed, son of Nasar Ahmed, resident of Chattral and Mohd Asif, son of Mehmood Ahmed, resident of Chak Banola. During their personal search, 22 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered from their possession. A case vide FIR No. 84 72021 under Section 48 (A) of Excise Act was registered against them at Police Station Mendhar.

### Lost purse containing cash, ornaments restored to owner

NOWSHERA: Police on Wednesday recovered a lost purse containing cash and gold & silver ornaments and handed it back to its owner.

Police said that on April 6, 2021 evening, a complaint was received from a woman wherein stated that she had lost her purse somewhere in Nowshera market, containing a gold Mangalsutra of 4 Tolas, a gold chain of 2 Tola, 4 silver anklets and cash amounting to Rs 9,000 having total value of Rs 3 lakh approximately.

Police added that immediately after receiving complaint, a



special team led by PSI Rajat Sharma under supervision of SHO Pankaj Sharma carried out a meticulous scrutiny involving retracing route of woman and examining CCTV footage from several places in and around market area where the complainant had lost her purse. During the course of enquiry, the police team was able to zero in the location where the purse had been lost. Thereafter, the location was circulated among public, appealing to come forth with any information likely to lead to recovery of lost purse. Within a short time, a Samaritan came forward and handed over lost purse to Police Station Nowshera, with all contents intact, which was further handed over to the owner.

### Mother, daughter charred in Kishtwar fire

KISHTWAR: In a tragic incident, a woman and her daughter were burnt alive in a mysterious fire incident, which engulfed their house in remote village Manzaagam-Tagood area of Kishtwar last midnight.

According to SHO Chatroo Sandeep Parihar, a fire was broke out in a house of Poshhi Devi, daughter of Late Jamet Ram last midnight at Manzaagam-Tagood area of Tehsil Mughalmaidaan in District Kishtwar, about 26 Km away from District Headquarters, in which two women burnt alive. After witnessing smoke and flames, people informed police. A Police party led by DySP HQ Kishtwar Devinder Singh Bandral and SHO Chatroo Sandeep Parihar rushed to the spot and along with Red Cross Team, locals and fire tenders, and doused the flames, which were spreading rapidly. Both bodies were retrieved and handed over to family members. The deceased have been identified as Poshhi Devi (58) and her 24-year old daughter Netu Balla, daughter of Balwan Singh.

When contacted SSP Kishtwar Shafaqat Hussain Bhat, while confirming the incident, said that investigation has been initiated to ascertain cause of fire. Meanwhile Forensic Science Teams also rushed to spot and collected the samples from the site.

### Two injured as tractor fell into Nallah

POONCH: Two persons were injured as the tractor, on which they were travelling, fell into a Nallah at Poonch on Wednesday.

As per details, a tractor met with an accident in Khanateer Nalla, due to which two persons got injured, who were identified as Usman Ali, son of Mohd Akram and Waseem Akram, son of Muneer Hussain, both residents of Shiendra. They were shifted to District Hospital Poonch for treatment.

### Huge consignment of codeine phosphate recovered; 3 drug peddlers arrested

SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs from society, Police has arrested three drug peddlers from Anantnag and Bandipora. Huge consignment of contra-band substance has also been recovered.

A police party from Police Station Bijbehara at a checkpoint established at Tulkhana crossing intercepted two persons identified as Lateef Ahmad Shah, son of Mohd Qasim Shah and Azad Ahmad Shah, son of Mohd Shaban Shah, both residents of Nambal Mattan. On checking, police party recovered 15

bottles of codeine phosphate from their possession. They were arrested on the spot and a case vide FIR number 64/2021 under relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Bijbehara and investigation was initiated.

During the course of investigation, the arrested duo revealed that they have bought codeine phosphate from Gh Hassan Dar, resident of Tulkhana Bijbehara. On this information, a team headed by SDPO Bijbehara under the close supervision of SSP Anantnag Imtiaz Hussain raided the house of accused. During search, 1,715 bottles of codeine phosphate were recovered from a 7-feet deep pit near kitchen garden. Investigation into the matter is going on and more arrests are expected.

SSP Anantnag Imtiaz Hussain has expressed gratitude towards people of Anantnag for their support in the endeavour of police to eradicate the menace of drugs. He reiterated the firm resolve of Anantnag police to go to the last criminal to ensure that everyone involved in illicit trade is booked under law.

Similarly in Bandipora, Officers at a checkpoint established at Pethkote Bandipora intercepted a person identified as Abdul Rashid Gojer son of Abdul Rehman Gojer resident of Yali Pethkote. During checking, officers were able to recover huge quantity of Charas from his possession. He was arrested and a case FIR vide number 11/2021 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Pethkote and further investigation has been initiated.

Preliminary enquiry revealed that accused drug peddler was selling the drugs to youth of area, especially in and around Mantrigan & Pethkote areas of Bandipora.

### Hit & Run case solved, accused arrested

JAMMU: Police on Wednesday solved a hit & run case by arresting the accused. As per details, a Tata Harrier driven by one Aryan Sharma (17) hit a scooty (JK02BD6717) from behind and leaving mother & daughter in lurch, ran away along with test-rider staff of Fairdeal Motors. It is pertinent to mention herein that person driving Tata Harrier was not having valid driving license and is below age of 18 years. Grievous injuries were caused to scooty-borne duo mother and daughter, resident of 103/2 Upper Roop Nagar, Jammu. Janipur police under the supervision of SHO Janipur Anayat Ali has taken the cognizance of the matter. Police has arrested accused, registered a case and referred the matter to Court of Law for further proceedings.

### Rs 52,000 fine imposed on food business operators for violating norms

SAMBA: Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Samba Suram Chand Sharma imposed a fine of Rs 52,000 (Fifty two thousand) on Food Business Operators (FBOs) for violating prescribed norms under Food Safety and Standard Act (FSSAI).

The FBOs were booked and summoned before the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Samba who is also Adjudicating officer for Food Safety Act. A fine of Rs 5,20,000 was imposed on FBOs for supplying Mis-branded/Substandard Food items. He also exhorted upon the designated Officer Food Safety and Food Safety Officer to generate awareness among Food Business Operators regarding the observance of Food Safety norms enshrined in Food Safety and Standard Act.

### FCS&CA team recovers Rs 10,400 fine from erring traders

RAMBAN: Department of Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs along with team of enforcement department conducted market checking drive in Banihal Bazar. The drive was conducted on the directions of Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Banihal, Zaheer Abbas.

The team headed by Tehsil Supply Officer, Banihal, Gian

Chand Khajuria along with police officials inspected over 50 establishments like mutton, chicken, milk and Grocery stores, besides vegetable and fruit vendors and booked several traders. The team realised a fine of Rs 10,400 from erring traders for not displaying rate list, overcharging and unauthorized installation of hoardings. TSO instructed shopkeepers to display rate lists and sell commodities on the rates fixed by Department/Associations. Moreover, different business establishments were also made aware about different rules and regulation of the department in vogue.

Meanwhile, wearing face mask drive was also conducted and persons found roaming without wearing face masks in public places were fined. The enforcement teams warned shops and business establishments to adhere to SOPs and other preventative measures issued by Government to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

### Purse snatched from woman

### Woman found hanging

### Two nabbed with Charas

During checking, 100 Gm Charas like substance packed in 2 Challis were recovered from their possession. The duo was arrested and a case vide FIR No. 54/2021 under section 8/20 of NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Poonch.
